# vidaXL Raised Garden Bed Instruction Manual

## PRODUCT OVERVIEW

---

This instruction manual provides essential information for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your vidaXL Raised Garden Bed. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning assembly or use.

- **Robust Construction:** Made from galvanized steel with internal supports, this planter is extremely sturdy and durable.
- **Premium Material:** The flower pot is powder-coated to resist rust and corrosion, making it weather-resistant and highly suitable for outdoor use.
- **Ample Space:** The raised planter is deep and wide enough to hold a large quantity of soil, providing sufficient space for your plants, vegetables, herbs, and flowers.

## SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

Assembly of the vidaXL Raised Garden Bed requires careful attention to detail. It consists of multiple panels and numerous fasteners. We recommend assembling with at least two people.

### Required Tools (Not Included):

- Gloves (recommended for handling metal edges)
- Screwdriver or wrench set
- Measuring tape

### Assembly Steps:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and verify against the included parts list (refer to the separate parts list document). Ensure all panels, screws, nuts, and internal supports are present.
2. **Panel Assembly:** Connect the corrugated galvanized steel panels using the provided screws and nuts. Start by forming the basic oval shape. Ensure all connections are secure but do not overtighten initially.
3. **Install Internal Supports:** Attach the internal cross-bracing supports to the inside of the raised bed.

These supports enhance structural integrity. Refer to the diagram for correct placement.

4. **Final Tightening:** Once all panels and supports are in place, systematically tighten all screws and nuts. Avoid over-tightening to prevent damage to the metal.
5. **Placement:** Choose a level outdoor location for your raised garden bed. Consider sunlight exposure and proximity to water sources.




Image: Dimensional diagram of the raised garden bed, illustrating its length (175 cm), width (100 cm), and height (68 cm).

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your vidaXL Raised Garden Bed is straightforward, allowing you to create an ideal growing environment for your plants.

### Filling the Raised Bed:

- Layering (Optional but Recommended):** For optimal drainage and soil health, consider layering materials. A common approach includes:
  - Bottom layer: Coarse materials like branches, wood chips, or gravel for drainage.
  - Middle layer: Organic matter such as leaves, grass clippings, or compost.
  - Top layer: High-quality potting mix or garden soil suitable for your chosen plants.
- Filling with Soil:** Fill the raised bed with your chosen soil mix, leaving a few centimeters from the top edge to prevent overflow when watering.
- Planting:** Plant your desired vegetables, herbs, or flowers according to their specific spacing and depth requirements.

### Watering and Care:

- **Watering:** Raised beds tend to dry out faster than in-ground gardens. Monitor soil moisture regularly and water as needed, especially during dry periods.
- **Fertilization:** Supplement soil nutrients with appropriate fertilizers based on your plants' needs.
- **Weeding:** Raised beds generally have fewer weeds, but remove any that appear promptly to prevent competition with your plants.

## MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance will ensure the longevity and continued performance of your vidaXL Raised Garden

Bed.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically clean the exterior of the raised bed with a soft cloth and mild soap solution to remove dirt and debris. Avoid abrasive cleaners that could damage the powder coating.
- **Inspection:** Annually inspect all screws and nuts for tightness. Retighten if necessary. Check for any signs of rust or damage to the galvanized steel.
- **Soil Refresh:** Over time, soil nutrients deplete. Consider amending the soil with compost or fresh potting mix at the beginning of each planting season.
- **Winter Care:** In regions with harsh winters, consider emptying the bed or covering it to protect the soil and structure from extreme conditions.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your raised garden bed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
<b>Instability after assembly</b>	Screws not fully tightened; uneven ground; internal supports not correctly installed.	Ensure all fasteners are securely tightened. Place the bed on a level surface. Verify internal supports are correctly positioned and fastened.
<b>Water pooling at the bottom</b>	Poor drainage layer; compacted soil.	Ensure a proper drainage layer (e.g., gravel, wood chips) is at the bottom. Loosen compacted soil or amend with organic matter to improve drainage.
<b>Rust spots appearing</b>	Damage to powder coating; prolonged exposure to harsh chemicals.	Clean the affected area and apply a rust-inhibiting paint suitable for galvanized steel. Avoid using harsh chemicals near the bed.
