Timex TW5M53900 Men's Wristwatch Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

This manual provides comprehensive instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Timex TW5M53900 Men's Wristwatch. Please read this manual carefully to ensure proper use and longevity of your timepiece.

The Timex TW5M53900 is a digital watch equipped with various functions including a Day-Date display, Chronograph, Countdown timer, Dual Time zone, and Alarm.

SETUP

Initial Power On and Time Setting

Your watch comes with a pre-installed battery. Upon first use, you may need to activate the display or set the current time and date.

- Identify Buttons:** Locate the control buttons on the sides of the watch case. Typically, these are labeled or have distinct functions (e.g., MODE, SET, START/STOP, LIGHT). Refer to the image below for button identification.
- Enter Time Setting Mode:** Press the **MODE** button repeatedly until the time setting mode is displayed. Digits for hours or minutes will usually flash.
- Adjust Time:** Use the **SET** or **START/STOP** buttons to adjust the flashing digits (hours, minutes, seconds). Press **MODE** again to move to the next setting (e.g., from hours to minutes).
- Set Date:** Continue pressing **MODE** to cycle through date settings (month, day, year) and adjust them using the **SET** or **START/STOP** buttons.
- Exit Setting Mode:** Once all settings are correct, press the **MODE** button or another designated button (e.g., **RESET**) to exit the setting mode and return to normal time display.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Timex TW5M53900 watch offers several modes accessible via the **MODE** button.

Time and Date Display

In the default mode, the watch displays the current time (hours, minutes, seconds) and the day and date. The display is LCD for clear visibility.

Chronograph (Stopwatch)

To use the chronograph function:

1. Press the **MODE** button until "CHRONO" or a similar indicator appears on the display.
2. Press the **START/STOP** button to begin timing.
3. Press **START/STOP** again to pause or stop the timing.
4. Press the **RESET** button to clear the chronograph to zero.

Countdown Timer

To set and use the countdown timer:

1. Press the **MODE** button until "TIMER" or a countdown icon is displayed.
2. Use the **SET** or **START/STOP** buttons to set the desired countdown duration (hours, minutes, seconds).
3. Press **START/STOP** to begin the countdown.
4. An alarm will sound when the countdown reaches zero. Press any button to stop the alarm.

Dual Time

The dual time function allows you to track a second time zone:

1. Press the **MODE** button until "DUAL TIME" or "T2" is displayed.
2. Use the **SET** or **START/STOP** buttons to adjust the second time zone.
3. Press **MODE** to exit.

Alarm

To set and activate the alarm:

1. Press the **MODE** button until "ALARM" or an alarm icon is displayed.
2. Use the **SET** or **START/STOP** buttons to set the desired alarm time.
3. Press a designated button (often **RESET** or **MODE** again) to toggle the alarm ON/OFF. An alarm indicator will typically appear on the display when active.
4. When the alarm sounds, press any button to silence it.

Indiglo® Night-Light

The watch features an Indiglo® night-light for illumination in low-light conditions. Press the **LIGHT** button (usually located on the top right or left side of the case) to activate the backlight.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

- Wipe the watch case and strap regularly with a soft, damp cloth.
- For stubborn dirt, a mild soap solution can be used, followed by rinsing with clean water and drying thoroughly.
- Avoid using harsh chemicals, solvents, or abrasive cleaners, as these can damage the watch's finish or components.

Water Resistance

This watch is water-resistant up to 5 bar (50 meters). This rating means it is suitable for everyday use and can withstand splashes, rain, and brief immersion in water. It is *not* suitable for showering, swimming, or diving.

- Do not operate the buttons while the watch is submerged in water.
- Ensure the crown (if applicable) is pushed in completely after setting the time to maintain water resistance.

Battery Replacement

The watch uses a CR2025 cell battery. When the display becomes dim or functions become erratic, it may be time to replace the battery. It is recommended to have the battery replaced by a qualified watch technician to ensure proper sealing and maintain water resistance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Display is blank or dim.	Low or dead battery.	Replace the battery (CR2025). Professional replacement recommended.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Watch may be in a locked mode or internal malfunction.	Try pressing all buttons firmly. If unresponsive, a battery reset (removing and reinserting battery) might be needed by a professional.
Time is incorrect or not keeping time.	Incorrect setting or low battery.	Re-set the time according to the "Initial Power On and Time Setting" section. If issue persists, replace battery.
Condensation under the crystal.	Loss of water resistance or extreme temperature change.	Avoid extreme temperature changes. If condensation persists, seek professional repair immediately to prevent internal damage.



