1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective use of your OTL Technologies Pokemon Pikachu Wireless Bluetooth Kids Headphones, model PK0980. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product and retain it for future reference.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

To ensure safe operation and prevent damage, observe the following precautions:

- **Age Suitability:** These headphones are suitable for children aged 3 years and above.
- **Volume Control:** The headphones feature two safe volume settings: 85 dB and 95 dB. Always select the appropriate volume level for the listening environment to protect hearing. Prolonged exposure to loud noise may cause hearing damage.
- **Water Resistance:** This product is **not water-resistant**. Avoid exposure to water or moisture to prevent damage.
- **Cleaning:** Do not use harsh chemicals or strong detergents to clean the headphones. Use a soft, dry cloth.
- **Disassembly:** Do not attempt to disassemble, repair, or modify the headphones. This will void the warranty and may cause damage or injury.
- **Environmental Awareness:** Do not use headphones in situations where an inability to hear surrounding noise may present a danger (e.g., while cycling, driving, or near operating machinery).
- **Battery Safety:** The headphones contain a Lithium-ion battery. Do not expose to extreme temperatures or dispose of in fire.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components and controls of your headphones.

4.1 Headphone Structure

4.2 Controls and Ports

- **Power Button:** Used to turn the headphones on/off and for Bluetooth pairing.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust the listening volume.
- **Volume Limit Switch:** Toggle between 85 dB and 95 dB maximum volume levels.
- **USB Type-C Port:** For charging the headphones.
- **3.5mm Audio Jack:** For wired connection using the included audio cable.
- **Microphone:** Integrated for hands-free calls.

4.3 Adjustable Headband

The headband is extendable to provide a flexible and customized fit for various head sizes. Adjust both sides evenly for optimal comfort.

5. SETUP

5.1 Charging the Headphones

Before first use, fully charge the headphones.

1. Connect the USB Type-C charging cable to the charging port on the headphones.
2. Connect the other end of the USB cable to a compatible USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, USB wall adapter).

3. The LED indicator will show the charging status. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours.
4. Once fully charged, the LED indicator will change (refer to the instruction leaflet for specific LED behavior) and the headphones will provide up to 24 hours of playback time.

5.2 Bluetooth Pairing

To connect your headphones wirelessly to a device:

1. Ensure the headphones are charged.
2. Press and hold the Power button until the LED indicator flashes, indicating pairing mode.
3. On your device (e.g., smartphone, tablet, laptop), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "OTL Pikachu" or a similar name from the list of found devices.
5. Once connected, the LED indicator will change (e.g., solid blue) and a confirmation tone may sound.
6. The headphones have a working distance of up to 10 meters from the paired device.

5.3 Wired Connection (Optional)

You can use the headphones with the included 3.5mm audio cable for devices without Bluetooth or when the battery is depleted.

1. Plug one end of the 3.5mm audio cable into the audio jack on the headphones.
2. Plug the other end into the 3.5mm audio output of your device.
3. The headphones will operate in passive mode, and Bluetooth functionality will be disabled.

6. OPERATING THE HEADPHONES

6.1 Power On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3 seconds. The LED indicator will light up.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button for approximately 3 seconds. The LED indicator will turn off.

6.2 Adjusting Volume

- **Volume Up:** Press the '+' button.
- **Volume Down:** Press the '-' button.
- **Setting Maximum Volume:** Use the volume limit switch (85 dB / 95 dB) located on the earcup to set the desired maximum safe listening level.

6.3 Music Playback and Calls

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Power button once during music playback.
- **Next Track:** Press and hold the '+' button.
- **Previous Track:** Press and hold the '-' button.
- **Answer/End Call:** Press the Power button once during an incoming call or to end an active call.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the Power button during an incoming call.

6.4 Using the Sharing Cable

The included sharing cable allows two pairs of headphones to listen to the same audio source simultaneously.

1. Connect the main 3.5mm audio cable from your audio source to the first pair of headphones.
2. Connect one end of the sharing cable to the available 3.5mm audio jack on the first pair of headphones.
3. Connect the other end of the sharing cable to the 3.5mm audio jack on the second pair of headphones.
4. Both headphones will now receive audio from the same source.

7. MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the headphones with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or aerosols.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the headphones in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. The foldable design allows for compact storage.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the headphones regularly, even if not in constant use.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Headphones do not power on.	Battery is depleted.	Charge the headphones using the provided USB Type-C cable.
Cannot pair via Bluetooth.	Headphones not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; too far from device.	Ensure headphones are in pairing mode (flashing LED). Turn Bluetooth on your device. Move headphones closer to the device (within 10 meters). Try restarting both devices.
No sound when connected.	Volume too low; incorrect audio source selected; wired cable not fully inserted.	Increase headphone and device volume. Check if the correct audio output is selected on your device. Ensure the 3.5mm cable is fully inserted if using wired mode. Check the volume limit switch.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Sound is distorted or cuts out.	Low battery; interference; too far from device.	Charge the headphones. Move away from other wireless devices. Reduce distance to the paired device.
