1. INTRODUCTION

The Google Nest Doorbell (Wired, 2nd Gen) provides continuous monitoring and intelligent alerts for your home's entrance. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your device.

The 2nd-gen wired Nest Doorbell is always on, so you can know what's happening at your front door around the clock. Get intelligent alerts about people, packages, and animals, plus 3 hours of event video history – no subscription required. Add up to 10 days of continuous recording with Nest Aware Plus. Set up and manage your video doorbell easily using the Google Home app. The Nest Doorbell requires a free Google Account and is not compatible with the Nest app or the home.nest.com site.

3. SETUP AND INSTALLATION

The wired Nest Doorbell is designed to replace an existing wired doorbell. Professional installation is recommended if you are unfamiliar with electrical wiring.

3.1 Requirements

- Existing wired doorbell system.
- Compatible 16-24VAC, 10-40VA rated doorbell transformer (sold separately).
- Compatible chime (sold separately).

- Wi-Fi internet connection.
- Free Google Account and the Google Home app on a compatible mobile device.

3.2 Installation Steps (Overview)

1. **Turn off power:** Before beginning, turn off power to your existing doorbell system at the circuit breaker.
2. **Remove old doorbell:** Carefully disconnect and remove your old doorbell button.
3. **Install base plate:** Mount the Nest Doorbell base plate using the provided screws and anchors. Use the 20° wedge if an angled view is desired.
4. **Connect wires:** Connect the existing doorbell wires to the Nest Doorbell terminals.
5. **Mount Nest Doorbell:** Secure the Nest Doorbell onto the base plate.
6. **Install chime puck:** If your existing chime is mechanical, install the included chime puck according to the quick start guide.
7. **Restore power:** Turn the power back on at the circuit breaker.
8. **Set up in Google Home app:** Follow the on-screen instructions in the Google Home app to connect your Nest Doorbell to your Wi-Fi network and complete the setup.

Installation and compatibility.

It's designed to replace a wired doorbell and requires a compatible chime and transformer (both sold separately).⁴
You may need to replace existing hardware.

4. OPERATING YOUR NEST DOORBELL

4.1 Live View and Event History

Access a 24/7 live view of your front door from anywhere using the Google Home app. The doorbell automatically records events and provides 3 hours of free event video history, including 2-second previews and 5-minute clips.

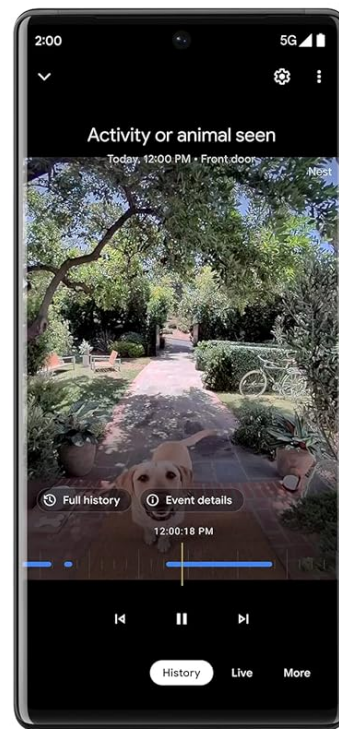

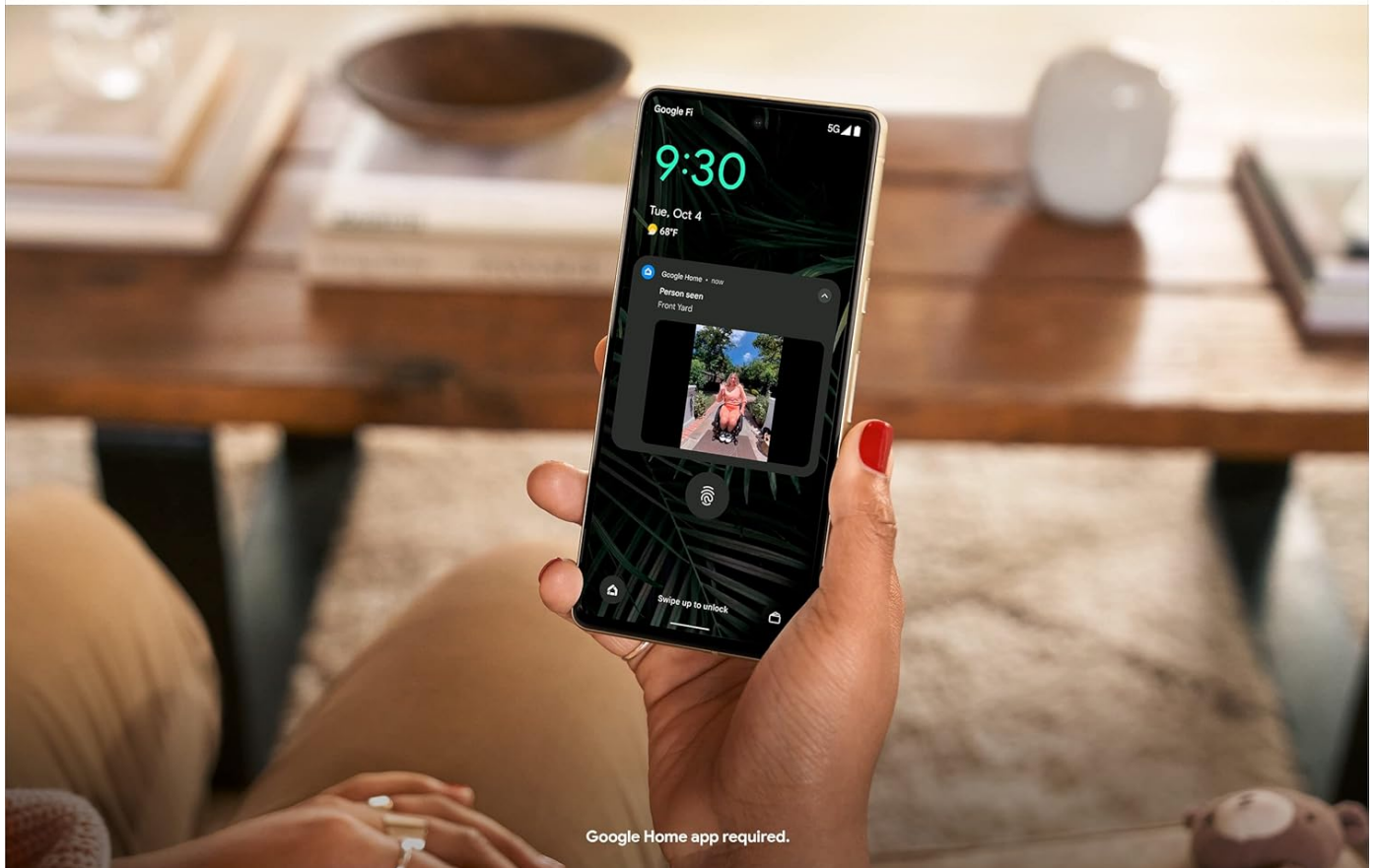

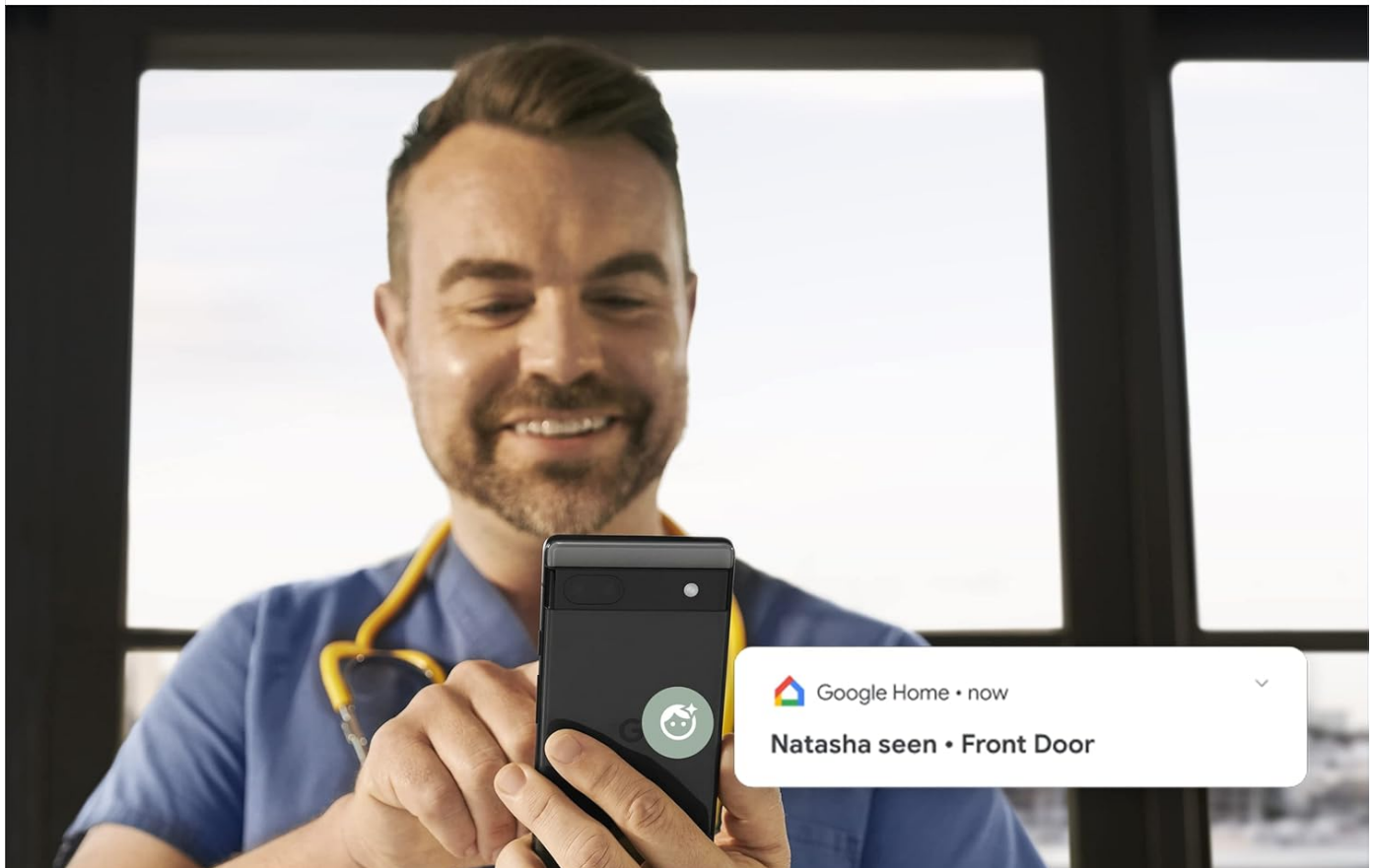


Image: A man using his smartphone to interact with the Nest Doorbell, showing the two-way audio feature.

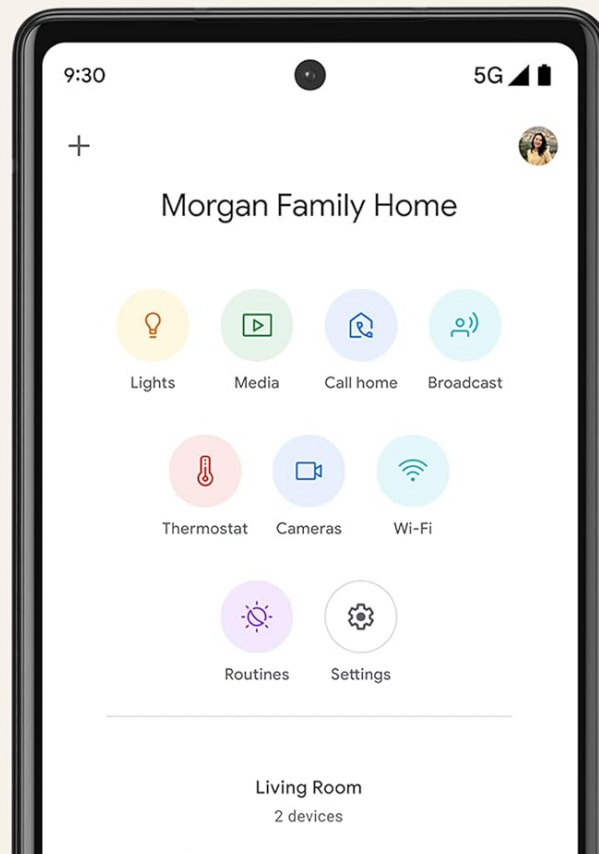


Image: The Google Home app interface on a smartphone, demonstrating easy control over connected home devices, including the doorbell.

4.5 Smart Home Integration

The Nest Doorbell works seamlessly with Google Assistant and Amazon Alexa. Stream your live video feed to compatible smart displays or use compatible speakers as a doorbell chime.

5. MAINTENANCE

The Google Nest Doorbell is designed for outdoor use with an IP54 weather resistance rating. Regular maintenance is minimal.

- **Cleaning:** Periodically wipe the doorbell's exterior with a soft, damp cloth to remove dust and dirt. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners.
- **Lens Care:** Ensure the camera lens is clean and free from smudges for optimal video quality. Use a microfiber cloth if necessary.
- **Firmware Updates:** Keep your Google Home app updated to ensure your doorbell receives the latest firmware, which can improve performance and add new features.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Nest Doorbell, try the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Power/Offline:**
 - Check your circuit breaker to ensure power is on to your doorbell system.
 - Verify that the doorbell wires are securely connected to the terminals.
 - Ensure your Wi-Fi network is active and stable.
- **Poor Video Quality:**
 - Clean the camera lens with a soft cloth.
 - Check your Wi-Fi signal strength in the Google Home app; a weak signal can affect streaming quality.
- **Alerts Not Working:**
 - Ensure notifications are enabled for the Google Home app on your mobile device.
 - Check the detection settings within the Google Home app to ensure desired alerts (person, package, etc.) are enabled.
- **Doorbell Not Ringing Chime:**
 - Verify the chime puck is correctly installed and wired to your existing chime.
 - Check chime settings in the Google Home app.

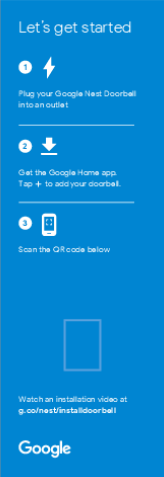
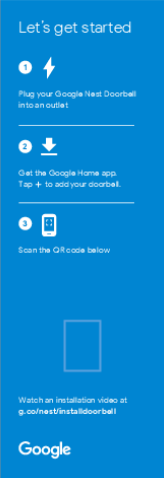

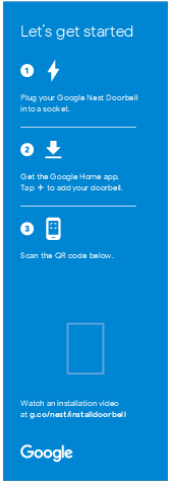
