1. Introduction

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your Hyper 26-inch Adult Beach Cruiser Bike. Please read this manual thoroughly before first use and retain it for future reference. This bicycle is designed for adult riders and features a sturdy steel frame, lightweight alloy wheels, and a rear coaster brake for comfortable cruising.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- · Always wear a helmet when riding.
- Ensure all bolts and quick releases are securely tightened before each ride.
- Check tire pressure before each ride.
- Familiarize yourself with the coaster brake operation.
- Ride defensively and obey all traffic laws.
- Avoid riding at night without proper lighting.

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

While the product description states "Assembly Required: No", some minor adjustments and component installations are typically necessary for new bicycles. Please follow these general steps:

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Retain packaging for potential returns or future transport.
- 2. Handlebar Installation/Adjustment: Insert the handlebar stem into the fork steerer tube. Ensure the

- handlebars are centered and tightened securely. The wide swept-back handlebars should be comfortable for an upright riding posture.
- 3. **Seat Post Installation/Adjustment:** Insert the seat post with the deluxe oversize padded spring seat into the frame's seat tube. Adjust the seat height so your feet can comfortably touch the ground while seated, or as preferred for efficient pedaling. Tighten the seat post clamp securely.
- 4. **Pedal Installation:** Identify the left (L) and right (R) pedals. The left pedal threads counter-clockwise, and the right pedal threads clockwise. Apply a small amount of grease to the threads and screw them into the crank arms. Tighten firmly with a wrench.
- 5. Tire Inflation: Inflate tires to the recommended pressure indicated on the tire sidewall.
- 6. Brake Check: Verify the rear coaster brake engages properly by pedaling backward.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Riding

The Hyper Beach Cruiser is designed for comfortable, casual riding on flat trails, beaches, boardwalks, and paved roads. Its single-speed drivetrain simplifies operation.

- Mount the bicycle by swinging your leg over the frame.
- Begin pedaling forward to engage the drivetrain.
- Maintain an upright posture for comfort, utilizing the wide swept-back handlebars and padded seat.

4.2 Braking (Coaster Brake)

This bicycle is equipped with a rear coaster brake, which is activated by pedaling backward.

- 1. To slow down or stop, apply backward pressure to the pedals.
- 2. The harder you pedal backward, the stronger the braking force will be.
- 3. Practice braking in a safe, open area before riding in traffic.

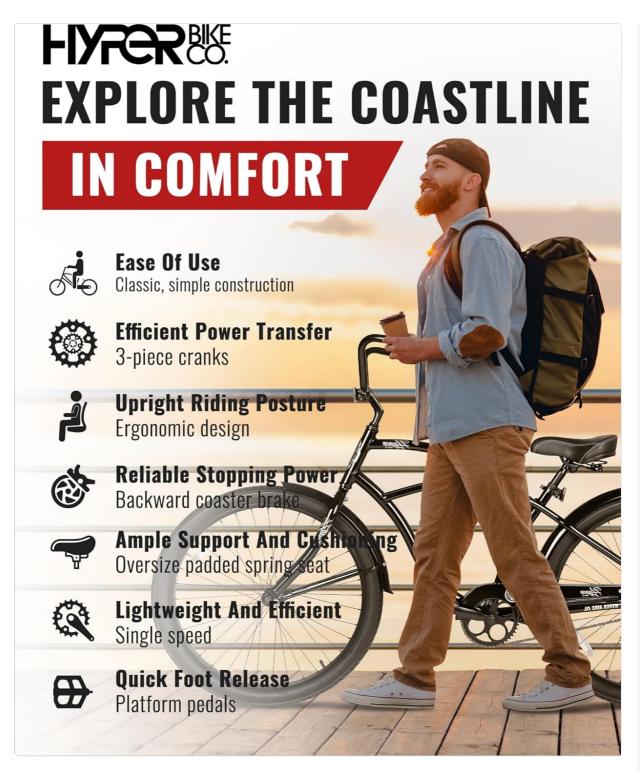


Image 4.1: Operational features highlighting the coaster brake and comfortable design.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and safe operation of your bicycle.

- **Cleaning:** Clean the frame and components regularly with a damp cloth and mild soap. Avoid high-pressure washing directly on bearings.
- Lubrication: Periodically lubricate the chain with bicycle-specific chain lubricant.
- Tire Pressure: Check and maintain tire pressure as recommended on the tire sidewall.
- Fasteners: Regularly inspect all bolts, nuts, and quick releases for tightness. Tighten any loose fasteners.
- Brake Inspection: Ensure the coaster brake engages smoothly and effectively. If you notice any

issues, consult a bicycle mechanic.

• **Storage:** Store the bicycle in a dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures, to prevent rust and material degradation.

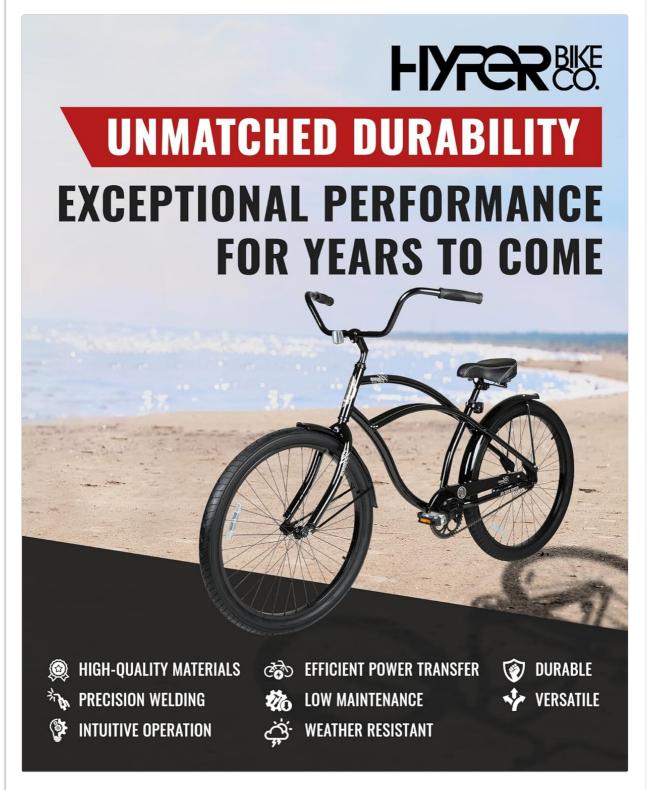


Image 5.1: Durability features contributing to low maintenance and long-term performance.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Pedals feel loose:** Ensure pedals are threaded correctly and tightened firmly. Left pedal is reverse-threaded.
- Tires lose air quickly: Check for punctures or valve stem issues. Inflate to recommended pressure.
- Brake not engaging effectively: Inspect the coaster brake mechanism. If issues persist,

professional service may be required.

• Unusual noises: Inspect chain for proper lubrication and tension. Check for loose components.

For issues not covered here, or if you are unsure about any repair, consult a qualified bicycle mechanic.
