## INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new appliance. ## KEY FEATURES

- **CrispSeal® Plus Crispers:** Designed to keep produce fresher for longer by automatically removing excess moisture and blocking out dry air.
- **Smudge-Proof® Stainless Steel:** A durable and attractive finish that resists fingerprints, making cleaning easier.
- **EvenTemp™ Cooling System:** Optimizes airflow to ensure consistent temperatures throughout the refrigerator, preventing warm spots and unwanted freezing.

- **PureAir Ultra® II Air Filter:** Superior to baking soda, this filter captures undesirable odors to maintain a fresher interior environment.
- **PurePour™ Water Filter:** Provides safe, great-tasting water by reducing up to 99% of contaminants, reducing the need for bottled water.
- **Spacious Capacity:** Offers 22.6 cu. ft. total capacity, with 15.5 cu. ft. for the refrigerator and 7.1 cu. ft. for the freezer.
- **LED Lighting:** Illuminates the interior for clear visibility of contents.
- **External Ice and Water Dispenser:** Convenient access to filtered water and ice (crushed or cubed).
- **Adjustable Tempered Glass Shelves:** Provides flexible storage options to accommodate various item sizes.
- **Auto-Close Doors:** Ensures doors are never left slightly ajar, automatically closing when within 5 inches.

## SETUP AND INSTALLATION

### Unpacking and Placement

1. Remove all packaging materials, tape, and protective film from the refrigerator.
2. Clean the interior with a mild detergent and warm water before first use.
3. Place the refrigerator on a level surface, ensuring proper clearance for air circulation (refer to installation guide for specific clearances).
4. Allow the refrigerator to stand upright for at least 4 hours before plugging it in to allow refrigerants to settle.

## Electrical and Water Connections

- Connect the refrigerator to a dedicated 115V, 15A grounded electrical outlet. Do not use extension cords.
- Connect the water supply line to the refrigerator for the ice maker and water dispenser. Ensure the water supply is turned off during connection. Flush the water system for several minutes to remove air and impurities before first use.

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### Temperature Control

The refrigerator and freezer temperatures can be adjusted via the external control panel on the dispenser. The recommended temperature settings are 37°F (3°C) for the refrigerator and 0°F (-18°C) for the freezer.

### Ice and Water Dispenser

To dispense water, press a glass against the dispenser paddle. To select between cubed or crushed ice, use the corresponding buttons on the control panel. The dispenser also features a light for convenience.

### CrispSeal® Plus Crispers

These crispers are designed to maintain optimal humidity levels for fruits and vegetables. Store produce in these drawers to extend their freshness. The bottom drawer is an adjustable temperature drawer for meat/seafood, cold

drinks, or deli/snacks.

## MAINTENANCE

### Cleaning

- **Interior:** Clean regularly with a mild soap and water solution. Rinse thoroughly and dry. Remove shelves and drawers for easier cleaning.
- **Exterior:** For Smudge-Proof® Stainless Steel, wipe with a clean, damp cloth and then dry with a soft, lint-free cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.
- **Condenser Coils:** Clean coils behind the refrigerator every 6-12 months to ensure efficient operation. Unplug the appliance before cleaning.

### Filter Replacement

- **PureAir Ultra® II Air Filter:** Replace every 6 months. The control panel will indicate when replacement is due.
- **PurePour™ Water Filter:** Replace every 6 months or when the water flow decreases significantly. The control panel will indicate when replacement is due.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Refrigerator not cooling	Power outage; temperature setting too high; door left ajar; condenser coils dirty.	Check power supply; adjust temperature; ensure door is closed; clean condenser coils.
Water dispenser not working	Water supply turned off; water filter clogged; dispenser locked.	Check water supply valve; replace water filter; unlock dispenser.
Ice maker not producing ice	Water supply turned off; ice maker switch off; clogged water filter.	Ensure water supply is on; turn on ice maker switch; replace water filter.
Unusual noises	Normal operating sounds (e.g., defrost cycle, water valve); refrigerator not level.	Refer to normal sounds section in full manual; level the refrigerator.
