Introduction

This manual provides essential information for the safe and effective operation of your Barbie Hot Wheels RC Corvette. This remote-control 1956 Corvette Stingray is designed to replicate the vehicle featured in Barbie The Movie. It accommodates two Barbie dolls and features a functional trunk for accessories. The vehicle operates as a full-function remote-control car.

What's in the Box

- 1 Hot Wheels Barbie Corvette
- 1 Remote Control

Setup

Battery Installation

The Barbie Hot Wheels RC Corvette requires 5 AA batteries for the vehicle and 2 AA batteries for the remote control. Batteries are not included.

1. **For the Vehicle:** Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the Corvette. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the battery compartment cover. Insert 5 new AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Replace the cover and secure with the screw.
2. **For the Remote Control:** Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control. Using a Phillips head screwdriver, unscrew the battery compartment cover. Insert 2 new AA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+/-). Replace the cover and secure with the screw.

After installing batteries, turn on both the vehicle and the remote control using their respective power switches. The remote control will automatically pair with the vehicle.

Operating Instructions

The remote control provides full-function movement for the Barbie Hot Wheels RC Corvette.

- **Forward/Backward:** Use the left joystick on the remote control to move the car forward or backward.
- **Left/Right:** Use the right joystick on the remote control to steer the car left or right.
- **Combined Movement:** Use both joysticks simultaneously to achieve turns while moving forward or backward.

Ensure the vehicle and remote control are within range for optimal performance. The car operates on a 2.4 GHz frequency, allowing multiple remote-control cars to be used simultaneously without interference.

Maintenance

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the car and remote control with a dry, soft cloth. Do not immerse in water or use harsh chemicals.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the car and remote control in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. Remove batteries if storing for extended periods to prevent leakage.
- **Battery Care:** Always use fresh batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries. Dispose of used batteries responsibly.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Solution
Car does not respond to remote.	1. Ensure both the car and remote control are turned ON. 2. Check if batteries are correctly installed and not depleted. Replace if necessary. 3. Ensure the car and remote are within operating range.
Car moves slowly or erratically.	1. Replace batteries in both the car and remote control. 2. Ensure the car is being operated on a smooth, flat surface.
Interference with other RC vehicles.	The 2.4 GHz frequency minimizes interference, but ensure no other strong radio signals are present nearby.
