3. SETUP GUIDE

3.1 Physical Setup

- Positioning the Console:** Place the PS5 console on a stable, flat surface. You can position it vertically or horizontally using the included console base.
- Connect HDMI Cable:** Connect one end of the HDMI cable to the HDMI OUT port on the PS5 console and the other end to the HDMI input on your TV.
- Connect Power Cable:** Plug the AC power cable into the AC IN connector on the PS5 console and then into a power outlet.
- Connect DualSense Controller:** Connect the DualSense wireless controller to the console using the included USB cable to pair it. Once paired, it can be used wirelessly.

3.2 Initial Software Setup

- Power On:** Press the power button on the console or the PlayStation button on your DualSense controller to turn on the PS5.
- Follow On-Screen Instructions:** The console will guide you through initial setup steps, including language selection, internet connection (Wi-Fi or Ethernet), and display settings.
- Sign In to PlayStation Network:** Sign in with your existing PlayStation Network account or create a new one. This is essential for accessing the PlayStation Store and online features.
- System Software Update:** Ensure your console's system software is up to date for optimal performance and access to the latest features.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Solution
Console not powering on	Check power cable connections. Ensure the power outlet is working.
No display on TV	Verify HDMI cable connections. Ensure TV input is set to the correct HDMI port. Try a different HDMI cable.
Controller not connecting/charging	Ensure USB cable is securely connected. Try a different USB port or cable. Reset the controller using the small button on the back.
Slow game downloads	Check internet connection speed. Try connecting via Ethernet cable for a more stable connection. Pause other downloads.
