PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Frigidaire Gallery Nugget Ice Maker produces chewable, crunchy, and airy nugget ice, similar to what is found in restaurants. This countertop unit is designed for convenience and efficiency, producing up to 44 pounds of fresh ice daily with the first batch ready in as little as 10-15 minutes. It features a large-capacity bin that holds up to 3 pounds of ice and includes a built-in reservoir, eliminating the need for a direct water hookup.

- Ensure the ice maker is placed on a stable, level surface away from direct sunlight or heat sources.
- Do not immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.

- Unplug the ice maker from the electrical outlet when not in use, before cleaning, or if a malfunction occurs.
- Keep children away from the ice maker during operation.
- Use only potable water in the reservoir.
- This product contains chemicals known to the State of California to cause cancer and birth defects or other reproductive harm.

WHAT'S IN THE BOX

Carefully unpack all components and ensure all items are present:

- 1 x Frigidaire Gallery Nugget Ice Maker Unit
- 1 x Ice Bin
- 1 x Ice Scoop
- 1 x Drip Tray

SETUP

1. **Unpacking:** Remove all packaging materials and inspect the ice maker for any damage.
2. **Placement:** Place the ice maker on a flat, stable, and heat-resistant surface. Ensure there is adequate ventilation around the unit, especially at the sides and back where the air vents are located. The compact design allows it to fit under most kitchen cabinets.
3. **Initial Cleaning:** Before first use, clean the ice maker thoroughly. Refer to the "Maintenance and Cleaning" section for detailed instructions.
4. **Fill Water Reservoir:** Open the top cover and fill the water reservoir with potable water up to the MAX fill line. Distilled water is recommended to minimize mineral buildup and maintain ice quality.
5. **Power On:** Plug the ice maker into a grounded electrical outlet. The Power indicator light will illuminate.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Start Ice Production:** Press the "Ice" button on the control panel. The ice maker will begin the ice-making cycle.
2. **First Batch:** The first batch of nugget ice will be ready in approximately 10-15 minutes. Subsequent batches may be produced more quickly.
3. **Ice Full Indicator:** The "Ice Full" indicator light will illuminate when the ice bin is full. The ice maker will automatically pause production.
4. **Add Water Indicator:** The "Add Water" indicator light will illuminate when the water reservoir needs refilling. The ice maker will pause until water is added.
5. **Dispensing Ice:** Pull out the ice bin drawer and use the provided ice scoop to retrieve ice.
6. **Important Note:** This ice maker is designed to produce ice, not to store it long-term. The unit does not keep ice frozen once it's made. For prolonged storage, transfer the ice to your freezer promptly after it is produced.

MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning and maintenance will ensure optimal performance and ice quality.

1. **Automated Self-Cleaning:** The ice maker features an auto self-cleaning function. To activate, ensure the unit is empty of ice and water, then press and hold the "Clean" button for a few seconds. The unit will run a cleaning cycle.
2. **Manual Cleaning:** For thorough cleaning, unplug the unit. Remove the ice bin and drip tray and wash them with mild soap and warm water. Wipe down the interior and exterior of the unit with a soft cloth.
3. **Water Quality:** Using distilled water can significantly reduce mineral buildup and extend the life of your ice maker. If using tap water, consider descaling the unit more frequently.
4. **Drip Tray:** Regularly empty and clean the drip tray to prevent water overflow and maintain hygiene.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Ice maker not producing ice.	No water in reservoir; unit not plugged in; ambient temperature too high.	Fill water reservoir; ensure unit is properly plugged in; operate in a cooler environment.
"Add Water" light is on.	Water reservoir is empty or below minimum level.	Refill the water reservoir with potable water.
"Ice Full" light is on.	Ice bin is full.	Remove ice from the bin.
Ice has an unusual taste.	Unit needs cleaning; water quality issue.	Perform a self-cleaning cycle or manual clean; use distilled water.
Unit is noisy.	Normal operation sounds (compressor, ice dropping); unit not level.	Ensure unit is on a stable, level surface. Some operational noise is normal.
