Key features include 1080P Full HD video quality, Starlight Color Night Vision, AI-powered motion detection with real-time notifications, two-way audio communication, and compatibility with Amazon Alexa. Its wire-free design ensures easy installation and flexible placement.

SETUP

1. Charge the Camera

Before initial use, fully charge the camera using the provided USB charging cable and power adapter. A red indicator light will illuminate during charging and turn off when fully charged. Full charge may take up to 8 hours.

2. Download the Home V App

Search for "Home V" in your device's app store (Google Play Store for Android or Apple App Store for iOS) and download the application. Create an account and log in.

3. Pair the Camera with the App

1. Open the Home V app and tap 'Add Device'.
2. Select your current location/region.
3. Turn on the camera by flipping the 'ON/OFF' switch located at the bottom of the unit.
4. Press and hold the 'Sync' button (located near the charging port) for 5 seconds until you hear a sound and the indicator light flashes red.
5. In the app, scan the QR code located on the back of your camera.
6. Follow the on-screen prompts to connect the camera to your 2.4GHz Wi-Fi network. Ensure your Wi-Fi password is correct.
7. Once connected, you can name your device (e.g., "Front Door Camera", "Dining Room Camera").

4. Mounting the Camera

The camera can be mounted using the provided screws for permanent installation or the 3M adhesive pad for temporary placement. Ensure the camera is installed vertically with the lens facing slightly upwards to prevent water or snow from entering the device.

- **Wall Mounting:** Use the included screws and wall anchors to securely attach the mounting bracket to your desired location.
- **Adhesive Mounting:** For non-permanent installation, attach the 3M adhesive pad to the flat base of the mounting bracket and press firmly onto a clean, dry surface.
- **Adjusting Angle:** The mounting bracket allows for flexible adjustment of the camera's viewing angle. Securely tighten the joint once the desired angle is achieved.

OPERATING YOUR CAMERA

Live View

Open the Home V app and select your camera from the dashboard to access the live video feed. You can view real-time footage from anywhere with an internet connection.

PIR Motion Detection & Real-Time Notifications

The camera features advanced PIR (Passive Infrared) detection and AI smart algorithms to accurately detect motion. When motion is detected, you will receive instant notifications on your smartphone.

- **Custom Activity Zones:** In the app settings, you can define specific activity zones to reduce unnecessary alerts and focus on important areas.
- **AI Detection:** Configure AI detection to specifically identify humans, pets, or vehicles, further minimizing false alarms.

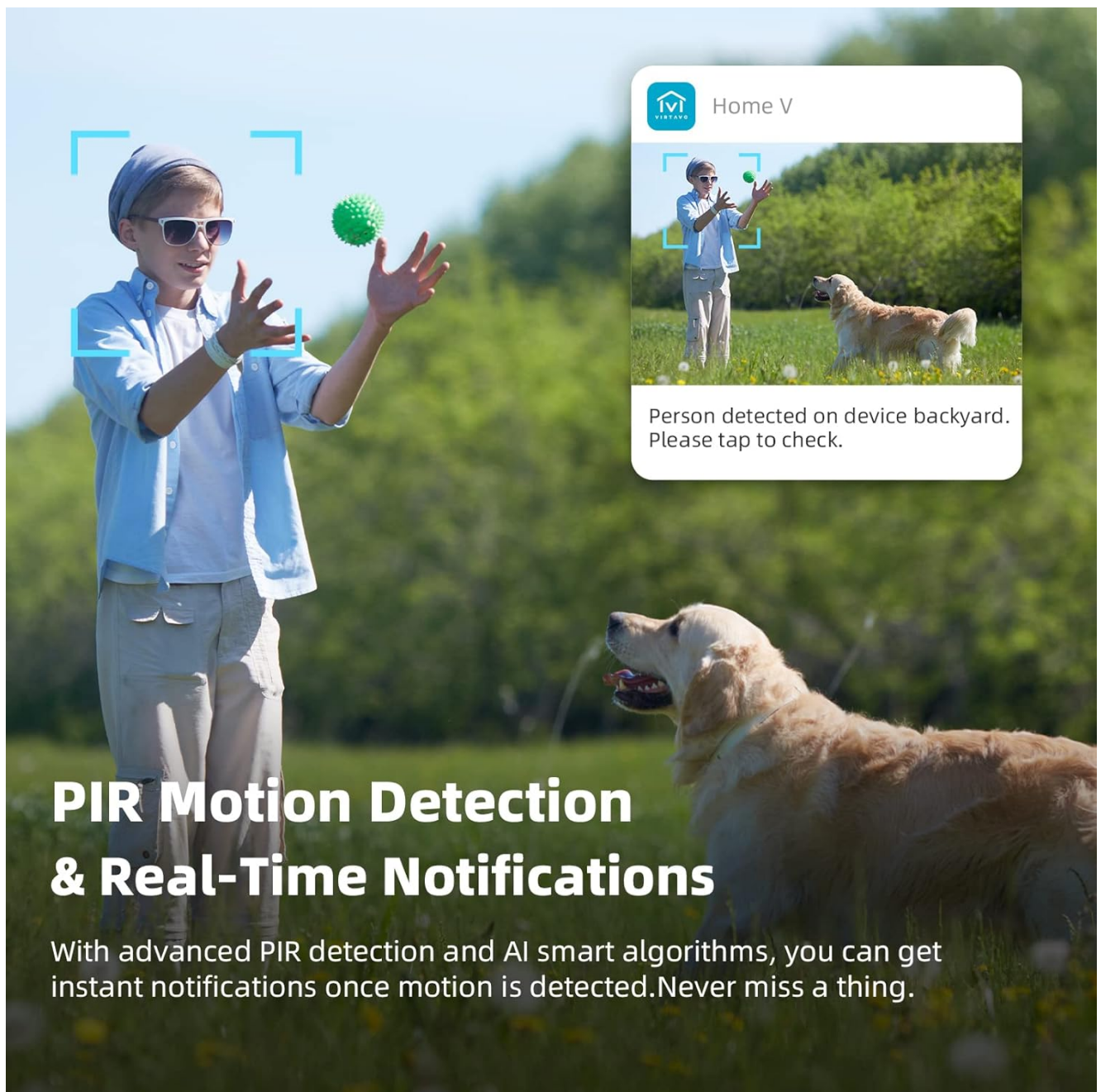
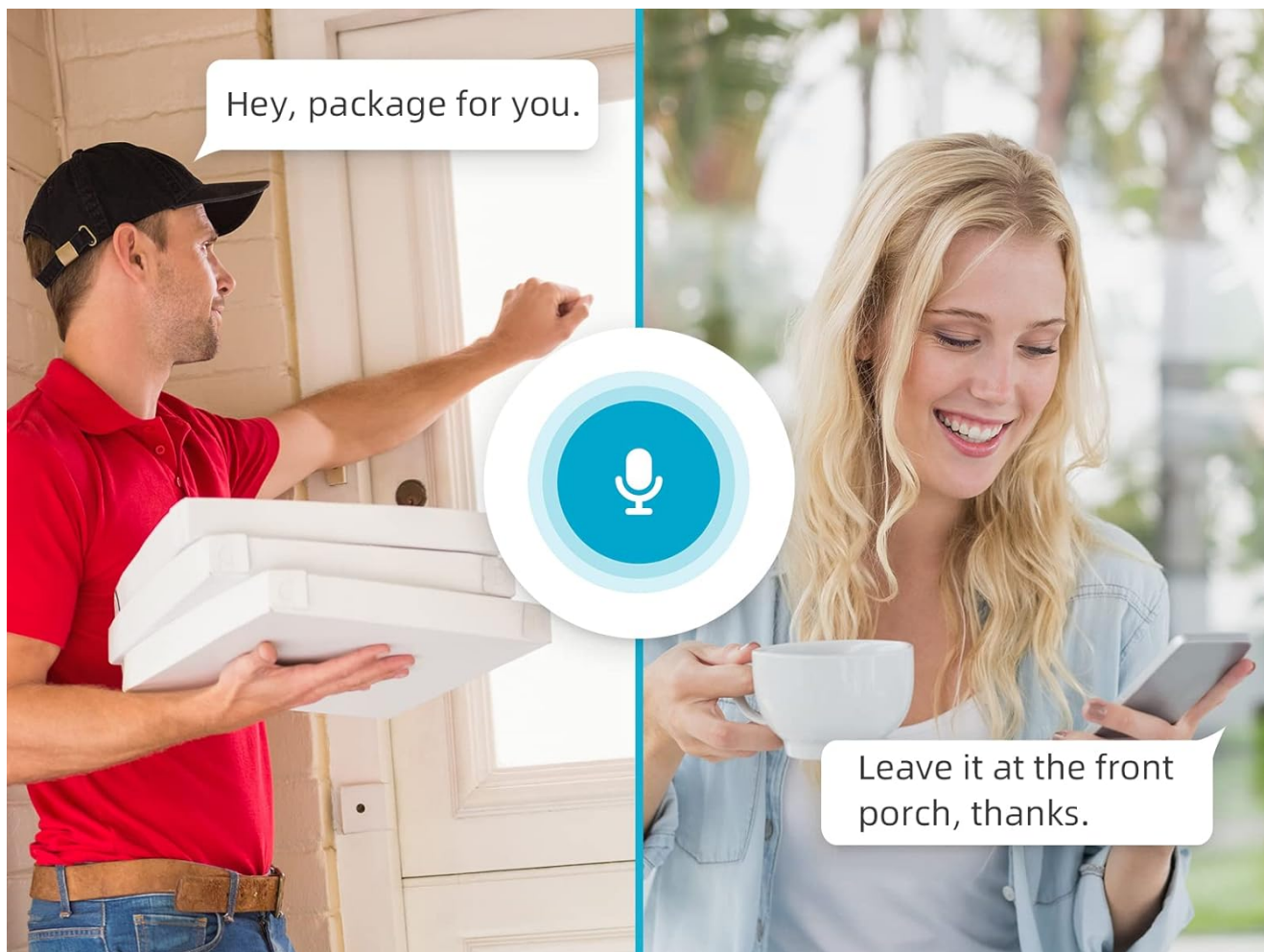

No more unnecessary alerts and receive alerts only in specific areas.

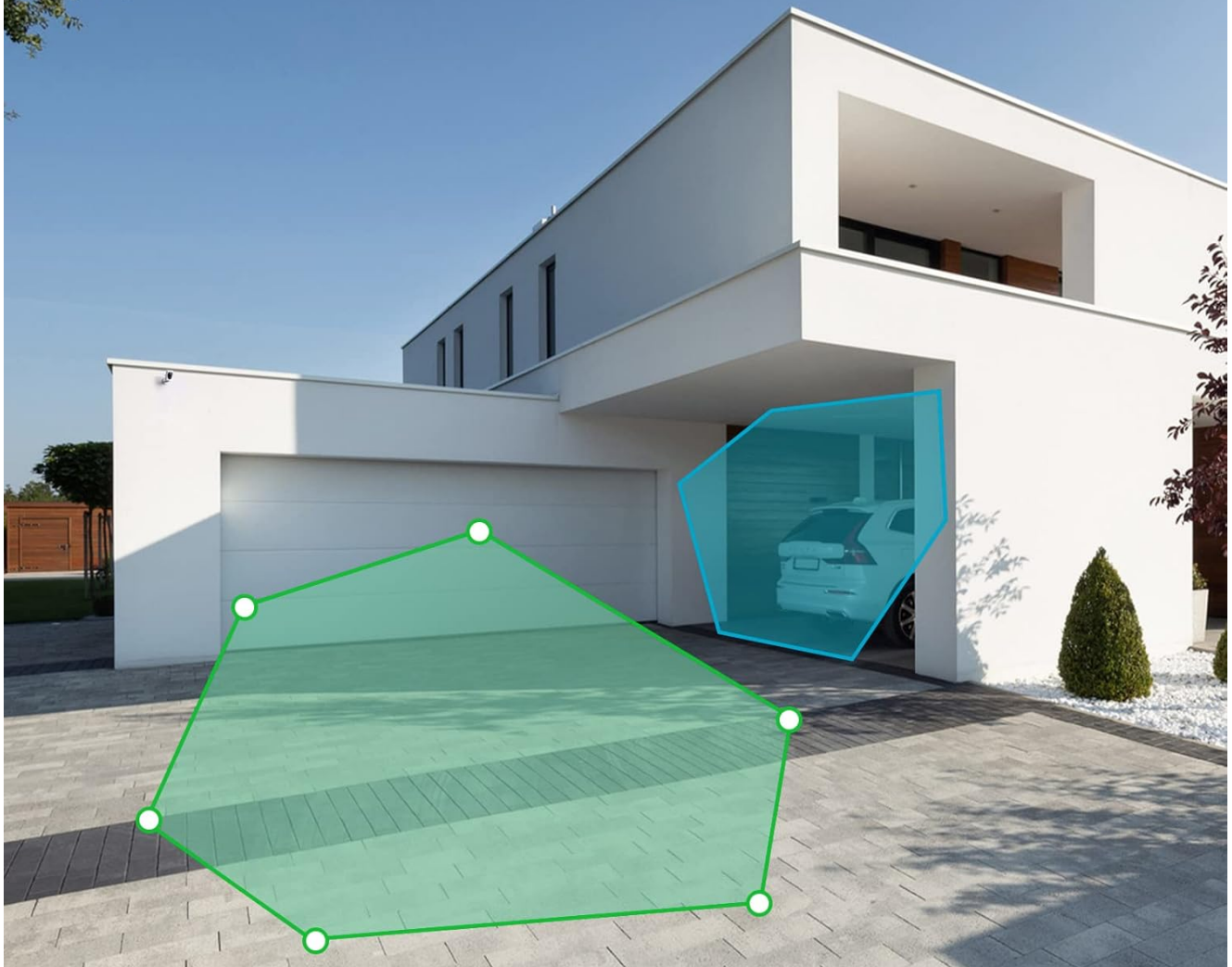
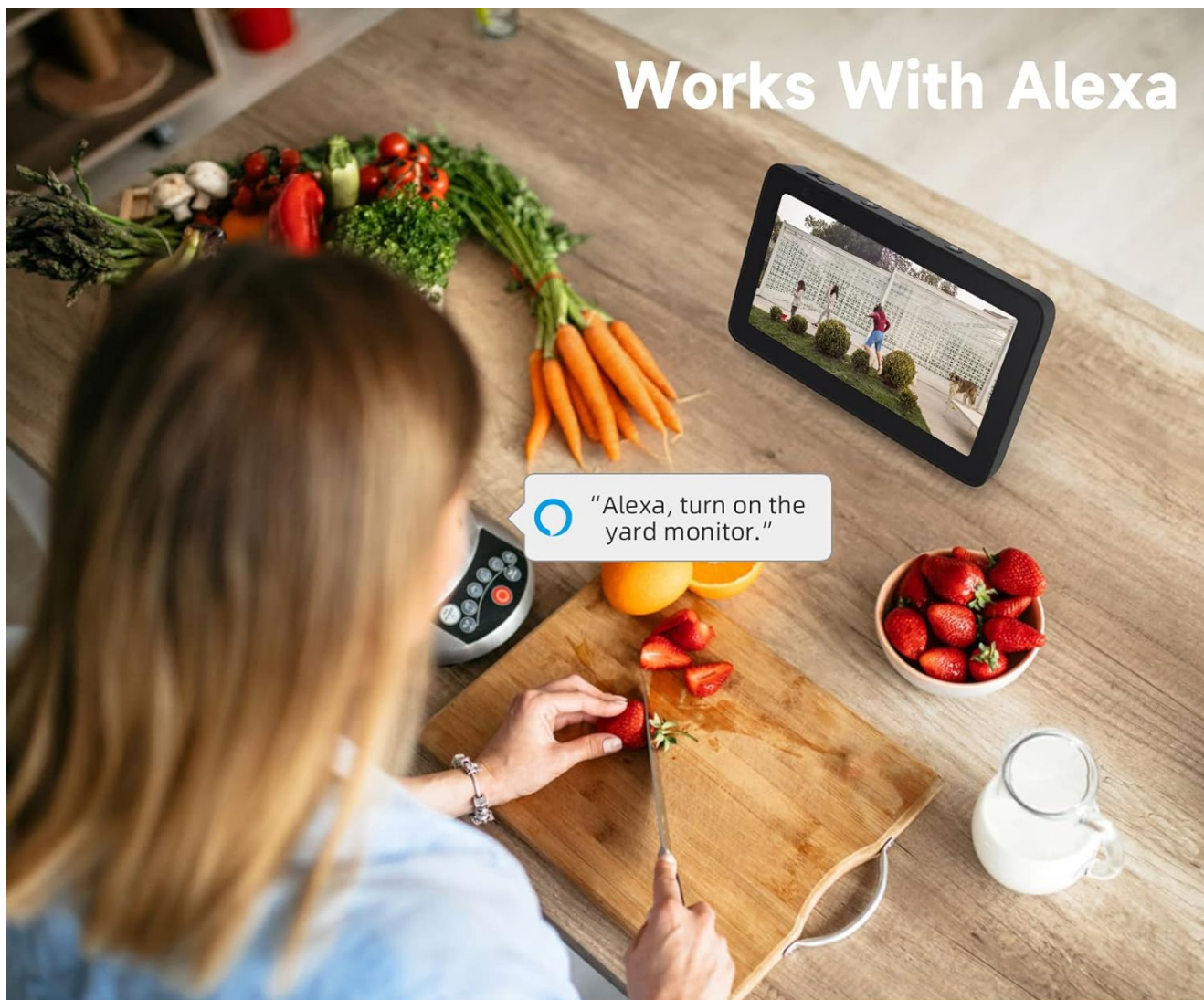

MAINTENANCE

Battery Charging

The camera is powered by two built-in 4400mAh lithium batteries. Battery life can last 1-3 months depending on usage and environmental factors. Recharge the camera when the battery level is low, indicated by the app.

Cleaning

Regularly clean the camera lens and body with a soft, dry cloth to ensure optimal video clarity. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive materials that could damage the lens or casing.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Camera Offline

- Check Wi-Fi connection: Ensure the camera is within range of your 2.4GHz Wi-Fi router and the network is stable.

- Reboot Camera: Turn the camera off and then on again.
- Re-pair with App: If issues persist, try re-pairing the camera with the Home V app.

Poor Video Quality

- Check Wi-Fi Signal: A weak Wi-Fi signal can affect video quality. Try moving the camera closer to the router or reducing interference.
- Clean Lens: Ensure the camera lens is clean and free from dust or smudges.
- Adjust Night Vision Mode: In very dark conditions, switch to black & white night vision for better clarity.

False Motion Alerts

- Adjust Activity Zones: Define specific activity zones in the app to exclude areas with irrelevant motion (e.g., busy streets, swaying trees).
- Refine AI Detection: Utilize the human, pet, or vehicle detection settings to filter out unwanted alerts.
- Adjust Sensitivity: Lower the motion detection sensitivity in the app settings.
