INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your PEUGEOT Paris Nature Black Salt Mill. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The PEUGEOT Paris Nature Black Salt Mill is a manual grinder designed for dry natural crystal salt. Its unique design and high-quality construction ensure a reliable and consistent grind.

SETUP

Your PEUGEOT Paris Nature Black Salt Mill comes pre-filled with dry natural crystal salt, ready for immediate use. If refilling is required, follow these steps:

- 1. Unscrew the Top Knob:** Locate the metal knob at the very top of the mill. Turn it counter-clockwise to loosen and remove it.
- 2. Remove the Top Cap:** Carefully lift off the wooden top cap of the mill.

3. **Fill with Salt:** Pour dry natural crystal salt into the body of the mill. Ensure the salt grains are no larger than 4mm to prevent jamming the mechanism. Do not overfill.
4. **Replace Cap and Knob:** Place the wooden top cap back onto the mill, aligning it with the central rod. Screw the metal knob back on clockwise until it is finger-tight. Do not overtighten.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Using your Peugeot salt mill is straightforward.

1. **Hold the Mill:** Grasp the body of the mill firmly with one hand.

2. Adjust Grinding Degree: The fineness of the grind is adjusted by turning the metal knob on top of the mill.

- Turn the knob **clockwise** for a finer grind.
- Turn the knob **counter-clockwise** for a coarser grind.

3. **Grind the Salt:** Once the desired fineness is set, turn the top part of the mill (the wooden cap and knob assembly) clockwise to activate the grinding mechanism and dispense salt.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will extend the life of your Peugeot salt mill.

- **Cleaning the Exterior:** Wipe the exterior of the mill with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the mill in water, as this can damage the wood and the grinding mechanism.
- **Cleaning the Grinding Mechanism:** The steel grinding mechanism is designed for durability. If salt residue builds up, you can gently brush it away with a small, dry brush.

- **Storage:** Store the mill in a dry place away from direct sunlight and excessive humidity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mill not grinding or grinding poorly.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Mill is empty.• Salt grains are too large or damp.• Grinding mechanism is clogged.• Top knob is too loose.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Refill the mill with dry salt.• Ensure salt grains are dry and no larger than 4mm.• Clean the grinding mechanism with a dry brush.• Tighten the top knob slightly.
Grind is inconsistent.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Top knob not tightened correctly.• Grinding mechanism needs cleaning.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Adjust the top knob to the desired fineness and ensure it is secure.• Clean the grinding mechanism.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Mill feels stiff or difficult to turn.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Salt grains are too large or damp. • Mechanism is clogged. • Top knob is overtightened. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Check salt quality and size. • Clean the grinding mechanism. • Loosen the top knob slightly.
