1. Product Overview

The ZABBOW Scorpion Bluetooth Headset is a versatile wireless earphone designed for clear communication and audio playback across various activities such as sport, office work, and driving. Featuring Bluetooth V5.3 technology, it ensures stable connections and wide compatibility with devices like iOS, Android, and PS3. Its design prioritizes comfort and includes a noise-canceling microphone for enhanced call quality.

Key Features:

- **Wide Compatibility:** Advanced Bluetooth V5.3 for stable connections with iOS, Android, and PS3 devices.
- **Ultra-Long Battery Supply:** Up to 10 hours of continuous call time and 160 hours standby on a 2-hour charge.
- **Great Sound Quality:** High-detail treble and bass response with noise reduction and echo cancellation technology.
- **Comfort Design for Sports:** Lightweight and comfortable fit, suitable for extended wear without discomfort.

2. Product Components and Controls

Headset Components and Functions

Component	Function
Function Button	Power On/Off, Play/Pause, Answer/End Call, Voice Assistant activation.
Volume "+" / Previous	Increase volume, skip to previous track.
Volume "-" / Next	Decrease volume, skip to next track.
Charging Port	Connect charging cable to power source.
Lamp (LED Indicator)	Indicates power status, pairing mode, charging status.
Mic	Microphone for voice input during calls.
Ear Hook	Provides secure and comfortable fit over the ear.

3. Setup

3.1 Charging the Headset

Before first use, fully charge your headset. A full charge takes approximately 2 hours.

1. Connect the charging cable to the headset's charging port.
2. Connect the other end of the cable to a USB power source (e.g., computer USB port, wall adapter).
3. The LED indicator (Lamp) will show the charging status. It typically turns red during charging and blue or off when fully charged.

3.2 Pairing with a Device

To use your ZABBOW Scorpion headset, you must first pair it with your Bluetooth-enabled device.

1. Ensure the headset is turned off.
2. Press and hold the **Function Button** for approximately 5-7 seconds until the LED indicator flashes red and blue alternately. This indicates the headset is in pairing mode.
3. On your device (smartphone, tablet, PS3, etc.), enable Bluetooth and search for available devices.
4. Select "ZABBOW Scorpion" or a similar name from the list of found devices.
5. Once paired, the LED indicator on the headset will typically flash blue slowly or turn off, and you will hear a confirmation tone.

Note: The headset will automatically attempt to reconnect to the last paired device when powered on, if that device's Bluetooth is active and within range.

4. Operating Instructions

4.1 Power On/Off

- **Power On:** Press and hold the **Function Button** for about 3 seconds until the LED indicator flashes blue and you hear a power-on tone.
- **Power Off:** Press and hold the **Function Button** for about 4 seconds until the LED indicator flashes red and you hear a power-off tone.

4.2 Call Management

- **Answer/End Call:** Short press the **Function Button**.
- **Reject Call:** Press and hold the **Function Button** for about 2 seconds during an incoming call.
- **Redial Last Number:** Double-press the **Function Button** when not on a call.

4.3 Music Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Short press the **Function Button**.
- **Next Track:** Short press the **Volume "-" / Next** button.
- **Previous Track:** Short press the **Volume "+" / Previous** button.

4.4 Volume Control

- **Increase Volume:** Press and hold the **Volume "+" / Previous** button.
- **Decrease Volume:** Press and hold the **Volume "-" / Next** button.

4.5 Voice Assistant Activation

- **Activate Voice Assistant:** Triple-press the **Function Button** (if supported by your connected device).

5. Maintenance

5.1 Cleaning

- Wipe the headset with a soft, dry, lint-free cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or aerosol sprays.
- Avoid getting moisture into any openings.

5.2 Storage

- Store the headset in a cool, dry place away from extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the battery periodically (e.g., every 3 months) to maintain battery health.

5.3 Ear Hook Disassembly/Assembly

The ear hook can be removed or replaced for comfort or maintenance.

1. **To Remove:** Gently buckle the clear lens near the charging port, then push the ear hook out.
2. **To Install:** Align the ear hook with the slot and push it in until it clicks securely into place.

6. Troubleshooting

If you encounter issues with your headset, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

Problem	Possible Solution
Headset does not power on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect to a charger and check the LED indicator.
Cannot pair the headset with my device.	Ensure the headset is in pairing mode (flashing red and blue LED). Make sure Bluetooth is enabled on your device. Move the headset closer to your device. Turn off and on Bluetooth on your device, then try searching again. Clear previous Bluetooth connections on your device if too many are stored.

Problem	Possible Solution
No sound or low volume.	Increase the volume on both the headset and your connected device. Ensure the headset is properly connected to your device. Check if the audio output on your device is set to the Bluetooth headset.
Call quality is poor.	Ensure the microphone is not obstructed. Move closer to your connected device to avoid interference. Avoid environments with strong electromagnetic interference.
