SETUP

1. Charging the Earbuds and Case

Before first use, ensure both the earbuds and the charging case are fully charged. The charging case has a 2600mAh capacity, providing multiple recharges for the earbuds.

- **USB-C Charging:** Connect the provided USB-C cable to the charging port on the case and to a power source.
- **Wireless Charging:** Place the charging case on a compatible wireless charging pad (not included).
- **Earbud Charging:** Place the earbuds into the charging case. They will automatically begin charging. The LED display

on the case will show the charging status of each earbud.

2. Pairing with Your Device

The CAPOXO D8 earbuds utilize Bluetooth 5.3 for a fast and stable connection.

1. Take the earbuds out of the charging case. They will automatically turn on and enter pairing mode.
2. On your device (smartphone, tablet, laptop), go to Bluetooth settings.
3. Search for "D8" in the list of available devices and select it to connect.
4. Once connected, you will hear a confirmation tone, and the earbuds will be ready for use.

One-step Auto Pairing

1. Earbuds auto turn on and enter pairing status when taken out from the charging case;
2. Activate Bluetooth and search "D8" to connect.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Controls

The CAPOXO D8 earbuds feature multi-function buttons on each earbud for easy control:

- **Play/Pause:** Click once on either the Left (L) or Right (R) earbud.
- **Volume Up:** Long press the Right (R) earbud.
- **Volume Down:** Long press the Left (L) earbud.

- **Next Track:** Quick-click twice on the Right (R) earbud.
- **Previous Track:** Quick-click twice on the Left (L) earbud.
- **Answer/End Call:** Click once on either L/R earbud.
- **Reject Call:** Long press for 2 seconds on either L/R earbud.

Voice Assistant Activation

To activate your device's voice assistant (e.g., Siri, Google Assistant), quick-click three times on either the Left (L) or Right (R) earbud.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Regularly clean the earbuds, especially the eartips and charging contacts, with a soft, dry cloth. For sweaty earbuds, ensure they are completely dry before placing them back in the charging case to prevent damage.
- **Storage:** When not in use, store the earbuds in their charging case to protect them from dust and damage.
- **Water Resistance:** While IPX7 waterproof, avoid prolonged submersion in water. Dry thoroughly after exposure to sweat or splashes.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Earbuds not pairing	Earbuds not in pairing mode; Bluetooth off on device; previously paired device interfering.	Ensure earbuds are out of case and flashing. Turn Bluetooth off/on on your device. Forget "D8" from previously paired devices and re-pair.
No sound from one earbud	Low battery; earbud not properly connected; mono mode activated.	Charge both earbuds. Place both earbuds back in the case and take them out again. Ensure both earbuds are connected in stereo mode.
Charging case not charging	Faulty cable/charger; improper connection.	Try a different USB-C cable or power adapter. Ensure the cable is securely plugged into the case and power source. For wireless charging, ensure proper placement on the charging pad.
Earbuds falling out during exercise	Incorrect eartip size or improper fit.	Try different sized eartips included in the box. Adjust the flexible ear hooks to ensure a snug and secure fit around your ear.

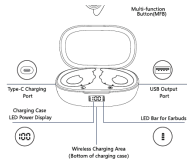

Power On/Off

Auto Power On

Take the earbuds out from the charging case, they will turn on automatically.

Auto Power Off

Put the earbuds back into the charging case, they will disconnect & turn off automatically.

Manually Power On

If the earbuds are out of the charging case and power off, then press & hold them for 2s, they will power on.

Manually Power Off

In non-standby mode or standby mode, press & hold either earbud for 5s, both earbuds will power off at the same time.

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Bluetooth Connection

Prior to first use (or not in use for long time), please fully charge both earbuds and charging case.

First Time Pairing

- Step 1: Take both earbuds out from charging case, they will automatically power on and enter pairing mode. At this time, red indicator of master earbud will flash Blue & Red light alternately, and the slave earbud indicator flashes Blue & Green every 2s.
- Step 2: Activate the Bluetooth setting on your phone, search and connect "D8".

Once connected, the red light of both earbuds goes off.



*Note: If the earbuds are not connected to your device over 5 minutes, the earbuds will power off automatically.

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For Second Time Use

If the earbuds have already connected with your device, and the Bluetooth setting of this device is on, in the second time using, when you take out the earbuds from the charging case, they will connect with your device automatically.

Pair with Other Device

D8 supports earbuds have memory function, they usually auto connect with the last paired device.

Thus, if you want to pair them with other device, you should disconnect "D8" from the last paired device, and forget the pairing record on the last device. Then try to connect it to a new device, it should work properly.

Mouse Mode (Only Left/Right Earbud is in Using State)

You can use one earbud alone, leave another earbud in the charging case.

- When in Dual mode, put one earbud into the charging case.
- Or only take one earbud out of the charging case, then search & connect "D8" on your device.



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Factory Restore Settings

When should I reset?

- 1) Only one earbud plays music.
- 2) Both earbuds can not work with together.
- 3) Occur connection issues.

Follow Steps Below to Reset Earbuds

Step 1: Delete the pairing name "D8" on your phone and deactivate the Bluetooth setting of all devices near by the earbuds.

Step 2: Put the two earbuds in the charging case, leave them in the charging state.

Step 3: Press the MFB button for 3 seconds, then the earbud will flash red & blue light alternately for 3 seconds, which means the both earbuds have reset completely.

Step 4: Now, pick up the earbuds to turn them on, activate the Bluetooth setting on your phone search and select "D8" to connect, it should work properly.

If not, please put the earbuds back to the charging case and repeat the steps above.

*Note: After resetting, the pairing record between the earbuds and all your devices will be cleared. To use them is any unsuccessful message in your devices. Please consider to delete the historical record of "D8" and try the pairing process again.

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Earbuds Charging

To Charge Earbuds

Insert the earbuds into charging case properly, they will power off & get charged.

Flash during charging:
Turn off once fully charged.

(Earbud's LED light: Red light up means "being charged", Red light off means "fully charged".)

Low Battery Alarm

When the battery is less than 10% (and the voltage is lower than 3.6V), a prompt voice "Please charge" will be uttered, and once every 5 minutes and 5 times in total, and then the earbuds will power off as normal.

*Tip: If the earbuds don't charge or even can't turn on, that may because there is a solidified part or something else on the charging connector or charging pin. You can solve this problem by cleaning the magnet connector on the earbuds and charging pin on the charging case with alcohol wipes.

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Charging Case Charging

Type-C Charging

There is a Type-C charging cable in the small black paper box inside the packing box. Please use the provided Type-C cable with a 5V/1A adapter included to charge the charging case.



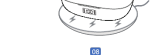
During charging, the charging case power display will show the battery in real time. The number will be displayed as 100 when fully charged.

Wireless Charging

Easy to charge your charging case without cables, just put the charging case on a wireless charging pad.

If the charging case doesn't use to charge, please try to reposition it.

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To Charge Your Phone

As a charged charging case supports charging your mobile phone, connect it to your mobile phone with your charging cable.



Multi-Function Operations

For Call

Answer Call: Click Once
End Call: Click Once
Reject Call: Long Press 2S



Voice Assistant

Voice assistant: Quick Triple Click

*Note: Must in non music mode or instantly ends.



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For Music

[Functions on "R" Earbud]

Play/Pause: Click Once
Next Track: Double Click
Volume + : Long Press 3s Hold

*Note: In music mode, "R" earbud only supports next song and volume +. You have to go back to the previous song by your phone.



[Functions on "L" Earbud]

Play/Pause: Click Once
Previous Track: Quick Double Click
Volume - : Long Press 3s Hold

*Note: In music mode, "L" earbud only supports next song and volume -. You have to go back to the previous song by your phone.



How to Wear the Earbuds Correctly?

Choose best fit ear tips, gently push the earbuds into your ears and adjust them to get a comfortable fit.

1. Do not use the earbuds while driving a car, operating machinery or performing other activities that require hearing surrounding sounds.
2. Using earbuds at high to moderate volumes for extended periods of time will result in permanent hearing damage. It is advised you keep volume levels moderate to low at times for your safety.
3. Please avoid use in thundering and raining days to prevent damage or electric shock.
4. Please keep the earbuds out of extreme heat or humidity, do not use any corrosive chemical to clean the earbuds.
5. Please avoid disassembling/necessitate the product in case of failure or fire accident.
6. Please keep beyond the reach of kids or pets.
7. Please stop using the device if it causes any discomfort or pain.
8. As the Bluetooth signal cannot transmit in water, it is not suitable for swimming or diving. If submerged in water, do not turn the earbuds on until completely dried.

How to Sync Volume on Android?

To protect users from potential hearing damage, Android's limit on max volume is quite low for Bluetooth audio devices.

If you feel the volume is too low, please access developer options and enable absolute volume so you'll be able to use the volume at your own will and to the full capabilities of your Bluetooth devices.

Find Build Number Firstly

Android 4.1 and lower: the Developer options screen is available by default.

Android 4.2 and higher: the Developer options in Android phones are hidden, you must enable this screen through Build Number.

Android 7.0 and lower: Settings > About Phone > Build Number

Android 8.0 and Android 8.1: Settings > System > About Phone > Build Number

Enable Developer Options

Locate the Build number and tap it about 7 times in succession to enable Developer options. You may also have to tap in your PIN for verification. Once developer options are activated, you will see a message that reads "You are now a developer".

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Go back to the Settings page, search Developer options as an entry. At the top of the Developer options screen, you can toggle the options as Figure 1.

Enable Absolute Volume

Scroll down and you reach the Networking section. Over there, enable (toggle ON) the absolute volume option as Figure 2.

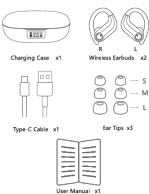
