MCombo Outdoor Storage Cabinet 0985 User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your MCombo Outdoor Storage Cabinet, Model 0985. This compact wooden shed is designed for outdoor storage in various settings such as gardens, yards, and patios.

Safety Warnings

Please read and understand all safety warnings before assembly and use.

- Handle heavy components with care during assembly. It is recommended to have two people for certain steps.
- Use appropriate tools as specified in the assembly instructions.
- Ensure a secure installation, especially when using anti-falling devices and metal brackets, to prevent tipping.
- Keep small parts and hardware away from children.
- For specific safety instructions, refer to the product's assembly manual included in the packaging or contact MCombo customer support.

2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all parts and hardware are present and undamaged. If any components are missing or damaged, do not proceed with assembly and contact customer service.

- Cabinet panels (sides, back, doors, roof, base)

- Removable shelf
- Hardware kit (screws, hinges, handles, latches, magnetic locks, anti-falling devices, metal brackets, feet nails)
- Assembly instructions

3. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly of the MCombo Outdoor Storage Cabinet is required. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included assembly manual. The process is designed to be straightforward, but attention to detail is crucial for stability and longevity.

General Assembly Tips:

- **Tools:** A screwdriver is required. A cordless drill can expedite the process, especially for numerous screws.
- **Order of Assembly:** While the included manual provides the exact sequence, some users find it easier to attach door handles as a final step rather than at the beginning.
- **Pre-drilled Holes:** Ensure all pre-drilled holes align correctly. If door handle holes do not align perfectly, carefully reposition and re-screw into the wood.

Key Assembly Steps:

1. Assemble the main frame of the cabinet, connecting the side and back panels.
2. Install the base and the removable shelf. The shelf can be adjusted to fit your storage needs.

Removable Shelves

3. Attach the roof panel. The roof is designed with a slope and asphalt covering for water runoff.

4. Install the doors, ensuring hinges are securely fastened.
5. Attach the aluminum alloy handles, metal latch, and magnetic locks to the doors for secure closure.

Lockable

The lockable latches provide a secure place for tools to be stored

- Secure Installation:** Install the 4 metal feet nails to raise the cabinet slightly, which helps with stability on uneven ground and protects the base from moisture.
- Anti-falling Devices and Metal Brackets:** For enhanced safety and stability, especially in windy conditions or if the cabinet is placed against a wall, install the provided anti-falling devices and metal brackets. These help fix the wood shed to a stable surface or wall.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The MCombo Outdoor Storage Cabinet is designed for simple and efficient use.

Opening and Closing Doors:

- To open, unlatch the metal latch and gently pull the aluminum alloy handles. The magnetic locks will release.
- To close, push the doors firmly until the magnetic locks engage and secure the metal latch.

Using the Removable Shelf:

- The cabinet includes one removable shelf. This allows for flexible storage of items of varying heights.
- To remove the shelf, lift it from its supports. To re-install, align it with the desired support pegs and lower it into place.

5. MAINTENANCE

Proper maintenance will extend the life and appearance of your MCombo Outdoor Storage Cabinet.

Wood Care:

- The cabinet is constructed from high-quality fir wood with a polished surface. While the roof is waterproof, the wood itself is not fully water-resistant and may benefit from periodic treatment.

- To preserve the wood and enhance its weather resistance, it is recommended to apply a waterproofing oil or product periodically, especially if the cabinet is exposed to direct rain or harsh weather conditions.
- Clean the wood surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners.

Roof Maintenance:

- The asphalt-covered sloping roof is designed to prevent water accumulation. Regularly inspect the roof for any debris or damage and clear as needed to ensure proper drainage.

Hardware Maintenance:

- Periodically check all screws, hinges, and latches to ensure they are tight and functioning correctly. Tighten any loose fasteners.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

This section addresses common issues you might encounter with your storage cabinet.

Cabinet Instability:

- **Issue:** Cabinet wobbles or is unstable on uneven ground.
- **Solution:** Ensure the 4 metal feet nails are properly installed and adjusted. If necessary, place shims under the feet to level the cabinet. Verify that the anti-falling devices and metal brackets are securely fastened to a stable surface or wall.

Doors Not Closing Properly:

- **Issue:** Doors do not align or close securely.
- **Solution:** Check that all hinges are tightly screwed. If the door handles' pre-drilled holes did not align perfectly during assembly, carefully unscrew and reposition the handles to ensure proper alignment and closure.

Water Penetration:

- **Issue:** Water is entering the cabinet despite the waterproof roof.
- **Solution:** While the roof is designed to shed water, the overall cabinet is not fully sealed against all water intrusion, especially from driving rain or prolonged exposure. Ensure the cabinet is placed in a location with good drainage. Apply a suitable waterproofing sealant or paint to the exterior wood surfaces, paying close attention to seams and joints, as part of regular maintenance.
