INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the assembly, operation, and maintenance of your SOFTSEA L-Shaped Metal Triple Bunk Bed with Slide and Small Desk. This versatile furniture piece is designed to maximize space, offering a twin over full bunk bed combined with a twin size loft bed, ideal for multiple occupants or guests. It features a durable metal frame, integrated desk, and a fun slide. Please read this manual thoroughly before assembly and use to ensure safe and proper operation.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Your safety is paramount. Adhere to all safety guidelines to prevent injury or damage.

- **Weight Capacity:** The upper bed has a weight capacity of 220 lbs. The lower bed has a weight capacity of 320 lbs. Do not exceed these limits.
- **Mattress Thickness:** For the upper bed, the mattress thickness should not exceed 6 inches. For the lower bed, the mattress thickness should be between 8-10 inches. Ensure the mattress is properly sized to allow for adequate guardrail height.
- **Guardrails:** The upper bunk is equipped with full-length guardrails. Always ensure guardrails are securely in place before use.
- **Ladder Use:** Always use the provided ladders for access to the upper and middle beds. Do not jump on or off the beds.

- **Assembly:** Assembly must be performed by adults. Ensure all parts are correctly assembled and tightened before use. Regularly check all connections and tighten as necessary.
- **Slide Safety:** The slide is intended for recreational use. Ensure the area around the slide is clear before use. Only one person should use the slide at a time.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate ventilation around the bed, especially if placed in a corner, to prevent moisture buildup.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before beginning assembly, verify that all components listed below are present and undamaged. The product is shipped in two efficiently packed boxes, which may arrive at different times.

SETUP AND ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly is required and typically takes less than an hour with assistance. It is recommended to have at least two adults for assembly. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included assembly manual (not part of this digital document) and refer to the diagrams below for visual guidance.

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully unpack all parts and lay them out on a clean, soft surface to prevent scratches. Identify each component using the package contents list.
2. **Assemble Base Frames:** Begin by assembling the base frames for the twin over full bunk bed and the separate twin loft bed according to the provided diagrams. Ensure all connections are finger-tightened initially.
3. **Attach Slats:** Secure the metal slats to each bed frame. Each bed requires 20 slats for proper mattress support.
4. **Connect L-Shape:** Connect the twin over full bunk bed and the twin loft bed to form the L-shaped configuration.
5. **Install Guardrails and Ladders:** Attach the full-length guardrails to the upper beds and secure the two ladders for access.
6. **Mount Desk and Slide:** Install the MDF desk panel and attach the slide to its designated position.
7. **Final Tightening:** Once all components are in place, systematically tighten all bolts and screws using the provided tools. Do not overtighten.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (USAGE)

This triple bunk bed is designed for efficient space utilization and comfortable sleeping arrangements.

- **Sleeping Arrangements:** The bed accommodates one twin mattress on the upper bunk, one full mattress on the lower bunk, and one twin mattress on the separate loft bed.
- **Accessing Upper Beds:** Use the integrated ladders to safely access the upper and middle sleeping areas. Always maintain three points of contact when climbing or descending.
- **Using the Desk:** The built-in MDF desk provides a convenient surface for studying, reading, or other activities. Ensure items placed on the desk do not obstruct movement or pose a falling hazard.
- **Using the Slide:** The slide is for recreational use. Ensure the landing area is clear before sliding. Supervise children during slide use.
- **Space Utilization:** The L-shaped design allows for optimal use of corner space in a room, providing three distinct sleeping areas while minimizing footprint.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

Proper care will extend the life and appearance of your bunk bed.

- **Cleaning:** For the metal frame, wipe with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid abrasive cleaners or harsh chemicals. For the MDF desk, wipe with a dry or slightly damp cloth. The product care instructions state "Dry Clean Only" which is typically for fabric, but for the metal and MDF components, a damp cloth is appropriate.
- **Regular Inspection:** Periodically check all bolts, screws, and connections to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as

necessary to maintain stability and safety.

- **Avoid Overloading:** Do not place excessive weight on any part of the bed beyond the specified weight capacities.
- **Protect Finish:** Avoid dragging sharp objects across the painted metal finish to prevent scratches.
- **Mattress Rotation:** Rotate mattresses regularly to ensure even wear and prolong their lifespan.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your bunk bed, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Bed feels wobbly or unstable.	Loose connections or uneven assembly.	Ensure all bolts and screws are fully tightened. Check that the bed is placed on a level surface. If the floor is uneven, use shims under the bed legs.
Squeaking noises during use.	Loose connections or friction between metal parts.	Retighten all assembly hardware. Apply a small amount of silicone lubricant to connection points if squeaking persists.
Difficulty climbing the ladder.	Rungs may feel uncomfortable.	Consider adding soft padding or tape to the ladder rungs for improved comfort, especially for bare feet.
Slide is not smooth.	Surface friction or debris.	Clean the slide surface thoroughly. Ensure no foreign objects are on the slide.
