1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

Please read all instructions carefully before using the appliance. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Always ensure the appliance is connected to a grounded power outlet.
- Do not leave the iron unattended while it is switched on or connected to the mains.
- Keep the appliance out of reach of children and individuals with reduced physical, sensory, or mental capabilities.
- Never immerse the appliance, power cord, or plug in water or other liquids.
- Exercise caution when handling hot surfaces and steam. Steam can cause burns.
- Only use distilled or demineralized water in the water tank to prevent limescale buildup.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet before filling the water tank, cleaning, or performing maintenance.
- Do not operate the appliance if the power cord or plug is damaged, or if the appliance has been dropped or damaged in any way. Contact authorized service personnel for repair.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Familiarize yourself with the components of your Polti Vaporella Simply steam generator iron.

- 1. **Iron:** The handheld unit with the soleplate and steam buttons.
- 2. Base Unit: Houses the water tank and steam generator.
- 3. Water Tank: Transparent, removable tank for water, visible on the right side of the base unit.
- 4. Steam Hose: Connects the iron to the base unit, delivering steam.
- 5. Power Cord Storage: Compartment within the base unit for storing the power cord.
- 6. **Control Panel/Indicators:** (Not clearly visible in image, but standard for such devices) Usually includes power on/off, steam ready indicator, and temperature controls.

3. SETUP

- 1. **Unpacking:** Carefully remove the appliance and all accessories from the packaging. Retain packaging for future storage or transport.
- 2. **Positioning:** Place the steam generator iron on a stable, heat-resistant surface, such as an ironing board designed for steam generators.

3. Filling the Water Tank:

- a. Ensure the appliance is unplugged.
- b. Remove the water tank from the base unit.
- c. Fill the tank with clean, distilled or demineralized water up to the "MAX" level indicator. Do not overfill.
- d. Reinsert the water tank securely into the base unit.
- 4. **Connecting to Power:** Unwind the power cord from its storage compartment and plug it into a suitable grounded electrical outlet.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. **Power On:** Press the power button (if available) or simply plug in the unit. The power indicator light will illuminate.
- 2. **Heating Up:** Allow the iron to heat up. The "steam ready" indicator light will typically flash during heating and become steady when the iron is ready for use. This may take a few minutes.
- 3. **Selecting Temperature:** Adjust the temperature dial on the iron according to the fabric type you are ironing. Refer to the garment's care label.
- 4. **Generating Steam:** Once the iron is ready, press and hold the steam button on the iron handle to release steam. For continuous steam, some models may have a lock function for the steam button.
- 5. **Ironing:** Iron your garments as usual, utilizing the steam as needed. For stubborn creases, a burst of steam can be applied.
- Refilling Water During Use: If the water tank runs empty, the "no water" indicator may light up.
 Unplug the unit, refill the tank as described in the Setup section, and then plug it back in. Allow it to reheat.
- 7. **Power Off:** After use, press the power button to turn off the unit and unplug it from the electrical outlet.
- 8. **Storage:** Allow the iron to cool completely before storing. Drain any remaining water from the tank. Secure the steam hose and power cord in their designated storage areas.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your appliance.

· Cleaning the Soleplate:

- a. Ensure the iron is unplugged and completely cool.
- b. Wipe the soleplate with a damp cloth and a mild, non-abrasive cleaner if necessary. Do not use abrasive pads or metallic scourers.

• Descaling (Anti-Calc System):

The Polti Vaporella Simply is designed with an anti-calc system. Follow these general steps for descaling:

- a. Refer to your specific model's instructions for descaling frequency, which depends on water hardness and usage.
- b. Ensure the appliance is unplugged and cool.
- c. Some models have a removable anti-calc filter or collector. Remove and rinse it under running water.
- d. For internal descaling, follow the manufacturer's recommended procedure, which may involve a specific descaling solution or a self-cleaning cycle.
- Cleaning the Exterior: Wipe the exterior of the base unit and iron handle with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals.
- Emptying the Water Tank: After each use, it is recommended to empty any remaining water from the tank to prevent stagnant water and mineral buildup.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No steam produced.	Water tank empty; iron not hot enough; steam button not pressed.	Refill water tank; wait for "steam ready" light; press steam button.
Water dripping from soleplate.	Iron not hot enough; steam used at too low a temperature.	Allow iron to heat fully; increase temperature setting for steam.
White flakes on garments.	Limescale buildup in the iron.	Perform descaling procedure as per maintenance instructions. Use distilled water.
Iron not heating up.	Not plugged in; power switch off; faulty outlet.	Check power connection; ensure power switch is on; try a different outlet.


