1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Bunfly Professional Pet Grooming Kit with Vacuum Suction System (Model PC-C2) is designed to provide a comprehensive and efficient grooming experience for dogs, cats, and other animals. This kit includes multiple grooming tools that connect to a central vacuum unit, ensuring a clean grooming environment by collecting shed hair directly.

Key Features:

- Powerful 13kPa suction for effective hair collection.
- Low noise technology (as low as 50dB) to minimize pet anxiety.
- Large 3.5L dust box capacity with a 2-stage HEPA filtration system.
- 5.2ft premium hose for extended reach and flexibility.
- Multiple interchangeable grooming tools for various needs.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read all safety instructions carefully before using the Bunfly Pet Grooming Kit to ensure safe operation and prevent injury or damage.

General Safety Precautions:

- Avoid using the product on infants.
- Keep the device and all components away from water sources to prevent electrical shock.
- Follow all recommended cleaning and maintenance procedures outlined in this manual.
- Ensure the device is unplugged before cleaning or changing attachments.

Specific Safety Warnings:

- This product operates at a noise level of up to 65dBA. While designed with noise reduction, this may still startle pets or users with sensitive hearing. Introduce the device slowly to pets, starting with the lowest suction

level, and offer treats to create a positive association.

- Always ensure pets are calm and comfortable before and during grooming sessions.
- Do not force any tool onto your pet. If resistance is met, stop and check for tangles or other issues.

3. SETUP

Follow these steps to set up your Bunfly Pet Grooming Kit for first-time use.

3.1 Unpacking and Inspection

1. Carefully remove all components from the packaging.
2. Inspect all parts for any signs of damage. If any components are damaged, do not use the product and contact customer support.
3. Ensure all listed components are present.

3.2 Assembling the Main Unit and Hose

1. Place the main vacuum unit on a stable, flat surface.
2. Connect one end of the flexible hose to the suction port on the main unit. Ensure it clicks securely into place.

3.3 Attaching Grooming Tools

1. Select the desired grooming tool (e.g., grooming brush, trimmer).
2. Attach the tool to the open end of the flexible hose by aligning the connectors and twisting until secure.
3. For the trimmer, select the appropriate guide comb for the desired hair length and snap it onto the trimmer head.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

This section provides detailed instructions on how to use each grooming tool effectively.

4.1 Powering On and Adjusting Suction

1. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
2. Press the power button on the main unit to turn on the device.
3. Adjust the suction level using the control buttons (typically indicated as low, medium, high) to suit your pet's comfort and grooming needs. Start with the lowest setting for nervous pets.

4.2 Using the Grooming Tools

General Tip: Always brush your pet gently and in the direction of hair growth. For best results, ensure your pet is calm and relaxed.

4.2.1 Grooming Brush (Slicker Comb)

- Attach the grooming brush to the hose.
- Gently brush your pet's coat to remove loose hair, tangles, and mats. The vacuum will automatically collect the shed hair.

4.2.2 Deshedding Brush (Grooming Comb)

- Attach the deshedding brush to the hose.
- Use this tool to remove excess undercoat and reduce shedding. Brush in long, even strokes.

4.2.3 Massage Comb

- Attach the massage comb to the hose.
- Gently massage your pet's head and body. This helps to relax the pet and stimulate circulation, while also collecting loose hair.



5.2ft Premium Hose

The long hose can keep the host away from pets during grooming and will not be frightened.

4.2.4 Electric Trimmer

- Attach the electric trimmer to the hose.
- Select and attach the desired guide comb (e.g., 6mm, 12mm, 18mm, 24mm) for the preferred hair length.
- Carefully trim your pet's hair, moving the trimmer smoothly against the direction of hair growth. The vacuum will suction the cut hair directly, preventing mess.

4.2.5 2-in-1 Dusting and Crevice Tool

- Attach the 2-in-1 tool to the hose.
- Use the brush side for dusting surfaces like furniture, keyboards, or pet beds.
- Slide the brush back to expose the crevice tool for cleaning tight spaces and corners where pet hair accumulates.

Larger Dust Box **3L**

The 3L dust box lets you clean longer without frequently emptying

4.2.6 Pet Hair Roller

- Attach the pet hair roller to the hose.
- Roll the tool over carpets, rugs, and upholstery to pick up embedded pet hair. The vacuum will collect the hair from the roller.

4.2.7 Bath Brush and Dog Nail Grinder

- These tools are designed for specific grooming tasks. Refer to their individual instructions for optimal use.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures the longevity and optimal performance of your grooming kit.

5.1 Emptying the Dust Box

1. Ensure the device is powered off and unplugged.
2. Locate the dust box on the main unit. It can be opened with one finger for non-contact cleaning.
3. Carefully remove the dust box and empty its contents into a waste bin.
4. Reattach the dust box securely to the main unit.

5.2 Cleaning Filters

The 2-stage HEPA filtration system, along with cyclone and stainless steel filters, prevents tangling and ensures efficient air purification.

1. After emptying the dust box, remove the internal filters (cyclone, stainless steel, and HEPA filters).
2. Tap the filters gently to dislodge any trapped hair or dust. For thorough cleaning, rinse washable filters under running water (check manual for specific filter types) and allow them to air dry completely before reinserting.
3. Ensure all filters are dry and correctly reinstalled before operating the device.

5.3 Cleaning Grooming Tools

1. Detach the grooming tool from the hose.
2. Remove any trapped hair from the brush bristles or trimmer blades using a small brush or your fingers.
3. Wipe down the tools with a damp cloth. Do not immerse electrical components in water.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Bunfly Pet Grooming Kit, refer to the following common problems and solutions.

6.1 Device Not Turning On

- **Check Power Connection:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the device and a working electrical outlet.
- **Power Button:** Confirm the power button on the main unit has been pressed.

6.2 Weak Suction

- **Dust Box Full:** Empty the dust box if it is full.
- **Clogged Filters:** Clean or replace the filters (cyclone, stainless steel, HEPA) as described in the Maintenance section.
- **Hose/Tool Blockage:** Check the flexible hose and the attached grooming tool for any hair blockages and clear them carefully.
- **Improper Attachment:** Ensure the hose and grooming tool are securely attached to the main unit and to each other.

6.3 Pet Discomfort with Noise

- **Gradual Introduction:** Introduce the device to your pet slowly. Start by letting them get used to the sound without grooming.
- **Lowest Suction:** Begin grooming on the lowest suction setting.
- **Positive Reinforcement:** Offer treats and praise during grooming sessions to create a positive experience.
- **Pre-brushing:** Brush your pet with a regular brush before using the vacuum grooming tools to remove some loose hair and prepare them.

6.4 Trimmer Not Cutting Effectively

- **Blade Cleanliness:** Ensure the trimmer blades are clean and free of hair buildup.
- **Blade Sharpness:** Over time, blades may dull. Note that replacement blades may not be readily available for this model (PC-C2).
- **Guide Comb:** Ensure the guide comb is correctly attached and not interfering with the blades.
