Cecotec Conga Rockstar 3000 Advance Ergowet Cordless Vacuum Cleaner User Manual

1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Cecotec Conga Rockstar 3000 Advance Ergowet 4-in-1 digital cordless vacuum cleaner. Please read these instructions carefully before first use and retain them for future reference. The Conga Rockstar 3000 Advance Ergowet is a versatile 4-in-1 cleaning device, functioning as a vertical, broom, handheld, and wet mop vacuum. It features a powerful digital Brushless motor, a specialized Jalisco brush, and the ErgoFlex system for enhanced maneuverability.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow basic safety precautions when using an electrical appliance:

- Do not use the appliance outdoors or on wet surfaces.
- Do not allow it to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with a damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not handle plug or appliance with wet hands.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce airflow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- Use extra care when cleaning on stairs.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.

- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not use without dust cup and/or filters in place.
- Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the switch is in the off-position before connecting to battery pack, picking up or carrying the appliance.
- Recharge only with the charger specified by the manufacturer.

3. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and in good condition:

- Jalisco Brush with LED lights
- Motorized Upholstery Brush
- Extendable Tube
- Elbow Connector Tube
- Flexible and Extendable Hose
- Fabric Brush
- Wall Mount Support
- 2-in-1 Wide Accessory for furniture and corners
- 2-in-1 Narrow Accessory for furniture and corners
- Water Tank with Microfiber Cloth
- Instruction Manual

4. SETUP

4.1 Assembly

1. **Main Unit Assembly:** Connect the main motor unit to the extendable tube. Ensure it clicks securely into place.
2. **Brush Attachment:** Attach the desired cleaning brush (e.g., Jaliscozo brush) to the end of the extendable tube. For handheld use, attach accessories directly to the main motor unit.
3. **Water Tank (for wet mopping):** If using the wet mopping function, fill the Water Tank with water and attach the microfiber cloth. Secure it to the main brush head as per the diagram in the manual.

4.2 Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the vacuum cleaner's lithium-ion battery. The charging time is approximately 2-3 hours for a full charge.

- Connect the charger to the charging port on the main motor unit or directly to the removable battery.
- Plug the charger into a power outlet.
- The LED display on the vacuum will indicate the charging status.

4.3 Wall Mount Installation

The included wall mount allows for convenient storage and charging.

1. Choose a suitable location near a power outlet.
2. Mark the drilling points on the wall using the wall mount as a template.
3. Drill holes and insert wall plugs (if necessary).
4. Secure the wall mount to the wall using the provided screws.
5. Hang the vacuum cleaner on the wall mount for storage and charging.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

5.1 Power On/Off and Mode Selection

1. **Power On:** Press the power button on the main motor unit to turn on the vacuum cleaner.
2. **Mode Selection:** Use the mode selection button to cycle through the four operating modes:
 - **Eco Mode:** Provides maximum battery life for light cleaning tasks.
 - **Medium Mode:** Balances efficiency and suction power for general cleaning.
 - **High Mode:** Offers maximum suction for stubborn dirt and carpets.
 - **Auto Mode:** Automatically adjusts suction power based on the detected dirt level and surface type (hard floor or carpet).
3. **Power Off:** Press the power button again to turn off the vacuum cleaner.

5.2 Using Attachments

- **Jaliscozo Brush:** Ideal for both hard floors and carpets, effectively collecting fine and coarse dirt, as well as pet hair. The integrated LED lights illuminate the cleaning path.
- **Motorized Upholstery Brush:** Use for cleaning sofas, cushions, and pet beds.
- **2-in-1 Wide/Narrow Accessories:** Suitable for cleaning corners, crevices, and delicate surfaces.

- **ErgoFlex System:** The flexible tube allows you to bend the vacuum to reach under furniture and other difficult areas without excessive bending.

5.3 Wet Mopping Function

To use the wet mopping function:

1. Fill the Water Tank with clean water. You may add a small amount of floor cleaning solution if desired.
2. Attach the microfiber cloth securely to the Water Tank.
3. Attach the Water Tank assembly to the main brush head.
4. Proceed with vacuuming as usual. The microfiber cloth will dampen the floor for simultaneous mopping.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your vacuum cleaner.

6.1 Emptying the Dust Tank

Empty the 600 ml dust tank after each use or when the MAX fill line is reached.

1. Ensure the vacuum is turned off.
2. Press the release button to detach the dust tank from the main motor unit.

3. Open the dust tank lid and empty the contents into a waste bin.
4. Close the lid and reattach the dust tank to the motor unit.

6.2 Cleaning Filters

The Cyclonic System uses filters to separate particles. Clean these regularly to maintain suction power.

1. Remove the dust tank.
2. Carefully remove the internal filters.
3. Tap the filters gently to remove loose dust. For a deeper clean, rinse them under running water.
4. Allow filters to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reinserting them. Do not use the vacuum with wet filters.

6.3 Cleaning the Jaliscozo Brush

Periodically check the brush roll for tangled hair or debris.

1. Turn off the vacuum and detach the brush head.
2. Use scissors or a brush cleaning tool to remove any tangled hair or fibers from the brush roll.
3. Wipe the brush housing with a damp cloth.

6.4 Cleaning the Water Tank and Microfiber Cloth

After wet mopping:

1. Empty any remaining water from the Water Tank.
2. Rinse the Water Tank thoroughly with clean water.
3. Remove the microfiber cloth and wash it by hand or machine (up to 60°C).
4. Allow all components to air dry completely before reassembly.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your vacuum cleaner, refer to the following table:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum does not turn on	Battery is not charged Battery not properly installed	Charge the battery fully Ensure battery is securely clicked into place
Low suction power	Dust tank is full Filters are clogged Brush roll is blocked Hose or tube is obstructed	Empty the dust tank Clean or replace filters Remove debris from brush roll Check and clear any blockages in the hose or tube
Brush roll stops spinning	Debris tangled in brush Brush head attachment not properly connected	Clean debris from brush roll Ensure brush head is securely attached
Short battery life	Using High mode frequently Battery not fully charged Battery degradation	Use Eco or Medium mode for longer runtime Ensure battery is fully charged before use Contact customer support if battery life significantly decreases over time

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Water tank leaks	Water tank not properly sealed Damage to water tank	Ensure water tank lid is securely closed and properly attached Inspect for cracks or damage; replace if necessary




