Model: GK59

1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The havit GK59 Gaming Microphone is designed for clear audio capture during gaming, streaming, and voice communication. It features a condenser microphone for high-quality sound and a versatile design for ease of use.

2. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Package Contents

2.2 Connecting the Microphone

The GK59 microphone offers versatile connectivity options for various devices.

1. **USB Connection:** Connect the provided USB cable to the USB-C port on the back of the microphone and the other end to an available USB port on your computer or gaming console. The microphone is plug-and-play and should be automatically recognized by most operating systems.
2. **3.5mm Jack Connection:** For devices supporting a 3.5mm auxiliary input, connect a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to the 3.5mm jack on the back of the microphone and to your device's audio input.

After connecting, ensure the microphone is selected as the default input device in your system's sound settings or your gaming/streaming software.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Basic Controls

The Havit GK59 features intuitive controls located on the front of the microphone body:

- **Mute Button:** Press to mute or unmute the microphone. An indicator light will typically show the mute status.
- **MIC +/- Buttons:** Adjust the microphone input sensitivity (gain). Press '+' to increase, '-' to decrease.
- **VOL +/- Buttons:** Adjust the headphone output volume for monitoring. Press '+' to increase, '-' to decrease.
- **ECHO +/- Buttons:** Adjust the echo effect level. Press '+' to increase, '-' to decrease.

3.2 Adjusting Microphone Position

The microphone is equipped with an adjustable stand, allowing you to optimize its position for best sound capture and comfort.

1. Gently hold the microphone body and the base of the stand.

2. Tilt the microphone forward or backward to achieve the desired angle. The stand's design helps reduce vibration and abnormal sounds during use.
3. Position the microphone approximately 6-12 inches (15-30 cm) from your mouth for optimal voice clarity.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Cleaning

To maintain the microphone's performance and appearance:

- Disconnect the microphone from its power source before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the exterior surfaces.
- Do not use liquid cleaners, aerosols, or solvents, as these may damage the finish or internal components.

4.2 Storage

When not in use, store the microphone in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Protect it from dust and moisture.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your havit GK59 Gaming Microphone, please refer to the following table for common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound input from microphone	Microphone not connected properly Incorrect input device selected Microphone muted	Ensure USB cable is securely connected. Check system sound settings and select GK59 as input. Press the Mute button on the microphone to unmute.
Low microphone volume	Microphone gain too low System input volume too low	Press the 'MIC +' button on the microphone. Adjust input volume in your system's sound settings.
Distorted or unclear audio	Microphone gain too high Microphone too close to mouth Environmental noise	Press the 'MIC -' button on the microphone. Adjust microphone position (6-12 inches from mouth). Reduce background noise in your environment.
No headphone monitoring sound	Headphones not connected Headphone volume too low	Ensure headphones are plugged into the 3.5mm jack. Press the 'VOL +' button on the microphone.
