Polaroid P4 Music Player Instruction Manual

INTRODUCTION

The Polaroid P4 Music Player is a powerful wireless Bluetooth speaker designed to deliver rich sound in large rooms. It features Bluetooth 5.1 connectivity, dual stereo pairing capabilities, and integration with the Polaroid Music App for enhanced control and access to curated music channels. This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, and maintaining your P4 Music Player.

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Controls and Ports

Familiarize yourself with the various controls and connection ports on your Polaroid P4 Music Player for optimal use.

- **Power Button:** Located on the top, typically red. Press and hold to power on/off.
- **Play/Pause Button:** Standard playback control.
- **Skip/Previous Track Buttons:** Navigate through your music.
- **Volume Dial:** Analog dial for precise volume adjustment.
- **Heart Button:** Used with the Polaroid Music App to save favorite songs.
- **USB-C Port:** For charging the device.
- **3.5mm AUX IN:** For wired audio connection.

SETUP

1. Charging the Speaker

Before initial use, fully charge your Polaroid P4 Music Player. The device contains a built-in Lithium Ion battery.

1. Connect the provided USB-C charging cable to the USB-C port on the speaker.
2. Connect the other end of the USB-C cable to a compatible USB power adapter (not included). For optimal charging, a Power Delivery (PD) compatible charger is recommended.
3. The charging indicator will illuminate. A full charge takes approximately 7 hours.

2. Power On/Off

- To power on, press and hold the Power button until the display activates.
- To power off, press and hold the Power button again until the display turns off.

3. Bluetooth Pairing

Connect your P4 Music Player to a Bluetooth-enabled device (smartphone, tablet, laptop) to stream audio wirelessly.

1. Ensure the speaker is powered on.
2. The speaker will automatically enter Bluetooth pairing mode, indicated by a flashing Bluetooth icon on the display.
3. On your device, navigate to Bluetooth settings and select "Polaroid P4" from the list of available devices.
4. Once connected, the Bluetooth icon on the speaker's display will become solid. The wireless range is up to 30 feet (approximately 9 meters).

4. Polaroid Music App

Enhance your experience by downloading the Polaroid Music App, available for iOS and Android devices.

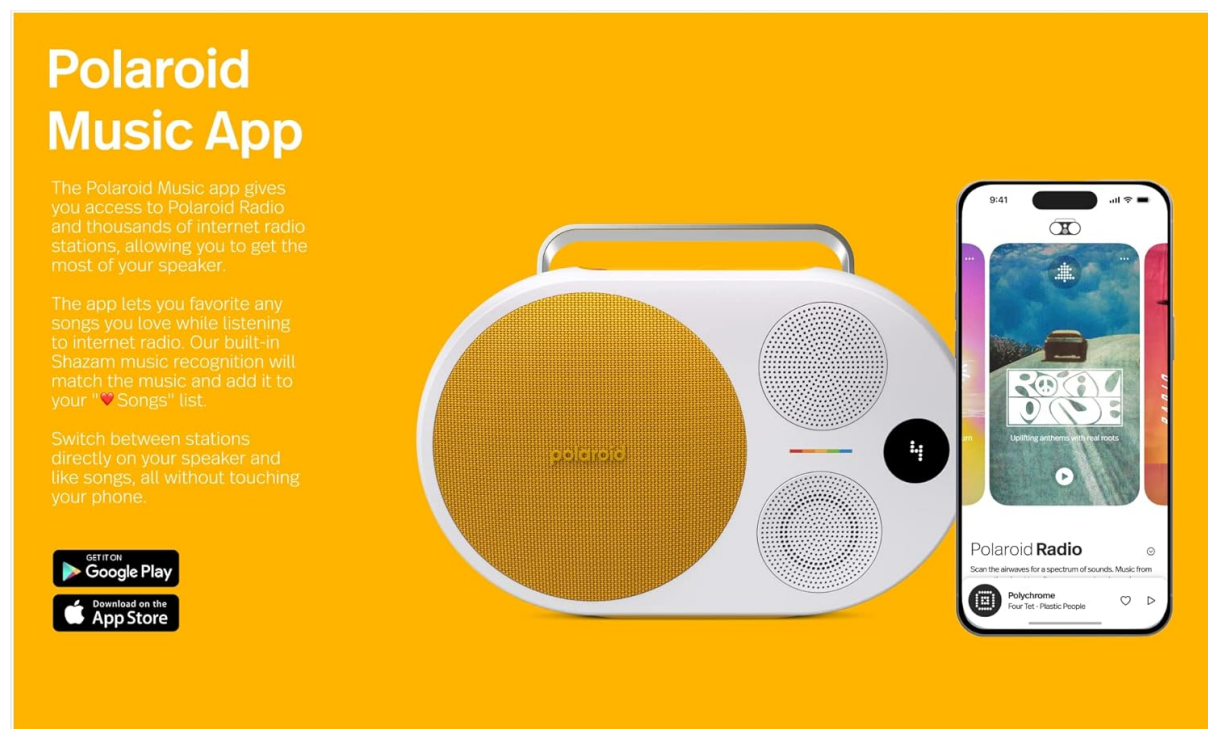


Image: A smartphone displaying the Polaroid Music App interface, positioned next to the Polaroid P4 Music Player.

- Download the app from the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
- The app allows you to control the speaker, access Polaroid Radio (a free curated internet radio service), and manage your music channels.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Basic Playback

- **Play/Pause:** Press the Play/Pause button once.
- **Adjust Volume:** Rotate the analog volume dial clockwise to increase volume, counter-clockwise to decrease.
- **Skip Tracks:** Use the Skip/Previous Track buttons to navigate.
- **AUX Input:** Connect an audio device directly using a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to the AUX IN port.

Stereo Pairing (Dual Speaker Mode)

For an immersive audio experience, you can pair two Polaroid P4 speakers together to create a stereo sound system.

1. Ensure both Polaroid P4 speakers are powered on and not connected to any other Bluetooth device.
2. Follow the instructions in the Polaroid Music App to initiate stereo pairing between the two speakers.
3. Once paired, one speaker will act as the left channel and the other as the right channel.

Using the Polaroid Music App

- **Polaroid Radio:** Access and browse various curated internet radio stations directly through the app.
- **Save Songs:** Use the Heart button on the speaker or within the app to save favorite songs. The app uses built-in Shazam music recognition to identify and add tracks to your "Songs" list.
- **Channel Switching:** Easily switch between music channels using the app or the analog dial on the

speaker.

MAINTENANCE

- **Cleaning:** Use a soft, dry cloth to clean the exterior of the speaker. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Water Resistance:** The Polaroid P4 is NOT waterproof. Avoid exposure to water or excessive moisture.
- **Storage:** Store the speaker in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures when not in use for extended periods.
- **Battery Care:** To prolong battery life, avoid fully discharging the battery frequently. Charge the speaker regularly, even if not in constant use.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Speaker does not power on.	Battery is depleted.	Connect the speaker to a power source using the USB-C cable and allow it to charge for several hours. Ensure your charger is a Power Delivery (PD) compatible type.
No sound from the speaker.	Volume is too low; device not paired; incorrect input source.	Increase the speaker's volume. Ensure your device is successfully paired via Bluetooth or connected via AUX. Check the audio output settings on your connected device.
Bluetooth pairing fails.	Speaker is already paired; device is out of range; Bluetooth on device is off.	Ensure the speaker is in pairing mode. Turn off Bluetooth on other nearby devices. Move your device closer to the speaker. Turn Bluetooth off and on again on your device.
Stereo pairing not working.	Incorrect pairing procedure; speakers too far apart.	Refer to the Polaroid Music App for detailed stereo pairing instructions. Ensure both speakers are within close proximity.


