SETUP GUIDE

This section provides step-by-step instructions for the initial setup of your iHealth Nexus Smart Scale.

Unboxing and Initial Setup

Upon opening the package, you will find the iHealth Nexus Smart Scale and its accessories. Ensure all components are present before proceeding.

Battery Installation


The iHealth Nexus Smart Scale requires 4 AAA batteries for operation. These are typically included in the package. Locate the battery compartment on the underside of the scale, open it, and insert the batteries according to the polarity indicators (+/-). Close the compartment securely.

App Download and Account Creation

To fully utilize the features of your iHealth Nexus Smart Scale, download the "iHealth MyVitals" app. This app is available on both the Apple App Store and Google Play. Follow the on-screen instructions within the app to register and set up your iHealth ID.

Keep Track Your Data

Automatically uploads your data straight to your app, can easily see your progress and sync your data with your favorite fitness apps.

Ensure your phone's Bluetooth is enabled and the iHealth Nexus scale is nearby to establish a connection with the app.

Learn how to take accurate measurements and understand the data provided by your scale.

Taking a Measurement

Place the iHealth Nexus Smart Scale on a hard, flat surface. Avoid soft surfaces like carpet or linoleum, as this may affect measurement accuracy. Step onto the scale with bare, dry feet. Being barefoot is essential for the bio-impedance sensors to accurately measure your body composition metrics. The scale will display your weight, and the app will provide detailed body composition data.

Understanding Your Data

The iHealth Nexus Smart Scale provides 9 essential body composition metrics to help you better understand your health. These include:

- Weight (kg, lb, st)
- Body Fat
- Body Water
- Muscle Mass
- Lean Mass
- Bone Mass
- Body Mass Index (BMI)
- Daily Caloric Intake (DCI)
- Visceral Fat Rating




An infographic illustrating the nine essential body metrics measured by the iHealth Nexus Smart Scale, including weight, BMI, body fat, and muscle mass.

Multi-User Functionality

The iHealth Nexus Smart Scale is designed for multi-user households, automatically identifying up to 8 users. After initial syncing with each user's smartphone, the scale intelligently recognizes who is weighing themselves, providing personalized weight history and data tracking for each individual.

Unlimited Users

1 scale for whole family, support for adding 8 users. The system is even clever enough to know if you forget to change if there is a major weigh difference from the last weighing.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

To ensure the longevity and accuracy of your iHealth Nexus Smart Scale, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning:** Wipe the scale's surface with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or immerse the scale in water.
- Storage:** Store the scale in a dry place at room temperature. Avoid extreme temperatures or direct sunlight.
- Battery Replacement:** Replace all 4 AAA batteries when the low battery indicator appears on the display.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

If you encounter any issues with your iHealth Nexus Smart Scale, refer to the table below for common problems and their solutions.

Problem	Solution
Scale not turning on	Check if batteries are installed correctly and are not depleted. Replace if necessary.
Inaccurate readings	Ensure the scale is placed on a hard, flat surface. Avoid carpets or uneven flooring. Make sure your feet are bare and dry when stepping on the scale.
App not syncing data	Verify that Bluetooth is enabled on your smartphone and the scale is within range. Close and reopen the iHealth MyVitals app. If the issue persists, try restarting your phone.
Scale not recognizing multiple users	Ensure each user has created their profile in the iHealth MyVitals app and has synced their initial measurement. The scale recognizes users based on their weight history.
