# Eureka Forbes Atom Vacuum Cleaner User Manual

## 1. INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your new Eureka Forbes Atom Vacuum Cleaner. This appliance is designed for efficient home cleaning with powerful suction and versatile functions. Please read this manual thoroughly before operating the appliance to ensure safe and proper use, and keep it for future reference.



## 2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

---

Always follow basic safety precautions when using electrical appliances to reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury.

- Ensure the power supply voltage matches the rating indicated on the appliance.
- Do not use the vacuum cleaner on wet surfaces or to pick up liquids.
- Do not pick up flammable or combustible materials, hot ashes, or sharp objects.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of the body away from openings and moving parts.
- Unplug from the outlet when not in use and before cleaning or servicing.
- Do not operate with a damaged cord or plug.
- This appliance is for household use only.

## 3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW AND COMPONENTS

---

The Eureka Forbes Atom is a versatile 2-in-1 vacuum cleaner, functioning as both a handheld and a stick vacuum. It also features a blower function.

### 3.1 Main Unit

- **Motor Unit:** Contains the 600 Watts motor for powerful suction and blower functions.
- **Dust Tank:** Transparent container for collecting dust and debris. Capacity: 0.5 litres.
- **Washable Filter:** A reusable filter designed for easy cleaning and maintenance.
- **Power Cord:** For connecting to an electrical outlet.

## 3.2 Included Accessories

The appliance comes with 7 accessories to facilitate various cleaning tasks:

- **Extension Tubes:** Used to extend the reach for cleaning high ceilings or difficult-to-reach areas.
- **2-in-1 Brush (Crevice Nozzle and Brush):** A versatile tool for cleaning narrow gaps and dusting surfaces.
- **Inflator for Blower:** An attachment for the blower function, useful for inflating toys or blowing away dust.
- **Upholstery Cleaner:** Designed for cleaning soft surfaces like mattresses, carpets, and curtains.
- **Floor Cum Carpet Brush:** A brush that can be toggled for use on bare floors or carpets/rugs, providing a mild polishing effect.
- **Canister:** The main body of the vacuum cleaner.
- **HEPA Filter:** (Note: Specifications mention "Hepa Filter" but also "Washable Filter". Assuming the washable filter is a type of HEPA or similar high-efficiency filter.)

## 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

The Eureka Forbes Atom can be assembled into a stick vacuum or used as a handheld unit.

### 4.1 Assembling as a Stick Vacuum

1. Insert the extension tubes firmly into the main motor unit's suction inlet until it clicks into place.
2. Attach the Floor Cum Carpet Brush to the end of the extension tubes. Ensure it is securely fastened.
3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

### 4.2 Using as a Handheld Vacuum

1. For handheld use, directly attach the desired accessory (e.g., 2-in-1 brush, upholstery cleaner, or inflator) to the suction inlet of the main motor unit.
2. Ensure the accessory is securely attached before operation.
3. Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Before operating, ensure the dust tank and filter are correctly installed and empty.

## 5.1 Powering On/Off

- To turn on the vacuum cleaner, press the power button located on the main unit.
- To turn off, press the power button again.

## 5.2 Suction Function

The vacuum utilizes cyclonic technology for consistent suction power.

- Select the appropriate accessory for the surface you are cleaning.
- Move the vacuum cleaner slowly over the area to be cleaned, allowing the suction to pick up dust and debris.
- For optimal performance, ensure the dust tank is not overfilled.

## 5.3 Blower Function

The vacuum cleaner also features a blower function for dislodging dust from hard-to-reach areas or for inflating small items.

- Attach the Inflator for Blower accessory to the blower outlet (typically located at the rear of the main unit).
- Direct the airflow towards the area where dust needs to be dislodged or the item to be inflated.
- Exercise caution when using the blower function, as it can disperse dust into the air.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

---

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your vacuum cleaner.

### 6.1 Emptying the Dust Tank

- Unplug the vacuum cleaner from the power outlet.
- Locate the dust tank release button or latch.
- Carefully detach the dust tank from the main unit.
- Position the dust tank over a waste bin and open the bottom flap to empty the contents.
- Reattach the dust tank securely to the main unit.

## 6.2 Cleaning the Washable Filter

- After emptying the dust tank, remove the washable filter.
- Rinse the filter under running water until clean. Do not use detergents.
- Allow the filter to air dry completely for at least 24 hours before reinserting it into the vacuum cleaner. Ensure it is completely dry to prevent damage to the motor.
- Regularly check the filter for any damage and replace if necessary.

## 6.3 General Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the vacuum cleaner with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners.
- Periodically check accessories for blockages and clean as needed.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Vacuum cleaner does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet faulty; power button not pressed.	Check power cord connection; test outlet with another appliance; press power button firmly.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Low suction power.	Dust tank full; filter clogged; hose/accessory blocked.	Empty dust tank; clean or replace filter; check and clear blockages in hose/accessories.
Motor heats up quickly.	Prolonged use; clogged filter/dust tank.	Allow the unit to cool down; ensure dust tank is empty and filter is clean. Avoid continuous operation for extended periods.
Unusual noise during operation.	Foreign object in brush roll or hose; motor issue.	Turn off and unplug; inspect brush roll and hose for obstructions and remove them. If noise persists, contact customer service.
