INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your replacement remote control for various Aiwa Compact Disc Carry Component Stereo Audio Systems. This remote is designed as an infrared replacement. Please ensure your original remote matches the appearance of this replacement for optimal compatibility.

SETUP

Battery Installation

The remote control requires **two (2) AA batteries** (not included).

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the remote control.
2. Slide the battery compartment cover downwards or in the direction indicated by an arrow to open it.
3. Insert two AA batteries, ensuring the positive (+) and negative (-) terminals align correctly with the markings inside the compartment.
4. Close the battery compartment cover by sliding it back into place until it clicks securely.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

General Use

This remote control is an infrared (IR) replacement. Point the remote directly at the IR receiver on your Aiwa stereo system. Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the stereo system.

Key Functions

- **POWER:** Turns the stereo system on or off.
- **VOLUME +/-:** Adjusts the audio output level.
- **PLAY/PAUSE:** Starts or pauses playback of audio.
- **SKIP/SEARCH:** Navigates between tracks or fast-forwards/rewinds within a track.
- **Numerical Buttons (0-9, +10):** For direct track selection or input.

- **FUNCTION:** Selects different audio sources or modes (e.g., CD, Radio, MD).
- **DISPLAY/CHARACTER:** Changes display information or enters characters.
- **ENTER:** Confirms selections.
- **MD EDIT/REC:** Functions related to MiniDisc recording and editing (if applicable to your system).

Note on Compatibility: This is a replacement remote. While designed to be compatible, it may not offer all the exact same functions as your original remote. Refer to your stereo system's original manual for specific functions if needed.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning

To clean the remote control, wipe it with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays, as these can damage the surface or internal components.

Battery Replacement

Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or stops working. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new AA batteries. Do not mix old and new batteries, or different types of batteries. Remove batteries if the remote will not be used for an extended period to prevent leakage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Remote not responding:**
 - Check if batteries are inserted correctly with the correct polarity.
 - Replace old batteries with new ones.
 - Ensure there are no obstructions between the remote and the stereo system's IR receiver.
 - Confirm you are pointing the remote directly at the stereo system.
- **Some functions not working:**
 - This remote is a replacement and may not support all functions of your original remote. Verify if the specific function was present on the original remote and if this replacement is designed to support it.
 - Ensure your stereo system model is listed as compatible.
- **Interference:**
 - Strong light sources (like direct sunlight or fluorescent lights) can interfere with IR signals. Try operating the remote in a different lighting condition.





