INTRODUCTION

Welcome to the user manual for your Timex Men's X Pan Am Chronograph 42mm Watch. This timepiece combines classic design with modern functionality, paying homage to the golden age of aviation. This manual provides essential information on setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your watch to ensure its longevity and accurate performance.

SETUP

Initial Setup and Time/Date Adjustment

Upon receiving your watch, you may need to set the correct time and date.

1. Setting the Time:

- Pull the crown (the knob on the side of the watch) out to position 2 (the outermost position).
- Turn the crown clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the hour and minute hands to the desired time.
- Push the crown back into position 0 (normal operating position) to start the watch.

2. Setting the Date:

- Pull the crown out to position 1 (the middle position).
- Turn the crown clockwise to adjust the date.
- Once the correct date is displayed, push the crown back into position 0.
- *Note: Avoid setting the date between 9 PM and 3 AM, as this can damage the date mechanism. If you need to set the date during this period, first set the time outside this window, adjust the date, then reset the time.*

OPERATING YOUR WATCH

Chronograph Function

Your Timex X Pan Am Chronograph features a precise chronograph function for measuring elapsed time.

1. **Starting the Chronograph:** Press the top pusher (button) located at the 2 o'clock position. The chronograph second hand will begin to move.
2. **Stopping the Chronograph:** Press the top pusher again to stop the chronograph. The elapsed time will be indicated by the chronograph hands.
3. **Resetting the Chronograph:** After stopping, press the bottom pusher (button) located at the 4 o'clock position to reset all chronograph hands to their zero positions.

Water Resistance

This watch is water resistant up to 50 meters (164 feet). This means it is suitable for short periods of recreational swimming, but not for diving or snorkeling.

- Do not operate the crown or pushers when the watch is wet or submerged in water.
- Avoid exposing the watch to hot water, steam, or sudden temperature changes, as this can compromise the water resistance seals.
- After exposure to saltwater, rinse the watch with fresh water and dry it thoroughly.

MAINTENANCE

General Care

- Clean your watch regularly with a soft, dry cloth. For stubborn dirt, a slightly damp cloth can be used, followed by immediate drying.
- Avoid contact with chemicals such as solvents, detergents, perfumes, and cosmetics, as these can damage the watch case, strap, or seals.
- Protect your watch from extreme temperatures, direct sunlight for prolonged periods, and strong magnetic fields.

- Store your watch in a cool, dry place when not in use, preferably in its original box or a watch case.

Strap Care

The leather strap on your Timex watch is designed for comfort and durability.

- Avoid prolonged exposure to water, sweat, and direct sunlight, which can cause the leather to dry out, crack, or fade.
- If the strap gets wet, gently pat it dry with a soft cloth and allow it to air dry naturally, away from direct heat.
- Periodically clean the strap with a leather-specific cleaner and conditioner to maintain its suppleness and appearance.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your watch, please refer to the following common problems and solutions before seeking professional service.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Watch stops or runs intermittently.	Low battery.	Replace the battery. This should be done by a qualified watch technician.
Date changes at noon instead of midnight.	AM/PM setting is incorrect.	Advance the time by 12 hours.
Chronograph hands do not reset to zero.	Minor misalignment.	Consult the full instruction manual for specific chronograph hand calibration steps, or seek professional service.
Condensation inside the crystal.	Compromised water resistance.	Immediately take the watch to a qualified service center. Do not attempt to dry it yourself.
