1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the setup, operation, and maintenance of your BINNIFA Play 6D Sound Bar. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the product to ensure proper function and to maximize your audio experience. Keep this manual for future reference.

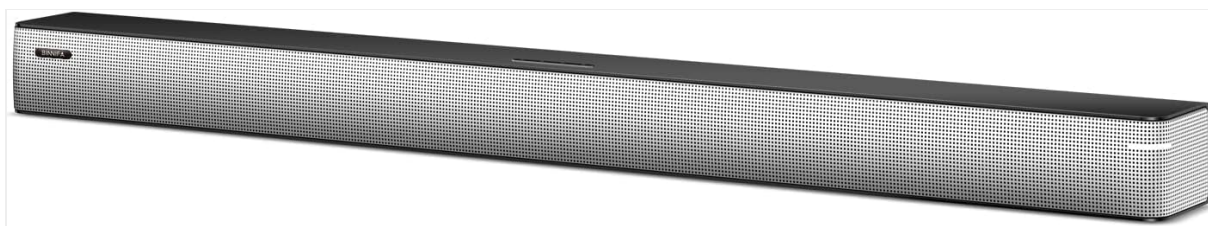


Image 1.1: The BINNIFA Play 6D Sound Bar, a sleek, silver-colored audio device designed to enhance television sound.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Do not expose the sound bar to rain, moisture, or extreme temperatures.
- Ensure proper ventilation around the unit to prevent overheating.
- Do not open the casing; refer all servicing to qualified personnel.
- Use only the provided power adapter.
- Keep the sound bar away from strong magnetic fields.

4. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

5. SETUP

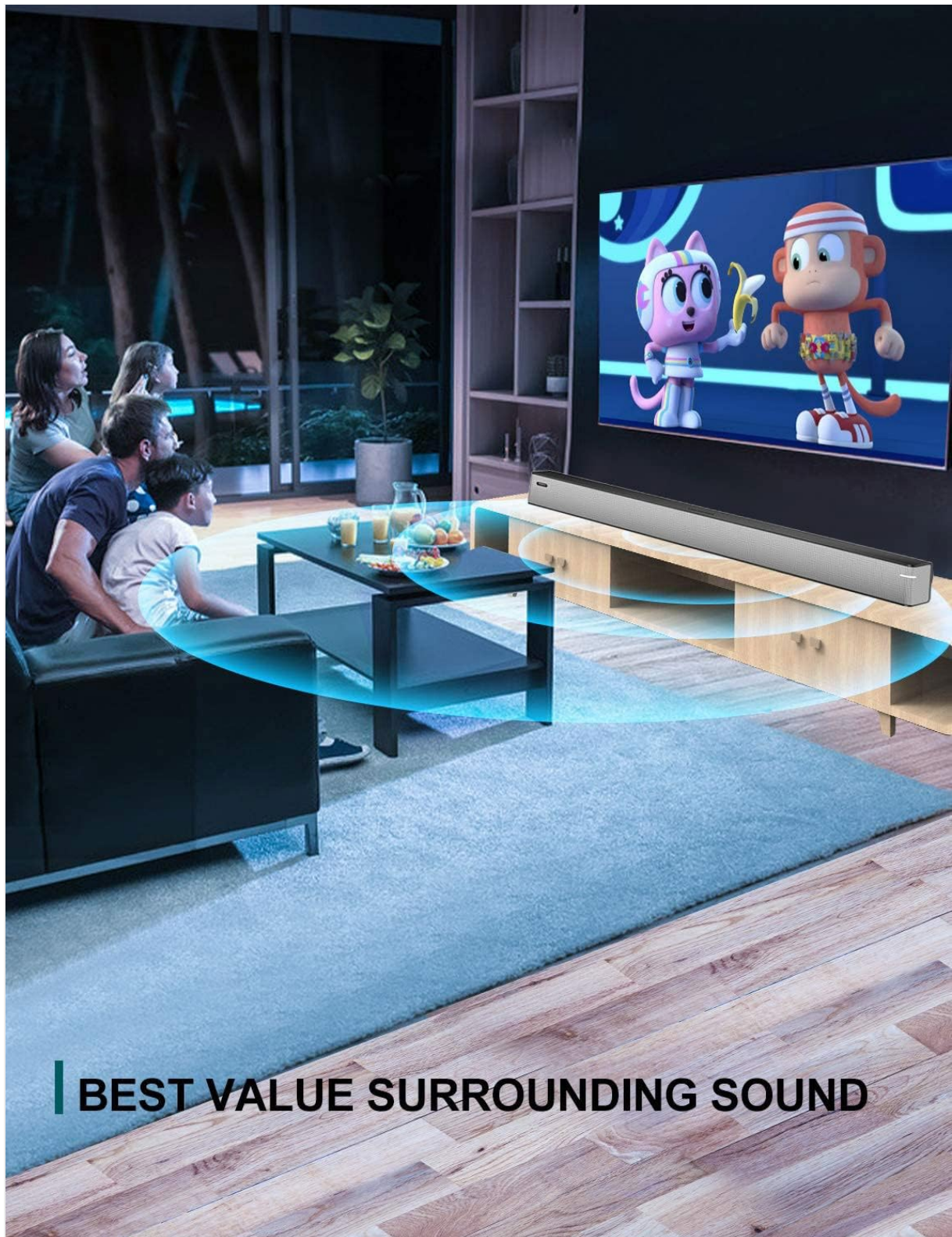
5.1 Placement Options

The BINNIFA Play 6D Sound Bar offers flexible placement options:

- **Tabletop Placement:** Place the sound bar on a flat, stable surface directly in front of your television. Ensure it does not obstruct the TV's remote sensor.
- **Wall Mounting:** Use the included wall mounting kits to attach the sound bar to a wall below your television. Refer to the wall mounting template for precise drilling locations.

5.2 Connecting to Your TV or Audio Source

The sound bar supports multiple connection types. Choose the method that best suits your television or audio device.

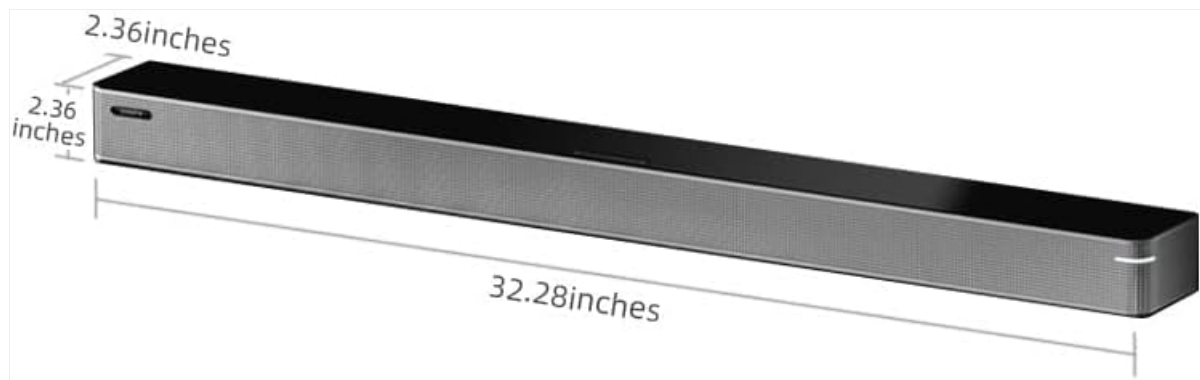


Image 5.3: A diagram illustrating the available connection methods: HDMI ARC, USB Media, and Bluetooth.

1. HDMI ARC Connection (Recommended):

- Connect one end of an HDMI cable (not included) to the HDMI ARC port on your TV.
- Connect the other end to the **HDMI ARC** port on the sound bar.
- Ensure your TV's HDMI ARC function is enabled in its settings.

2. Optical Connection:

- Connect the included optical cable to the **OPT** port on the sound bar.
- Connect the other end to the optical digital audio output port on your TV.
- Set your TV's audio output to 'Optical' or 'PCM'.

3. AUX Connection:

- Connect a 3.5mm audio cable (not included) to the **AUX** port on the sound bar.
- Connect the other end to the headphone jack or AUX output on your TV or audio device.

4. USB Connection:

- Insert a USB flash drive containing audio files into the **USB** port on the sound bar.
- The sound bar will automatically switch to USB mode and begin playback.

5. Coaxial Connection:

- Connect a coaxial cable (not included) to the **COX** port on the sound bar.
- Connect the other end to the coaxial digital audio output port on your TV.

5.3 Power Connection

Connect the AC power adapter to the **DC IN** port on the sound bar, then plug the adapter into a wall outlet.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Power On/Off

Press the **Power** button on the remote control or on the sound bar to turn the unit on or off.

6.2 Input Selection

Press the **Input** button on the remote control to cycle through the available input sources: HDMI ARC, Optical, AUX, USB, and Bluetooth.

6.3 Bluetooth Pairing

To connect a Bluetooth device:

1. Turn on the sound bar and select Bluetooth mode using the **Input** button. The indicator light will flash.

2. Enable Bluetooth on your mobile device (smartphone, tablet, etc.).
3. Search for available devices and select "BINNIFA Play 6D" from the list.
4. Once paired, the indicator light on the sound bar will stop flashing and remain solid.

6.4 Sound Modes

The sound bar features three optimized sound modes:

- **Music Mode:** Ideal for pop music, providing balanced audio.
- **Movie Mode:** Enhances movie and TV show audio with heavy bass for an immersive experience.
- **News Mode:** Optimizes vocal clarity for news broadcasts and talk shows.

Press the corresponding button on the remote control to switch between modes.

6.5 Volume Control

Use the **Volume Up (+)** and **Volume Down (-)** buttons on the remote control or on the sound bar to adjust the volume level.

7. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and performance of your sound bar:

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the surface of the sound bar with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Storage:** If storing the unit for an extended period, disconnect it from power and store it in a cool, dry place.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure that the vents are not blocked to prevent overheating.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your BINNIFA Play 6D Sound Bar, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from the sound bar.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sound bar not powered on.• Incorrect input source selected.• Volume too low or muted.• Incorrect TV audio output settings.• Loose audio cable connection.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Ensure the sound bar is powered on.• Select the correct input source (HDMI ARC, Optical, AUX, etc.).• Increase volume or unmute.• Check TV audio settings (e.g., set to PCM for Optical).• Securely connect all audio cables.
Bluetooth device cannot pair.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Sound bar not in Bluetooth mode.• Device too far from sound bar.• Bluetooth on device is off.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Switch the sound bar to Bluetooth mode.• Ensure the device is within 10 meters of the sound bar.• Enable Bluetooth on your device and retry pairing.
Remote control not working.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Batteries are depleted.• Obstruction between remote and sound bar.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Replace batteries in the remote control.• Ensure a clear line of sight to the sound bar's sensor.

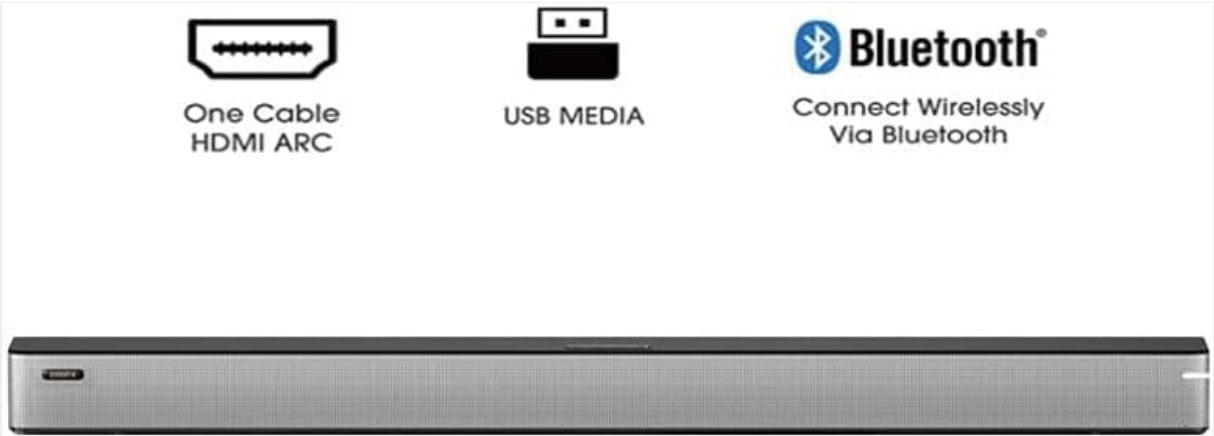




Image 9.1: Diagram illustrating the dimensions of the sound bar: approximately 32.28 inches long, 2.36 inches deep, and 2.36 inches high.
