INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing HOOBRO Bar Stools. This manual provides essential information for the safe assembly, operation, and maintenance of your new bar stools. Please read these instructions carefully before beginning assembly and retain them for future reference.

SAFETY INFORMATION

Exceeding the recommended maximum weight of 265 pounds could result in tipping. Use footrests carefully to avoid tripping hazards. Keep liquids away from the stool to prevent slipping.

Always ensure all screws and bolts are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten fasteners as needed. Do not stand on the stools. Use on a flat, stable surface.

PACKAGE CONTENTS

Before assembly, verify that all components listed below are present:

- 1 x Accessory Kit (contains screws, washers, etc.)
- 1 x Allen Key
- 1 x Instructions Manual

- 2 x Bar Stool (disassembled components)

ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly is straightforward and typically takes approximately 20 minutes. Follow the step-by-step instructions provided in the included instruction manual. Ensure all parts are correctly oriented before tightening screws.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

These bar stools are designed for seating at counter height surfaces. The integrated footrests provide comfort and support. The footrests are positioned at two different heights (8.7 inches and 11 inches) to accommodate various user

preferences.

To ensure stability, always sit centrally on the stool. Avoid sudden movements or leaning excessively to one side.

MAINTENANCE

To maintain the appearance and longevity of your HOOBRO Bar Stools, wipe them with a damp cloth. Avoid using harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, as these may damage the particleboard seat or metal frame. Ensure the stools are completely dry after cleaning.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Stool feels wobbly:** Check all screws and bolts. Re-tighten any loose fasteners. Ensure the stool is on a level surface. The adjustable feet can be used to compensate for uneven floors.
- **Difficulty with assembly:** Refer to the detailed assembly instructions provided in the package. Ensure all parts are

oriented correctly. Do not overtighten screws initially; tighten them fully once all parts are loosely assembled.

- **Scratches on floor:** Ensure the adjustable feet pads are properly installed and intact. Replace if worn.
