# Graco EezeFold Stroller Instruction Manual

Model: GS1112SAMDN000

## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for the safe and proper use, assembly, and maintenance of your Graco EezeFold Stroller. Please read all instructions carefully before assembly and use. Keep this manual for future reference. The Graco EezeFold Stroller is designed to be lightweight and compact, suitable for newborns up to approximately 3 years of age (0-15 kg). It features a one-hand fold mechanism and 4-wheel suspension for ease of use and comfort.

## 2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- **WARNING:** Never leave your child unattended in the stroller.
- **WARNING:** Ensure all locking devices are engaged before use.
- **WARNING:** Do not overload the storage basket. Maximum weight for the basket is typically 4.5 kg (10 lbs).
- **WARNING:** Always use the harness system. Ensure it is correctly fitted and adjusted.
- **WARNING:** This product is not suitable for running or skating.
- **WARNING:** The parking brake must be engaged when placing and removing the child.
- **WARNING:** Any load attached to the handle affects the stability of the stroller.
- Ensure your child is clear of any moving parts when making adjustments.
- Do not use accessories not approved by the manufacturer.
- The stroller is suitable for children from birth up to 15 kg.

## 3. COMPONENTS LIST

Before assembly, verify that all parts are present:

- Stroller Frame with Seat Fabric
- Canopy
- Front Wheels (2)
- Rear Wheels (2)
- Bumper Bar

- Instruction Manual

## 4. SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

---

### 4.1 Unfolding the Stroller

1. Place the folded stroller on a flat surface.
2. Release the folding latch, usually located on the side of the frame.
3. Lift the handle upwards until the frame clicks into its fully open position. Ensure all locking mechanisms are securely engaged.

## 4.2 Attaching the Wheels

1. Insert the front wheel assemblies into the designated slots on the front legs of the stroller until they click securely into place.
2. Attach the rear wheels to the rear axle by pushing them firmly until they lock.
3. Pull on each wheel to ensure it is securely attached.

## 4.3 Attaching the Bumper Bar

Align the bumper bar with the attachment points on either side of the seat and push until it clicks into place. Ensure it is firmly attached before use.

## 4.4 Attaching the Canopy

Slide the canopy attachments onto the frame until they are secure. Extend the canopy as desired.

## 5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

### 5.1 Folding the Stroller

The EezeFold stroller features a one-hand compact fold. Locate the folding mechanism (often a button or lever on the handle or frame). Activate the mechanism and push the handle downwards to collapse the stroller. Ensure the stroller is fully folded and the auto-lock engages for compact storage.

## 5.2 Adjusting the Seat Recline

The multi-position recline adjusts smoothly with one hand. Locate the recline lever or strap mechanism behind the seat. Squeeze the lever or adjust the strap to achieve the desired recline position, from upright to lie-flat, suitable for newborns.

### **5.3 Using the 5-Point Harness**

Always secure your child with the 5-point harness. Place the child in the seat, bring the shoulder straps over their shoulders, and the waist straps around their hips. Insert the buckle tongues into the buckle housing until they click. Adjust the straps for a snug fit, ensuring two fingers can fit between the strap and your child's shoulder.

### **5.4 Engaging the Brakes**

To engage the parking brake, press down firmly on the brake pedal located near the rear wheels. Ensure both wheels are locked. To release, lift the pedal upwards. Always engage the brake when the stroller is stationary.

### **5.5 Adjusting the Calf Support**



The calf support can be adjusted to provide comfort for your growing child. Locate the adjustment buttons or levers on the sides of the calf support and move it to the desired position.

### 5.6 Travel System Compatibility

The Graco EezeFold Stroller is compatible with Graco SnugEssentials i-Size infant car seats, allowing it to transform into a travel system. The car seat attaches securely with a single click, without the need for additional adapters. (Infant car seat sold separately).

## 6. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the stroller fabric with a damp cloth and mild detergent. Do not use bleach. Allow to air dry completely.
- **Frame Care:** Wipe the frame with a soft, damp cloth. Dry thoroughly.
- **Wheel Maintenance:** Regularly check wheels for wear and tear. Remove any debris that may be caught in the wheel mechanisms. Lubricate moving parts with a silicone-based lubricant if necessary.
- **Storage:** Store the stroller in a dry, well-ventilated area, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Inspections:** Periodically check all fasteners, rivets, and components to ensure they are secure and not damaged. Replace worn or broken parts immediately.

## 7. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stroller does not fold easily.	Folding mechanism not fully disengaged; debris in mechanism.	Ensure all levers/buttons are pressed correctly. Clear any obstructions. Refer to Section 5.1.
Wheels squeak or are stiff.	Lack of lubrication; dirt/debris in wheel bearings.	Clean wheels and axles. Apply a silicone-based lubricant to moving parts.
Harness is difficult to buckle/unbuckle.	Buckle is dirty or misaligned.	Clean the buckle mechanism. Ensure buckle tongues are inserted correctly.
Stroller pulls to one side.	Uneven tire pressure (if applicable); bent wheel axle; uneven weight distribution.	Check wheel alignment. Ensure weight is evenly distributed. Inspect for damage.
