1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing the GDLF Record Player Stand. This versatile furniture piece is designed to store your record player, vinyl collection, and other media essentials, while also providing convenient power outlets. Its mid-century modern design with a brown wood grain body, matte black sliding door, and solid wood legs will complement various home decors. Please read this manual carefully before assembly and use to ensure proper setup and longevity of your product.

2. SAFETY INFORMATION

- Keep all small parts and packaging materials away from children and pets.
- Ensure all screws and fasteners are securely tightened before use. Periodically check and re-tighten as needed.
- Do not overload the stand. Refer to the specifications for weight limits.
- Place the stand on a flat, stable surface to prevent tipping.
- Do not expose the product to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures, or high humidity.
- When using the built-in power outlets, ensure connected devices do not exceed the rated electrical capacity.
- Avoid placing hot items directly on the surface without protection.

4. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Assembly typically requires two people and a Phillips head screwdriver (not included). Follow these steps carefully:

- Unpack and Identify Parts:** Lay out all components on a clean, soft surface (like a blanket or carpet) to prevent scratches. Compare with the "Package Contents" list.
- Attach Legs:** Secure the four solid wood legs to the bottom panel of the stand using the provided screws. Ensure they are tightened firmly.
- Assemble Frame:** Connect the side panels to the bottom panel and the fixed internal shelves using cam locks and dowels. Follow the pre-drilled holes.
- Install Power Outlet Unit:** Carefully insert the power outlet unit into its designated slot on the middle shelf. Secure it with screws if applicable. Route the power cord through the pre-drilled hole at the back.
- Insert Iron Dividers:** Place the iron dividers into the lower left compartment to create sections for vinyl records.
- Attach Top Panel:** Secure the top panel to the assembled frame using cam locks and dowels.
- Install Sliding Doors:** Carefully slide the matte black doors into their respective tracks. Ensure they move smoothly.
- Attach Leather Handles:** Secure the leather handles to the sliding doors using the provided screws.
- Final Check:** Once assembled, gently lift and move the stand to its desired location. Ensure all connections are secure and the stand is stable.

5. SETUP AND PLACEMENT

- **Location:** Choose a flat, level surface in your living room, bedroom, or office. Ensure there is adequate space around the stand for easy access to records and devices.
- **Record Player Placement:** Place your record player on the spacious top surface. The tabletop measures approximately 18.89" x 14.37", suitable for most record players.
- **Cable Management:** Utilize the pre-drilled holes at the back of the stand to route power cords and audio cables neatly, preventing tangles and ensuring a clean setup.
- **Power Connection:** Plug the stand's power cord into a standard wall outlet.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

- **Using Power Outlets:** The built-in power strip features 2 USB ports and 2 standard AC outlets. Connect your record player, smartphone, or other electronic devices for convenient power access.
- **Vinyl Storage:** The stand offers ample storage for up to 350 vinyl albums. The open top section allows for easy access to frequently played records. The lower left compartment with iron dividers helps organize your collection.
- **Sliding Door:** The matte black sliding door provides privacy and conceals items stored in the lower right compartment, reducing visual clutter. Gently slide the door along its track to open or close.
- **Additional Storage:** The middle shelf can accommodate smaller items such as speakers, headphones, or other media accessories. The hidden storage behind the sliding door is ideal for less frequently accessed items.

7. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Wipe surfaces with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals or abrasive cleaners, which can damage the finish.
- **Dusting:** Regularly dust the stand to prevent buildup, especially around the power outlets and record player

area.

- **Spills:** Immediately wipe up any spills to prevent water damage or staining.
- **Hardware Check:** Periodically inspect all screws and fasteners to ensure they remain tight. Re-tighten if necessary to maintain stability.
- **Sliding Door Maintenance:** If the sliding door becomes stiff, clean the tracks to remove any dust or debris. A small amount of silicone spray can be applied to the tracks if needed, but avoid oil-based lubricants.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Stand is wobbly/unstable	Loose screws; uneven floor.	Ensure all assembly screws are tightened. Adjust leg levelers if present, or place shims under legs on uneven surfaces.
Sliding door is stiff or sticks	Debris in track; misaligned track.	Clean the sliding tracks thoroughly. Check if the door is properly seated in the track. Avoid forcing the door.
Power outlets not working	Not plugged in; circuit breaker tripped; faulty unit.	Ensure the stand's power cord is securely plugged into a working wall outlet. Check your home's circuit breaker. If issues persist, contact customer support.
Records don't fit perfectly in divided section	Oversized box sets or albums.	The divided section is designed for standard vinyl albums. Larger box sets may need to be stored in the hidden compartment or on the top surface.
