1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the YougetTech EH18 6L Evaporative Humidifier. This manual provides essential information for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your new humidifier. Please read this manual thoroughly before use and retain it for future reference.

The YougetTech EH18 is designed to add moisture to the air through a natural evaporation process, which helps alleviate issues caused by dry air without producing a visible mist or white dust. It is suitable for large rooms, covering up to 1000 sq.ft, and features a 6-liter water tank for extended operation.

2. SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To reduce the risk of fire, electric shock, or injury, always follow these basic safety precautions:

- Read all instructions before using the humidifier.
- Place the humidifier on a firm, level, water-resistant surface at least 6 inches (15 cm) away from walls and appliances.
- Do not place the humidifier directly on carpet, as this may obstruct airflow and cause overheating.
- Always unplug the humidifier before filling, cleaning, or moving it.
- Do not immerse the humidifier in water or other liquids.
- Do not add essential oils, medications, or any additives other than water to the tank, as this may damage the unit and void the warranty.
- Keep the humidifier out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not block air vents or fan openings.
- If the power cord or plug is damaged, do not use the appliance. Contact customer support.

3. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

4. SETUP

1. **Unpack:** Carefully remove all packaging materials and place the humidifier on a stable, flat surface.
2. **Remove Water Tank:** Lift the top section of the humidifier to access the water tank and filter assembly.
3. **Fill Water Tank:** Remove the filter assembly from the water tank. Fill the 6-liter water tank with clean tap water. Do not exceed the maximum fill line.

4. **Reassemble:** Place the filter assembly back into the water tank, then carefully place the main unit back onto the water tank, ensuring it is securely seated.

5. **Connect Power:** Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet. The humidifier is now ready for operation.

5. OPERATION

The YougetTech EH18 features a touch control panel for easy operation.

5.1. Power On/Off

- Touch the power button on the control panel to turn the humidifier ON or OFF.

5.2. Adjusting Fan Speed/Humidity

- The humidifier offers 10-speed levels. Use the speed adjustment button on the touch panel to cycle through the desired fan speeds. Higher speeds will increase the humidification rate.
- The humidifier automatically adjusts its output based on the ambient humidity to maintain a comfortable level.

5.3. Sleep Mode

- Activate Sleep Mode for ultra-quiet operation, ideal for bedrooms or sensitive sleepers. In this mode, the fan typically operates at speeds 1-3.

5.4. Timer

- Use the timer function to set the humidifier to operate for a specific duration before automatically turning off.

5.5. Child Lock

- Engage the Child Lock feature to prevent accidental changes to settings by children.

6. MAINTENANCE & CLEANING

Regular cleaning is crucial for maintaining optimal performance and hygiene of your humidifier.

6.1. Evaporative Wick Filter Cleaning

- The evaporative wick filter should be cleaned regularly to prevent mineral buildup and maintain efficiency.
- Unplug the humidifier and remove the main unit and water tank.
- Remove the wick filter from its assembly.
- Rinse the filter under cool running water to remove loose mineral deposits. For stubborn buildup, soak the filter in a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water for 20-30 minutes.

- Rinse thoroughly after soaking and allow the filter to air dry completely before reinserting.

6.2. Water Tank Cleaning

- Empty any remaining water from the tank.
- Wipe the inside of the water tank with a soft cloth and mild detergent. Rinse thoroughly to remove any soap residue.
- For mineral buildup, fill the tank with a solution of equal parts white vinegar and water, let it sit for 20-30 minutes, then scrub and rinse.
- Ensure all parts are dry before reassembly.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

- **No Power:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into both the humidifier and the wall outlet. Check if the outlet is functioning.
- **Low Humidity Output:** Check if the water tank is full. Ensure the evaporative wick filter is clean and properly saturated. Increase the fan speed setting.
- **Unusual Noise:** Ensure the humidifier is placed on a flat, stable surface. Check for any obstructions in the fan or water tank.
- **Unpleasant Odor:** Clean the water tank and evaporative wick filter thoroughly. Replace the water regularly.
