## 1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential information for setting up, operating, maintaining, and troubleshooting your Amazon Fire 7 Kids Tablet (12th Generation). Please read this guide thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize your device's functionality.

## 2. WHAT'S INCLUDED

Your Amazon Fire 7 Kids Tablet package includes the following items:

- Fire 7 tablet
- Amazon Kid-Proof Case
- USB-C cable
- 5W power adapter
- Quick Start Guide

## 3. SETUP

### 3.1 Initial Charging

Before first use, fully charge your Fire 7 Kids Tablet. Connect the USB-C cable to the tablet's charging port and the 5W power adapter to a wall outlet. A full charge typically takes approximately 4 hours.

### 3.2 Powering On and Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the power button located on the side of the tablet until the Amazon logo appears.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the power button, then select "Power Off" from the on-screen options.

### 3.3 Connecting to Wi-Fi

1. After powering on, follow the on-screen prompts.

2. Select your preferred Wi-Fi network from the list.
3. Enter the Wi-Fi password if prompted.
4. Once connected, the tablet will proceed with the initial setup.

### 3.4 Amazon Kids+ Setup and Parental Controls

The Fire 7 Kids Tablet includes a 1-year subscription to Amazon Kids+ (for new subscribers) and robust parental controls. These features allow you to manage content, set educational goals, and establish time limits.

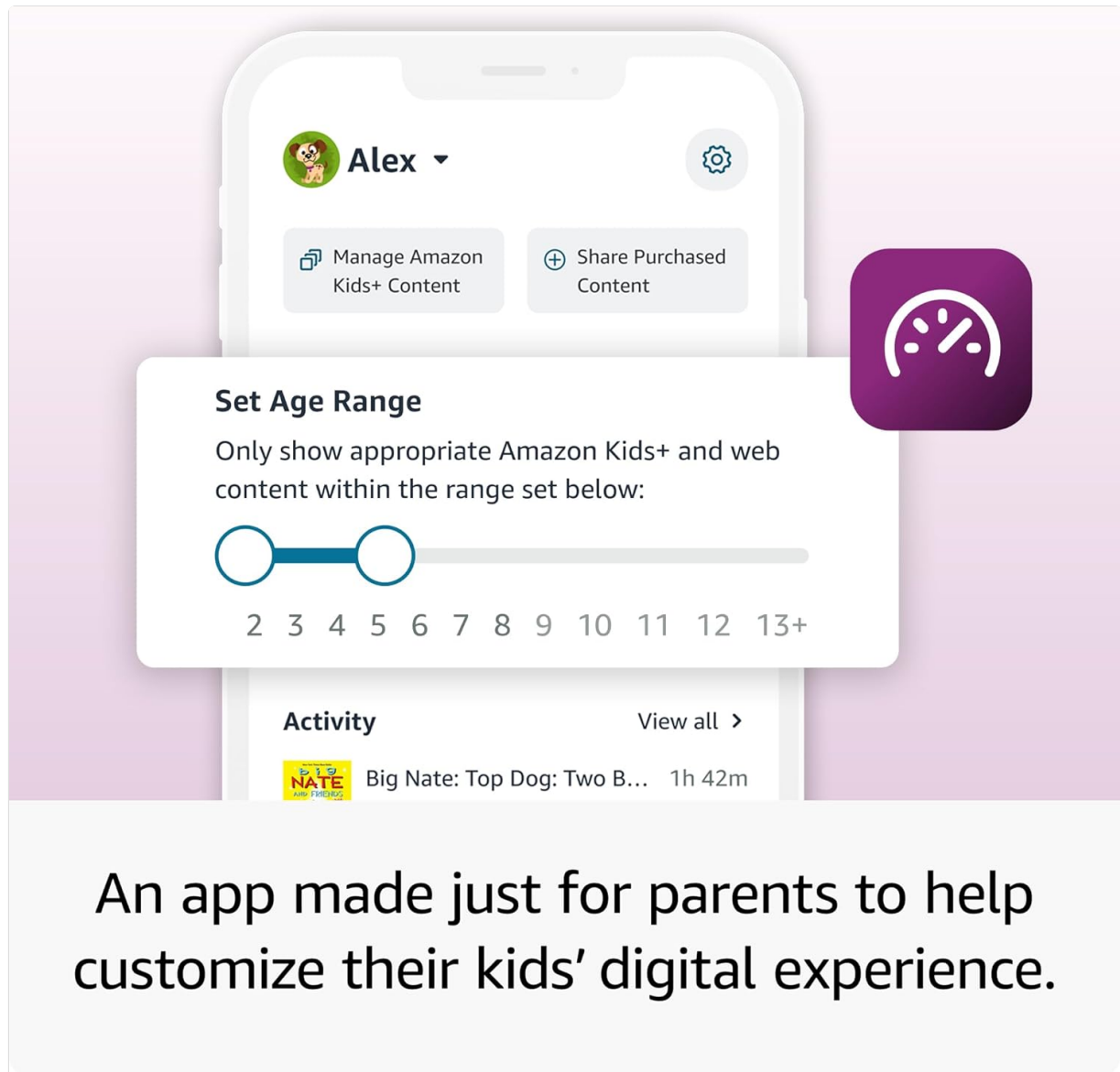


Image: The Amazon Kids+ Parent Dashboard allows setting age ranges for content and managing digital experience.

1. During initial setup, you will be guided to create a child profile or select an existing one.
2. Access the [Amazon Kids Parent Dashboard](#) from your Amazon account or directly on the tablet (requires parent password).
3. From the dashboard, you can:
  - Filter content based on your child's age.
  - Set daily time limits for tablet usage.
  - Establish educational goals.
  - Grant access to additional apps or websites.

## 4. OPERATING YOUR TABLET

### 4.1 Navigation

- **Touchscreen:** Interact with the tablet by tapping, swiping, and pinching on the screen.
- **Home Screen:** Displays favorite apps and content.
- **Back Button:** Returns to the previous screen.
- **Recent Apps:** Shows recently used applications.

### 4.2 Accessing Content (Amazon Kids+)

#### 4.3 Managing Storage

Your tablet comes with either 16 GB or 32 GB of internal storage. You can expand this by up to 1 TB using a microSD card.

- **To insert a microSD card:** Locate the microSD card slot on the side of the tablet, open the cover, and gently insert the card until it clicks into place.
- **To manage apps and content:** Go to Settings > Storage to view usage and uninstall apps or move content to the microSD card.

#### 4.4 Battery Life

The tablet offers up to 10 hours of battery life for reading, browsing, watching videos, and listening to music. Actual battery life may vary based on usage and settings.

- To conserve battery, reduce screen brightness and close unused applications.
- Charge the tablet regularly using the provided power adapter and USB-C cable.

### 5. MAINTENANCE



## 5.1 Cleaning Your Tablet

- Use a soft, lint-free cloth to clean the screen and exterior.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or aerosol sprays.
- Ensure the tablet is powered off and unplugged before cleaning.

## 5.2 Software Updates

Your Fire tablet receives automatic software security updates. Ensure your tablet is connected to Wi-Fi to receive these updates, which improve performance and security.

- To manually check for updates: Go to Settings > Device Options > System Updates.

## 5.3 Kid-Proof Case

The included Kid-Proof Case is designed to protect the tablet from drops and bumps. Keep the tablet in its case for optimal protection.

## 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

### 6.1 Tablet is Slow or Unresponsive

- **Restart the tablet:** Press and hold the power button for 40 seconds or until the tablet restarts.
- **Clear storage:** Go to Settings > Storage and clear cache or uninstall unused apps. Consider adding a microSD card for more space.
- **Close background apps:** Swipe up from the bottom of the screen (or tap the square icon) to view recent apps and swipe them away to close.

## 6.2 Battery Drains Quickly

- **Reduce screen brightness:** Adjust brightness in the Quick Settings panel (swipe down from the top).
- **Disable Wi-Fi/Bluetooth:** Turn off these features when not in use.
- **Limit background app activity:** Review app usage in Settings > Battery.
- **Ensure proper charging:** Use the included 5W power adapter and USB-C cable.

## 6.3 Cannot Access Content on Amazon Kids+

- **Check Wi-Fi connection:** Ensure the tablet is connected to a stable internet connection.
- **Verify Amazon Kids+ subscription:** Confirm your subscription is active via the Amazon Kids Parent Dashboard.
- **Review parental controls:** Ensure content filters and time limits are not preventing access.
- **Sync content:** In the Parent Dashboard, try syncing content to the tablet.

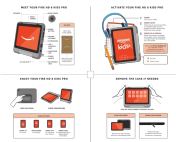
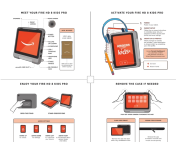
