1. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

This manual provides detailed instructions for the installation, operation, and maintenance of your Craftmade 70" DC Epic Indoor/Outdoor Damp Ceiling Fan, model DCEP70OB5. This fan features an energy-saving 6-speed reversible DC motor and includes IDC2 remote and wall controls, making it suitable for both indoor and outdoor damp locations.

2. KEY FEATURES

3. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Please read and understand all instructions before beginning installation. Improper installation or operation can lead to electric shock, fire, or personal injury. Always consult a qualified electrician if you are unsure about any part of the installation process.

- Ensure the power is disconnected at the circuit breaker before installation or servicing.
- All wiring must be in accordance with national and local electrical codes.
- The mounting structure must be capable of supporting the fan's weight (approximately 20.5 lbs).
- Do not operate the fan with damaged blades or housing.
- Keep hands, hair, and clothing clear of moving fan blades.

4. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present and undamaged before proceeding with installation.

- Set of 5 Custom Carved Scalloped Blades
- 6" Downrod
- Mounting Bracket
- IDC2 Remote Control
- Wall Control
- Hardware Pack (screws, washers, wire nuts, etc.)
- Instruction Manual

5. SETUP & INSTALLATION

5.1 Pre-Installation Checklist

- Turn off power at the circuit breaker.
- Ensure the electrical box is securely mounted and rated for ceiling fan support.
- Gather necessary tools (screwdriver, wire strippers, ladder, etc.).

5.2 Mounting the Fan

1. Attach the mounting bracket to the electrical outlet box.
2. Assemble the downrod with the motor housing.
3. Carefully lift the fan assembly and hang it from the mounting bracket.

5.3 Electrical Connections

Connect the fan's wiring to the household wiring according to the wiring diagram provided in the separate installation guide. Ensure all connections are secure and insulated with wire nuts.

5.4 Attaching the Blades

Securely attach each of the five custom carved scalloped blades to the motor housing using the provided screws. Ensure all blades are firmly attached before operation.

6. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 Using the IDC2 Remote Control

The included IDC2 remote control allows you to adjust fan speed, direction, and light (if a light kit is installed). Insert the required batteries (not included) into the remote.

- **Power Button:** Turns the fan on or off.
- **Fan Speed Buttons:** Select from 6 different fan speeds.
- **Reverse Button:** Changes the direction of the fan blades for summer (downward airflow) or winter (upward airflow) operation.
- **Light Control:** (If applicable) Turns the light on/off and dims.

6.2 Using the Wall Control

The included wall control provides an alternative method for operating your fan, offering similar functionalities to the remote control.

7. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and longevity of your ceiling fan.

- **Cleaning:** Dust the fan blades and motor housing periodically with a soft, damp cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents. The manufacturer recommends "Hand Wash" for care, implying gentle cleaning.
- **Blade Balance:** If the fan wobbles, check that all blade screws are tight and that blades are not warped. A blade balancing kit (sold separately) may be used if necessary.
- **Tighten Fasteners:** Periodically check and tighten all screws and fasteners on the fan assembly.
- **Motor Lubrication:** The DC motor is permanently lubricated and does not require additional oiling.

8. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
---------	----------------	----------

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not start.	No power to the fan; loose wire connections; remote/wall control battery dead.	Check circuit breaker; ensure all wire connections are secure; replace remote/wall control batteries.
Fan wobbles.	Loose blade screws; unbalanced blades; improper mounting.	Tighten all blade screws; use a blade balancing kit; ensure mounting bracket is secure.
Remote/Wall control not working.	Dead batteries; remote not paired; interference.	Replace batteries; refer to pairing instructions in the full installation guide; ensure no strong interference sources nearby.




