INTRODUCTION

This manual provides detailed instructions for the proper setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Discovery H2GO Privacy Shelter. Please read it thoroughly before first use to ensure safe and optimal performance.

SAFETY INFORMATION

IMPORTANT:

- Always set up this shelter in a safe, flat area away from potential hazards such as trees, power lines, and open flames.
- Do not use in high winds.
- Be cautious when using the roll-out floor to avoid tripping on the drain hole.
- Always follow manufacturer's instructions for proper setup, use, and dismantling.
- Keep away from heat sources and open flames.
- Always supervise children when using this shelter.

KEY FEATURES

- Durable 68D Polyester fabric with 1200 mm waterproof coating.
- Sturdy steel pole frame with central hub for robust support.
- Freestanding design for easy setup.
- Large zippered entry door for quick access.
- Mesh ceiling for enhanced ventilation.
- Roll-out floor with integrated drain hole for shower use.
- Built-in opening for a shower tube.
- Internal wall pockets to keep essentials within reach.
- Side windows for additional airflow and light.
- Compact packed dimensions for portability.

MESH CEILING FOR VENTILATION

COMPONENTS AND WHAT'S INCLUDED

Your Kelty Discovery H2GO Privacy Shelter package should include the following items:

- Privacy Shelter Fabric Body
- 4 Steel Poles (pre-attached or separate, depending on model revision)
- EZ Clip on Fly
- Stakes (for securing the shelter)
- Carry Duffel Bag

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. **Choose a Location:** Select a flat, clear area free from sharp objects, debris, and potential hazards. Ensure adequate drainage if using as a shower.
2. **Unpack Components:** Remove the shelter and all poles from the carry duffel bag. Lay the fabric body flat on the ground.
3. **Assemble Poles:** Connect the steel pole sections. The shelter features a central hub system for simplified pole assembly. Insert the pole ends into the designated grommets or sleeves on the shelter fabric.
4. **Raise the Shelter:** Carefully lift the shelter by its poles, allowing it to stand upright. The freestanding design will help it maintain its shape.
5. **Attach Fly (if separate):** Secure the EZ Clip on Fly to the top of the shelter, ensuring it is properly aligned for weather protection and privacy.
6. **Secure with Stakes:** Use the provided stakes to anchor the shelter's base to the ground, especially in windy conditions, for added stability. Utilize any available guy lines for extra security.

7. **Adjust Features:** Open or close the zippered door, side windows, and roll-up floor as needed for your intended use.



The robust steel pole frame provides strong and stable construction, ensuring the shelter remains upright during use.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS (USAGE)

Using as a Shower Shelter:

- **Prepare Floor:** For showering, unroll the floor and ensure the drain hole is positioned over an appropriate drainage area.
- **Install Shower Tube:** Route your shower tube through the built-in opening at the top of the shelter. Ensure the shower head is securely positioned.
- **Internal Storage:** Utilize the internal wall pockets for soap, shampoo, or other showering essentials.
- **Ventilation:** Open the mesh ceiling and side windows as desired for ventilation during showering.

Using as a Changing Shelter:

- **Floor Configuration:** The roll-up floor can be kept rolled up for a larger, open floor space if preferred for changing.
- **Privacy:** Ensure the zippered door is fully closed for maximum privacy.
- **Storage:** Use the internal pockets for clothing or personal items.



The shelter provides ample space and features for comfortable showering in outdoor settings.

MAINTENANCE AND CARE

- **Cleaning:** Clean the shelter with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use harsh detergents or bleach, as this can damage the fabric and coatings. Rinse thoroughly.
- **Drying:** Always ensure the shelter is completely dry before packing it away to prevent mildew and odor. Air dry in a shaded area.
- **Storage:** Store the shelter in its carry duffel bag in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- **Pole Care:** Inspect poles for any damage or bending before and after each use. Clean any dirt or debris from pole sections.
- **Fabric Care:** The shelter is made with DWR/PFC Free fabrics and coatings. Avoid prolonged exposure to direct sunlight when not in use to preserve fabric integrity.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Shelter is unstable or collapses easily.	Not properly staked down; poles not fully assembled; high winds.	Ensure all stakes are firmly in the ground and guy lines are taut. Verify all pole sections are fully connected. Do not use in high winds.
Water pooling on floor during shower.	Drain hole obstructed; uneven ground.	Clear any debris from the drain hole. Relocate the shelter to a more level area or create a slight incline towards the drain.
Difficulty assembling poles.	Pole sections not aligning correctly; dirt in connections.	Ensure pole sections are clean. Apply gentle, even pressure. If a pole connection is broken, contact Kelty customer support for warranty or repair options.
Mildew or unpleasant odor.	Shelter packed away wet.	Unpack and thoroughly air dry the shelter in a well-ventilated area. Clean with a mild anti-mildew solution if necessary, then rinse and dry completely.
