PRODUCT OVERVIEW

The Insta360 X3 is a versatile waterproof 360 action camera designed to capture immersive footage. It features dual 1/2" 48MP sensors, capable of recording 5.7K 360 HDR video and 72MP 360 photos. The camera includes a 2.29" touchscreen for easy operation and preview. This bundle enhances its utility with a 2-in-1 selfie stick, lens cap, and a 256GB memory card, providing a comprehensive solution for capturing dynamic content.



SETUP GUIDE

1. Charging the Battery

Before first use, fully charge the Insta360 X3 battery. Connect the camera to a USB power adapter (not included) using the provided charge cable. The indicator light will show charging status and turn off when fully charged.

2. Inserting the MicroSD Card

Locate the microSD card slot on the side of the camera. Insert the included 256GB microSD card with the gold contacts facing the front of the camera until it clicks into place. Ensure the card is properly seated to avoid data loss.

3. Powering On/Off

To power on, press and hold the Power button until the screen lights up. To power off, press and hold the Power button until the camera shuts down.

4. Initial Activation and App Connection

For first-time use, activate the camera via the Insta360 app. Download the Insta360 app from your device's app store. Turn on the camera's Wi-Fi and Bluetooth, then open the app and follow the on-screen instructions to connect to your X3. This process activates the camera and allows for firmware updates and advanced controls.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Basic Recording Modes

- 360 Video: Captures immersive 360-degree footage. Ideal for reframing later.
- Single-Lens Mode: Uses one lens to record traditional wide-angle video.
- Photo Mode: Captures high-resolution 360 photos.

Switch between modes by swiping on the touchscreen or pressing the Mode button. Press the Shutter button to start/stop recording or take a photo.

2. Using the Touchscreen

The 2.29-inch touchscreen allows for intuitive control. Swipe left/right to browse modes, swipe down for settings, and swipe up for media playback. Tap icons to adjust parameters like resolution, frame rate, and field of view.

3. FlowState Stabilization

The camera automatically applies FlowState Stabilization to ensure smooth footage. This feature works in the background to counteract shakes and bumps, providing professional-grade stability without a gimbal.

4. Waterproof Usage

The Insta360 X3 is IPX8 waterproof to 33ft (10m) without a dive case. Ensure all ports are securely closed before exposing the camera to water. For deeper dives or prolonged underwater use, an official dive case is recommended (sold separately).

MAINTENANCE

1. Cleaning the Lenses and Screen

Use the provided lens cloth or a soft, clean, lint-free cloth to gently wipe the camera lenses and touchscreen. For stubborn smudges, a small amount of lens cleaning solution can be applied to the cloth, not directly to the camera. Avoid abrasive materials that could scratch the surfaces.

2. Battery Care

Store the battery in a cool, dry place. If storing for extended periods, charge the battery to approximately 50-60% to prolong its lifespan. Avoid fully discharging the battery or leaving it fully charged for long durations.

3. Storage

When not in use, store the Insta360 X3 in its protective pouch in a dry, dust-free environment. Avoid extreme temperatures and direct sunlight.

4. Firmware Updates

Regularly check for firmware updates via the Insta360 app. Updates often include performance improvements, new features, and bug fixes. Ensure your camera is sufficiently charged before starting an update.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution	
Camera won't power on.	Low battery; firmware issue.	Charge the battery. If still unresponsive, remove and reinsert the battery.	
Footage is shaky.	FlowState stabilization not active (unlikely); extreme movement.	Ensure camera firmware is up to date. For extremely vigorous activities, consider additional mounting stability.	
Cannot connect to Insta360 App.	Bluetooth/Wi-Fi off; app permissions; camera not activated.	Ensure camera's Wi-Fi/Bluetooth is on. Check app permissions on your phone. Restart both camera and phone.	
MicroSD card error.	Card not inserted correctly; incompatible card; corrupted card.	Reinsert the card. Ensure it's a compatible U3/V30 microSD card. Format the card in-camera (this will erase data).	
Overheating warning.	Prolonged recording in high temperatures.	Stop recording and allow the camera to cool down. Avoid direct sunlight during extended use.
