Mavpet 6L Automatic Pet Feeder (Model PP014) Instruction Manual

Your guide to setting up and operating your smart pet feeder.

1. INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Mavpet 6L Automatic Pet Feeder. This device is designed to provide scheduled and controlled feeding for your pets, enhancing convenience and ensuring consistent meal times. It features WiFi connectivity for app control, a voice recording function, and a dual power supply system for reliability.

2. PRODUCT COMPONENTS

Carefully unpack your Mavpet Automatic Pet Feeder and ensure all components are present:

- Automatic Feeder Unit x 1
- Power Adapter and Power Cord x 1
- Instruction Manual x 1 (This document)
- Desiccant Bag x 1

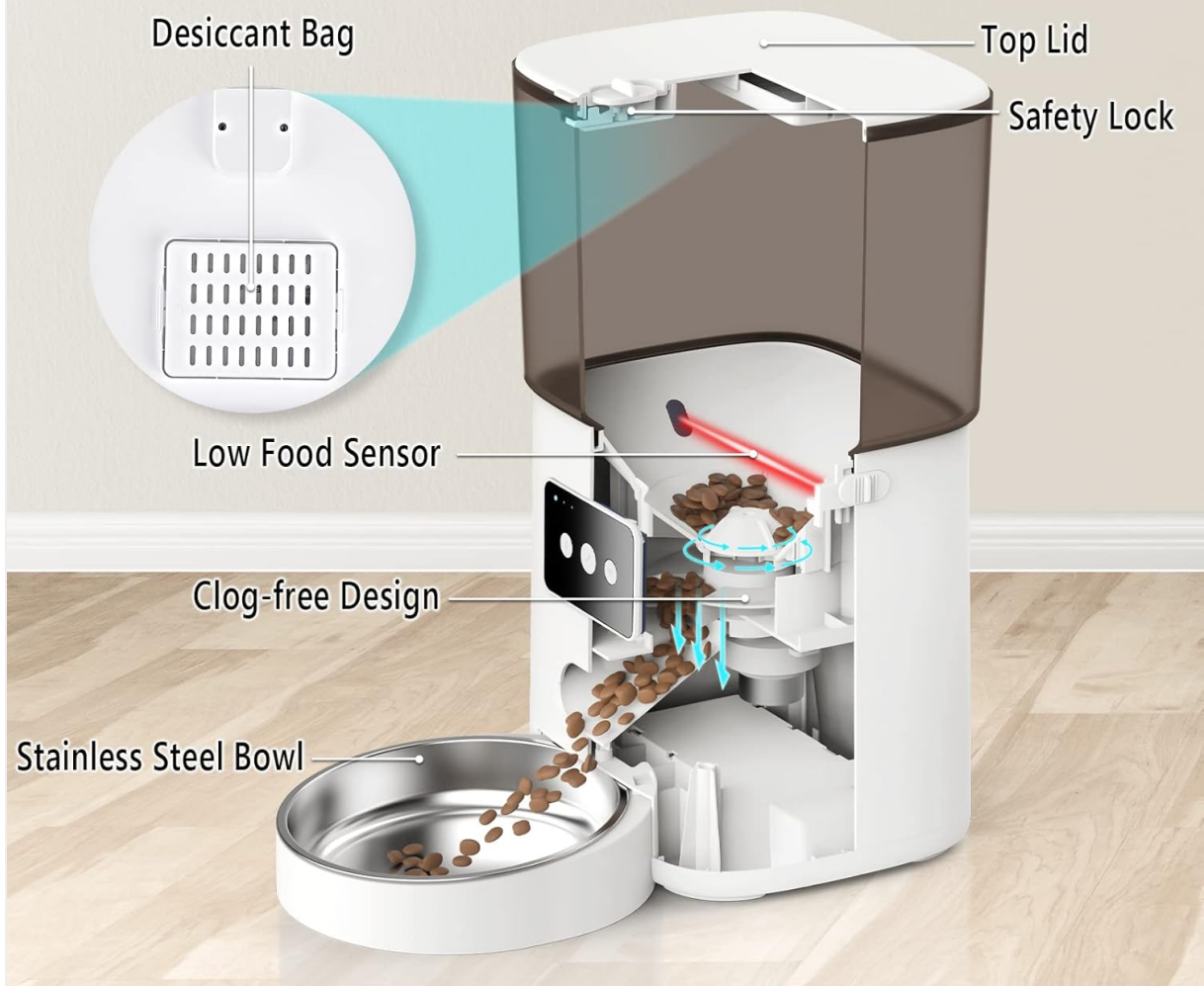

3. SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Power Supply

The feeder supports dual power options:

1. **AC Adapter:** Connect the provided 5V USB power adapter to a wall outlet and the feeder.
2. **Battery Backup:** For power outage protection, insert three D-size batteries (not included) into the battery compartment at the bottom of the unit.

The dual power system ensures continuous operation even during electrical interruptions.

3.2 App Download and WiFi Connection

1. Download the "Pet Zero" app from your smartphone's app store (iOS or Android).
2. Open the app and follow the on-screen instructions to create an account and add your device.
3. Ensure your smartphone is connected to a **2.4GHz WiFi network**. The feeder does not support 5GHz WiFi networks.
4. Follow the app prompts to connect the feeder to your home WiFi network.

3.3 Filling the Food Hopper

1. Open the top lid of the feeder.
2. Place the provided desiccant bag into the designated slot under the lid to keep food fresh.
3. Pour dry pet food into the 6L hopper. The feeder is suitable for dry food only, with a maximum kibble size of 15mm.
4. Close the lid securely, ensuring the safety latch is engaged to prevent pets from accessing the food.

4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

4.1 Scheduled Feeding via App

Use the "Pet Zero" app to create and manage your pet's feeding schedule:

- You can set up to **15 meals per day**.
- Each meal can be configured with up to **20 portions**. Each portion is approximately 7-8 grams.
- Adjust meal times and portion sizes according to your pet's dietary needs.

Set a Feeding Schedule

Use the mobile APP to control the pet's meal time anytime, anywhere, and never miss a meal.

4.2 Manual Feeding

You can dispense food manually at any time:

- Through the "Pet Zero" app, select the manual feed option and choose the number of portions.
- Alternatively, press the manual feed button on the feeder unit (refer to the product diagram for button location).

4.3 Voice Recording

Record a personalized 10-second voice message to call your pet at meal times:

- Locate the voice recording button on the feeder.
- Press and hold the button to record your message. Release to save.
- The message will play up to 5 times when food is dispensed, configurable via the app.

4.4 Smart Notifications and Indicator Light

The feeder provides important alerts:

- **Low Food Warning:** If the food level in the hopper is low, the indicator light will turn red, and a notification will be sent to your "Pet Zero" app.
- **Low Battery Power:** The indicator light will also signal low battery, and an app notification will be sent.
- The indicator LED can be turned off manually via the app if desired.

5. MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and hygiene for your pet.

5.1 Cleaning the Feeder

- Ensure the feeder is unplugged and batteries are removed before cleaning.
- The food hopper and stainless steel bowl are detachable for easy cleaning.
- Wash detachable parts with mild soap and water. Rinse thoroughly and dry completely before reassembling.
- Wipe the main unit with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main unit in water.
- The product care instructions specify "Hand Wash Only" for relevant components.

5.2 Desiccant Bag Replacement

Replace the desiccant bag periodically (e.g., monthly) to maintain food freshness. New desiccant bags can be purchased separately.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Mavpet feeder, refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Feeder not dispensing food	Food hopper empty; Food stuck; Power issue	Refill hopper; Check for obstructions (auto reversal mechanism helps); Verify power adapter connection or battery level.
Cannot connect to WiFi	Incorrect WiFi band; Weak signal; Incorrect password	Ensure connection to 2.4GHz WiFi; Move feeder closer to router; Re-enter WiFi password in app.
Voice message not playing	No message recorded; Volume too low	Record a new message; Check app settings for voice play times.
App notifications not received	App permissions; Phone settings	Check app notification permissions on your smartphone; Ensure phone is connected to internet.

Image 7.1: Diagram illustrating the dimensions of the Mavpet 6L Automatic Pet Feeder in inches.





8. SAFETY INFORMATION
