- Assembly Hardware (screws, washers, Allen wrench)

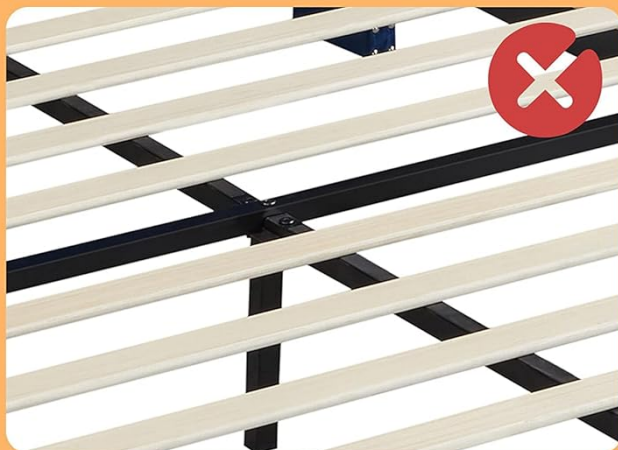




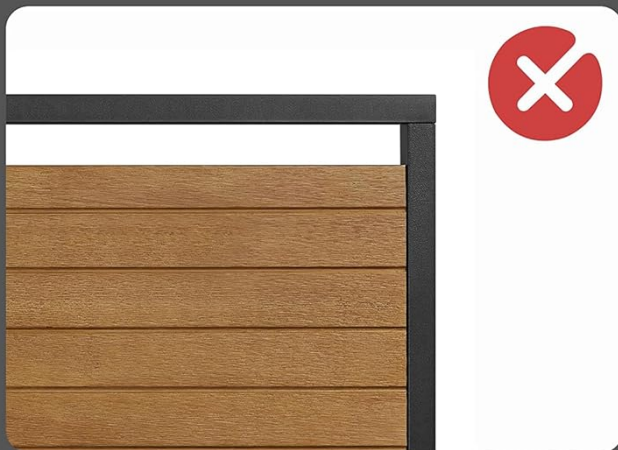
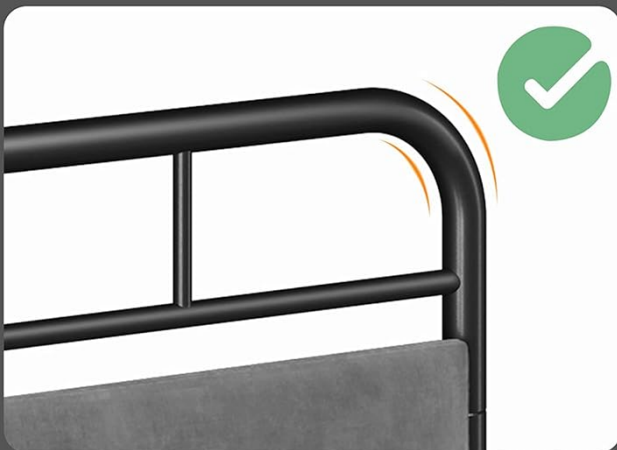
Image: Close-up of the curved upholstered headboard, showing the fabric and metal frame connection points.

## Step 2: Attach Side Rails and Center Supports

## OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

---

Once assembled, your Yaheetech Queen Bed Frame is ready for use. Place your queen-sized mattress directly onto the metal slats. The embedded design of the frame helps prevent the mattress from sliding.

- **No Box Spring Needed:** The robust 12-slat support system is designed to support your mattress directly, eliminating the need for a box spring.
- **Mattress Stability:** The three padded sides of the bed frame are intentionally higher than the inserted slats to minimize mattress movement.
- **Under-Bed Storage:** The 8.7-inch ground clearance provides ample space for storage bins or allows for easy cleaning with a vacuum robot.

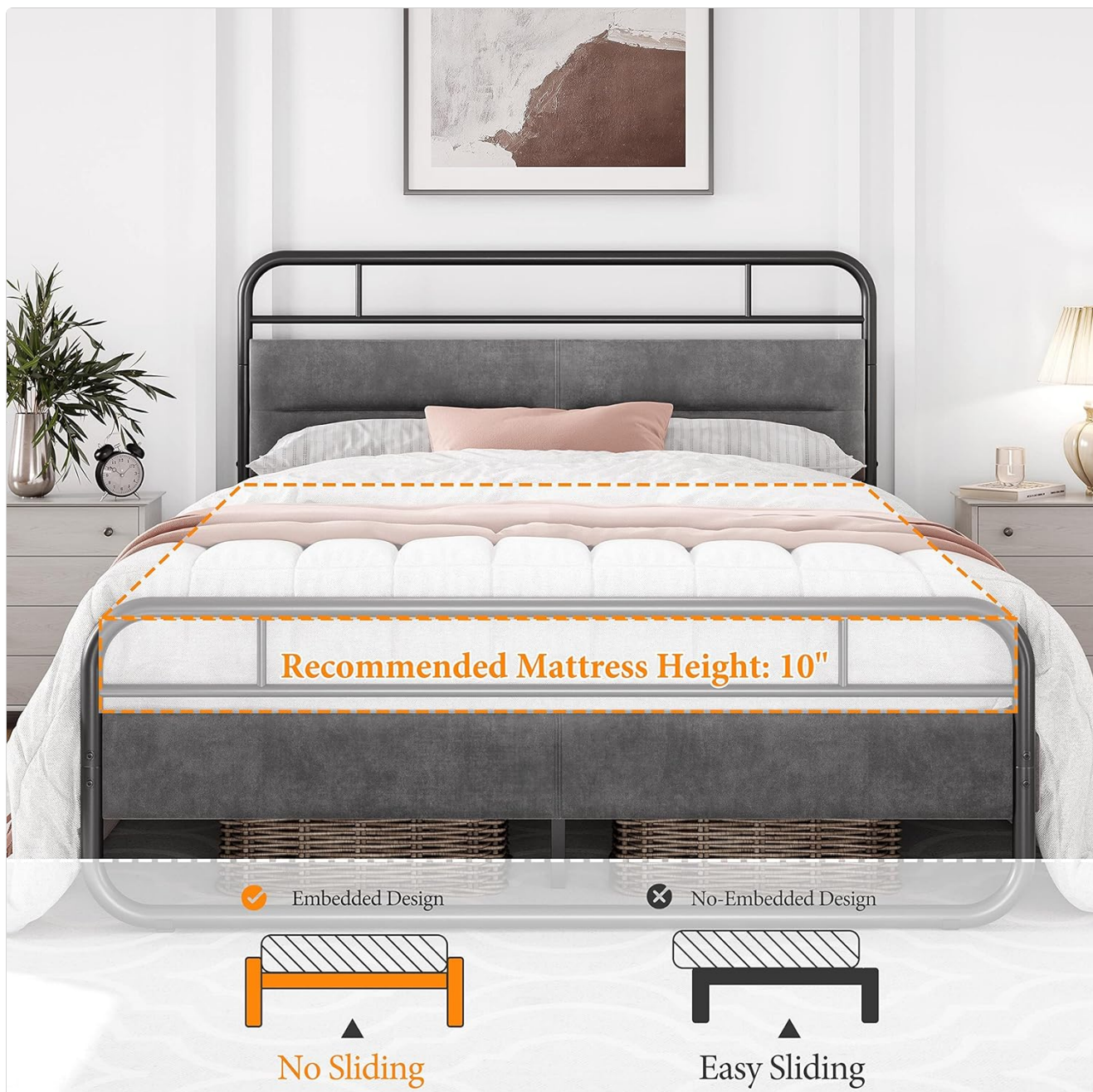


Image: Diagram showing the recommended mattress height of 10 inches and how the embedded design prevents mattress sliding.

## MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and appearance of your bed frame, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- **Cleaning the Frame:** Wipe metal parts with a soft, damp cloth. Avoid harsh chemicals that may damage the powder-coated finish.
- **Cleaning Upholstery:** For the dark grey velvet upholstery, spot clean with a mild detergent and a damp cloth. Blot dry and avoid excessive moisture.
- **Regular Checks:** Periodically check all screws and bolts to ensure they remain tight. Retighten as necessary to maintain stability and prevent noise.
- **Ventilation:** Ensure adequate air circulation around and under the mattress to prevent moisture buildup.

## TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your bed frame, refer to the following common solutions:

- **Squeaking Noises:** Check all connection points and tighten any loose screws. Ensure the mattress is properly seated on the slats.
- **Instability:** Verify that all parts are correctly assembled according to the instructions and that all bolts are securely tightened. Ensure the bed frame is on a flat, level surface.
- **Mattress Sliding:** The embedded design is intended to prevent sliding. If your mattress still slides, ensure it is the correct size for the frame and consider using a non-slip mattress pad.
