SETUP AND ASSEMBLY

Proper assembly ensures optimal performance and safety. Follow these steps to set up your Hurom H400 juicer:

1. **Unpack Components:** Carefully remove all parts from the packaging. Ensure all components listed in the packing list are present.
2. **Place Main Body:** Position the main juicer body on a stable, flat surface.
3. **Assemble Chamber Set:** Insert the inner chamber components (auger, strainer-free chamber) into the main body. Align the marks for correct placement.
4. **Attach Hopper:** Place the self-feeding hopper onto the assembled chamber. Rotate until it locks securely into place. The juicer will not operate if the hopper is not correctly locked.

5. **Position Containers:** Place the juice collection cup under the juice spout and the pulp collection cup under the pulp outlet.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The Hurom H400 is designed for simple and efficient juicing. Follow these steps for operation:

1. **Prepare Ingredients:** Wash fruits and vegetables thoroughly. The wide mouth hopper can accommodate larger pieces, reducing the need for extensive pre-chopping.
2. **Load Hopper:** Place your prepared ingredients into the self-feeding hopper. The juicer is designed to process ingredients hands-free once loaded.
3. **Start Juicing:** Ensure the juicer is properly assembled and the hopper is locked. Plug in the power cord and turn the On/Off switch to 'ON'. The auger will begin to slowly press the ingredients.
4. **Collect Juice and Pulp:** Fresh juice will flow into the juice collection cup, and dry pulp will be expelled into the pulp collection cup.
5. **Continuous Juicing:** You can add more ingredients to the hopper while the juicer is running.
6. **Reverse Function:** If ingredients become jammed, use the 'REV' (Reverse) function to dislodge them before resuming normal operation.
7. **Finish Juicing:** Once all ingredients are processed, turn the On/Off switch to 'OFF' and unplug the juicer.

CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

The Hurom H400 is designed for easy cleaning. Regular cleaning after each use will maintain hygiene and prolong the life of your juicer.

1. **Disassemble:** Turn off and unplug the juicer. Remove the hopper, then the chamber set from the main body. Separate the auger and strainer-free components.
2. **Rinse Parts:** Rinse all removable parts under running water. The strainer-free design significantly reduces pulp residue, making rinsing quick and easy.

3. **Clean with Brush:** Use the provided cleaning brush to remove any stubborn pulp residue from crevices.
4. **Hand Wash Only:** All removable parts are recommended for hand washing. Do not place them in a dishwasher.
5. **Wipe Main Body:** Wipe the main body with a damp cloth. Do not immerse the main body in water.
6. **Dry and Store:** Ensure all parts are completely dry before reassembling or storing the juicer.

TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your Hurom H400 juicer, please refer to the following common troubleshooting tips:

- **Juicer Not Turning On:** Ensure the power cord is securely plugged into a working outlet. Verify that all parts (chamber, hopper) are correctly assembled and locked into place. The juicer has a safety mechanism that prevents operation if not properly assembled.
- **Ingredients Jamming:** If ingredients get stuck, press the 'REV' (Reverse) button to rotate the auger in the opposite direction to dislodge them. Then, switch back to 'ON' to resume juicing. Ensure ingredients are not excessively large or fibrous without proper pre-cutting.
- **Excessive Pulp in Juice:** While the H400 is designed for minimal pulp, some very soft or overripe fruits might produce slightly more. Ensure the chamber set is clean and free from any blockages.
- **Low Juice Yield:** Ensure ingredients are fresh and firm. Overly soft or dry ingredients may yield less juice. For optimal extraction, feed ingredients at a steady, moderate pace.
- **Unusual Noise:** If you hear unusual noises, immediately turn off and unplug the juicer. Disassemble and check for any foreign objects or improperly assembled parts.
