INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the setup, operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your Analogue Pocket Console. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the device to ensure proper functionality and longevity.

1. SETUP

1.1 Unboxing

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Ensure the following items are present:

- Analogue Pocket Console
- USB-C Charging Cable
- Quick Start Guide (if included)




Figure 1: Analogue Pocket Console (White) - Angled View. This image displays the console's front and side, highlighting the screen, D-pad, action buttons, and shoulder buttons.

1.2 Charging the Device

Before initial use, fully charge the Analogue Pocket Console. Connect the USB-C charging cable to the console's USB-C port and the other end to a compatible USB power adapter (not included) or a powered USB port.

- The charging indicator light will illuminate during charging.
- A full charge typically takes approximately 2-3 hours.

1.3 Inserting Game Cartridges

The Analogue Pocket supports various game cartridges. To insert a cartridge:

1. Ensure the console is powered off.
2. Locate the cartridge slot on the top edge of the console.
3. Gently slide the game cartridge into the slot until it clicks into place. Do not force the cartridge.

1.4 Powering On/Off

- **To Power On:** Press and hold the Power button (usually located on the side or top) for a few seconds until the screen illuminates.
- **To Power Off:** Press and hold the Power button until a power-off menu appears on the screen, then select "Power Off." Alternatively, hold the Power button for an extended period (e.g., 5-10 seconds) for a forced shutdown.

2. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 Basic Controls

Familiarize yourself with the console's control layout:

- **D-Pad:** Directional input for movement and menu navigation.
- **A/B/X/Y Buttons:** Action buttons, functions vary by game.

- **Start/Select Buttons:** Typically used for pausing games, confirming selections, or accessing in-game menus.
- **Shoulder Buttons (L/R):** Additional action buttons, functions vary by game.
- **Volume Buttons:** Adjust audio output.
- **Brightness Buttons:** Adjust screen brightness.

- **Play Cartridge:** Starts the game inserted in the cartridge slot.

To prolong battery life:

- Avoid extreme temperatures.
- Do not allow the battery to fully deplete for extended periods.
- If storing the console for a long time, charge it to approximately 50% before storage.

3.3 Software Updates

Periodically check the official Analogue website for firmware updates. Updates can provide performance improvements, bug fixes, and new features. Follow the instructions provided with the update files carefully.

4. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Analogue Pocket Console, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Solution
Console does not power on.	Ensure the battery is charged. Connect the console to a power source and attempt to power on after a few minutes.
Game cartridge not recognized.	Ensure the cartridge is fully and correctly inserted. Clean the cartridge contacts with a cotton swab and isopropyl alcohol if necessary.
Screen is blank or flickering.	Try restarting the console. Check screen brightness settings. If the issue persists, contact support.
Buttons are unresponsive.	Restart the console. Ensure no debris is lodged around the buttons.
