INTRODUCTION

PRODUCT OVERVIEW

Key Features:

- **Night Vision:** Allows monitoring in low-light or dark conditions.

SETUP GUIDE

1. Unpacking and Inspection

Carefully remove all components from the packaging. Inspect the camera and accessories for any signs of damage. If any damage is found, do not use the product and contact customer support.

2. Powering the Camera

1. Connect the power adapter (not included) to the camera's power input port.
2. Plug the power adapter into a standard electrical outlet.
3. The Power LED on the camera should illuminate, indicating it is powered on.

3. Pairing the Camera with a Monitor

To establish a connection between the camera and your monitor unit (sold separately or included in a kit), follow these steps:

1. Ensure both the camera and the monitor unit are powered on.
2. Locate the "Pair Key" button on the camera (refer to Product Overview diagram).
3. Press and hold the "Pair Key" button on the camera for approximately 3 seconds until the camera's indicator light flashes.
4. Within 10 seconds, activate the pairing function on your monitor unit (refer to your monitor's specific instructions).
5. Once successfully paired, the camera's indicator light will become solid, and the image from the camera will appear on the monitor.

4. Placement

Place the camera on a flat, stable surface in the baby's room, ensuring a clear view of the crib or desired monitoring area. Keep the camera out of reach of children and pets. Avoid placing it near heat sources or direct sunlight.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Viewing Live Feed

Once the camera is paired and powered on, the live video feed will automatically display on your connected monitor unit.

Night Vision Activation

The GHB VB603 Baby Camera features automatic night vision. The camera's light sensor will detect low light conditions and automatically activate the infrared LEDs for clear black-and-white viewing in the dark.

Two-Way Communication

To speak through the camera's speaker to your baby, press and hold the talk button on your monitor unit. Release the button to listen.

Temperature Monitoring

The temperature detected by the camera's temperature sensor will be displayed on your monitor unit. Refer to your monitor's manual for specific display and alert settings.

MAINTENANCE

Cleaning the Camera

- Ensure the camera is unplugged before cleaning.
- Use a soft, dry cloth to wipe the camera body.
- For the lens, use a lens cleaning cloth or a soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.

Storage

When not in use for extended periods, store the camera in a cool, dry place, away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No image on monitor	Camera not powered on; Camera not paired; Out of range.	Check power connection; Re-pair camera and monitor; Move camera closer to monitor.
Poor image quality	Dirty lens; Insufficient lighting; Interference.	Clean the camera lens; Ensure adequate lighting or rely on night vision; Move camera away from other electronic devices.
No sound or distorted sound	Microphone/speaker blocked; Volume too low; Interference.	Ensure microphone/speaker are clear; Adjust volume on monitor; Reduce interference sources.
Night vision not working	Light sensor blocked; Malfunction.	Ensure light sensor is clear; Contact customer support if issue persists.
