INTRODUCTION

This instruction manual provides essential information for the Pokémon Card Game TCG: Starter Set ex Sprigatito and Lucario ex (Japanese). SETUP

Follow these steps to prepare for your first Pokémon Card Game battle:

- 1. Unpack Contents:** Carefully remove all items from the product packaging.
- 2. Review Deck:** Familiarize yourself with the 60-card deck. The included Play Instruction Manual will provide details on deck composition and strategy.
- 3. Prepare Play Area:** Unfold the play mat and place it on a flat surface. This mat indicates where to place your Pokémons, Energy cards, and other game components.
- 4. Organize Accessories:** Keep the damage counters, markers, and Pokémon coin readily accessible.
- 5. Read Instructions:** Before playing, thoroughly read the included Play Instruction Manual and Play Guide to understand the rules and flow of the game.



OPERATING (How to Play)

The Pokémon Card Game is a strategic two-player game. The primary objective is to defeat your opponent's

Pokémon by reducing their Hit Points (HP) to zero, or by taking all of your Prize cards.

Basic Gameplay Steps:

- **Shuffle and Draw:** Each player shuffles their 60-card deck and draws 7 cards as their starting hand.
- **Set Up Active and Bench Pokémons:** Players choose one Basic Pokémon from their hand to be their Active Pokémon and up to five Basic Pokémons to be on their Bench.
- **Prize Cards:** Each player takes the top 6 cards of their deck and places them face down as Prize cards.
- **Coin Flip:** A coin flip determines which player goes first.
- **Turns:** During a turn, a player can perform several actions, including drawing a card, playing Basic Pokémons, evolving Pokémons, attaching Energy cards, playing Trainer cards, and using their Active Pokémon's attacks.
- **Attacking:** To attack, a Pokémon must have the required Energy cards attached. Attacks deal damage to the opponent's Active Pokémon.
- **Winning:** A player wins by taking all of their Prize cards, by knocking out all of their opponent's Active and Benched Pokémons, or if their opponent cannot draw a card at the beginning of their turn.

MAINTENANCE

Proper care will ensure the longevity of your Pokémon Card Game set components:

- **Card Storage:** Store cards in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight. Consider using card sleeves and deck boxes to protect them from wear and tear, bending, and moisture.
- **Cleaning:** Keep cards and play accessories clean. Gently wipe cards with a soft, dry cloth if necessary. Avoid using liquids or abrasive materials.
- **Play Mat Care:** Keep the play mat flat when not in use to prevent creases. Roll it loosely for storage if needed.
- **Handling:** Handle cards by their edges to avoid creasing or damaging the card surface.
