1. INTRODUCTION

This manual provides essential instructions for the safe and efficient operation, maintenance, and troubleshooting of your COWAY Airmega Icon Air Purifier. Please read this manual thoroughly before using the appliance and retain it for future reference.

2. PRODUCT OVERVIEW

2.1 Key Features

- **Coverage:** Designed to purify air in spaces up to 649 sq. ft. in 30 minutes.
- **HyperCaptive Filtration System:** Features a combination of a washable pre-filter, deodorization filter, and True HEPA Filter, capable of reducing 99.999% of 0.01-micron particles, including pollen, allergens, bacteria, mold, and viruses. It also reduces 99% of volatile organic compounds and odors.
- **Air Quality Indicator:** Continuously monitors air quality and adjusts purification levels as needed, optimizing energy consumption.

- **Smart Mode:** Automatically adapts fan speeds based on the room's air quality (AQI) for efficient operation.
- **3-stage Manual Fan Speed:** Allows manual control over fan speed with low, medium, and high settings.
- **Wireless Device Charger:** Integrated Qi wireless charging station on the top surface.
- **Filter Life Indicator:** Provides a visual alert when filters require changing.

Powerful Purification

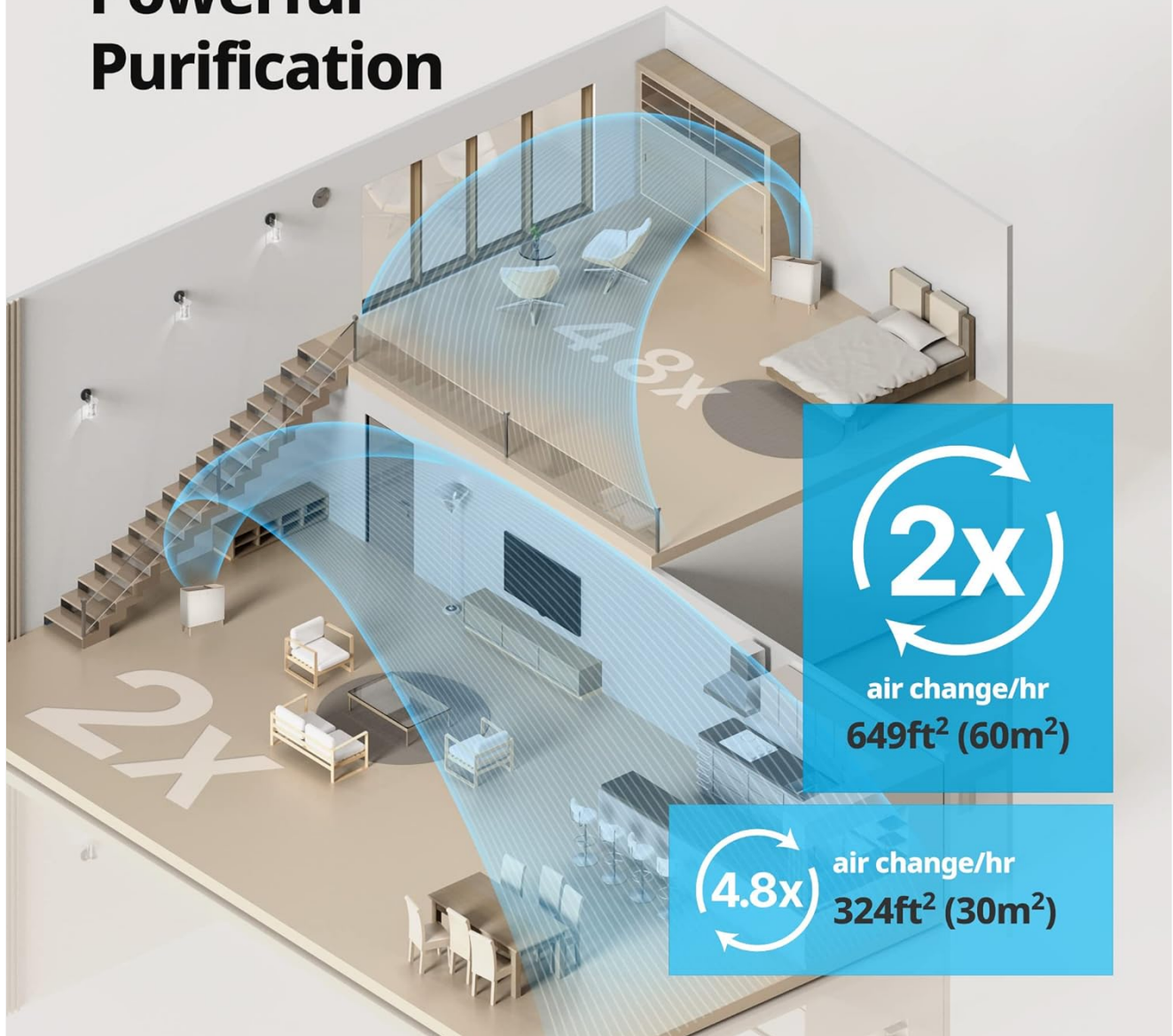

2.2 Included Components

- COWAY Airmega Icon Air Purifier Unit
- Filter Set (Pre-filter, Deodorization filter, True HEPA filter)
- User Manual

3. SETUP

3.1 Unpacking and Placement

1. Carefully remove the air purifier from its packaging.
2. Place the unit on a flat, stable surface. Ensure there is adequate space around the unit (at least 12 inches) for optimal airflow.
3. Avoid placing the unit near heat sources, direct sunlight, or in areas with high humidity.

3.2 Filter Installation

The filters are typically pre-installed but may be wrapped in plastic for shipping. Ensure all plastic packaging is removed from the filters before first use.

1. Open the front cover of the air purifier.

2. Remove the pre-filter, deodorization filter, and True HEPA filter.
3. Remove any plastic packaging from each filter.
4. Reinstall the filters in the correct order: True HEPA filter first, followed by the deodorization filter, and then the pre-filter. Ensure they are securely seated.
5. Close the front cover.

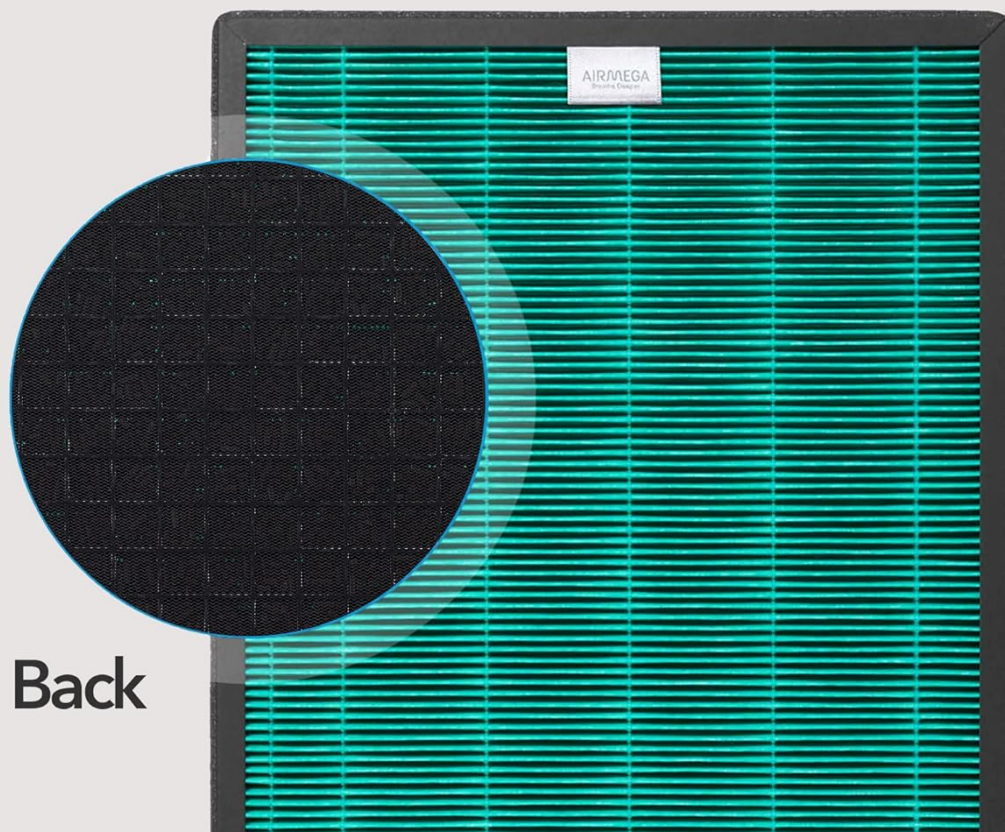


Image 4: All-In-One Max2 Filter. This image shows the combined Green True HEPA and Activated Carbon Filter, highlighting its structure and the back side.

4. OPERATION

4.1 Power On/Off

- Plug the power cord into a suitable electrical outlet.
- Press the **Power button** on the control panel to turn the unit on or off.

4.2 Fan Speed Control

- The unit offers three manual fan speeds: Low, Medium, and High.

- Press the **Fan Speed button** to cycle through the available speeds.

4.3 Smart Mode

- In Smart Mode, the air purifier automatically adjusts its fan speed based on the detected air quality.
- Press the **Smart Mode button** to activate this feature.
- The air quality indicator lights will change color to reflect the current air quality (e.g., blue for good, red for very unhealthy).

Real-time Air Quality Monitoring

24/7 pollution monitor senses air quality, adjusting purification to the necessary level.

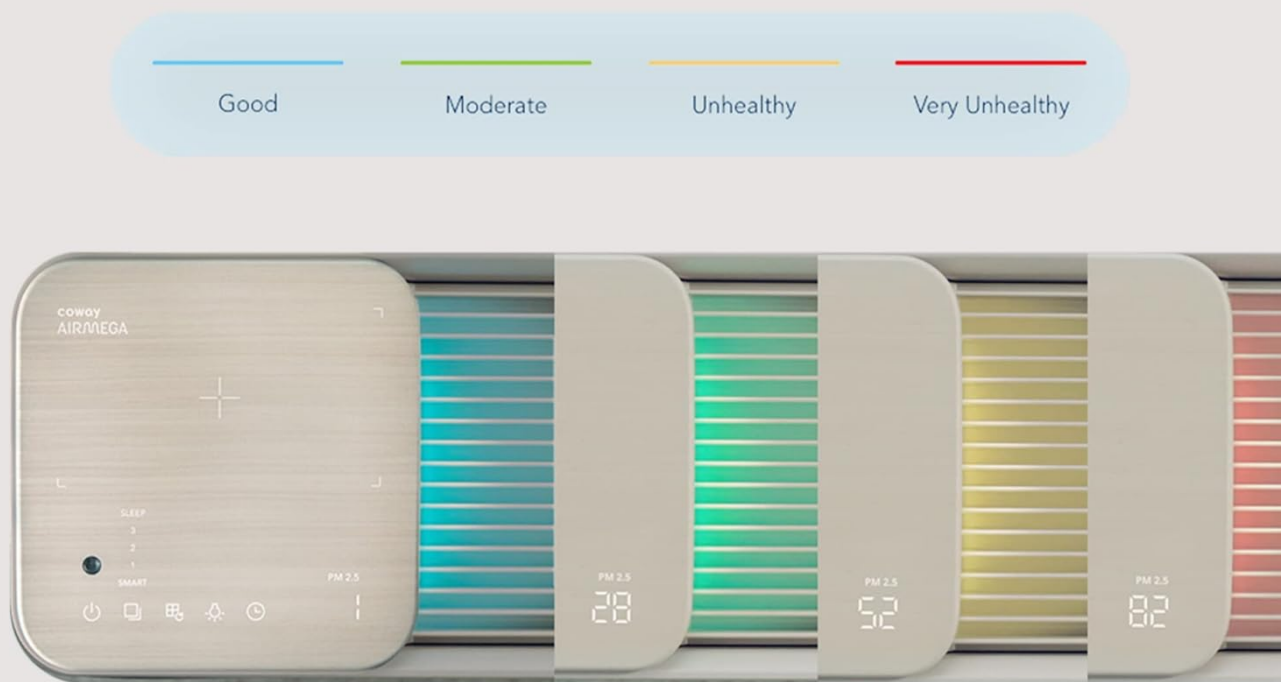

Smart Mode

Enables to automatically adapt to its surroundings by adjusting fan speeds based on AQI.

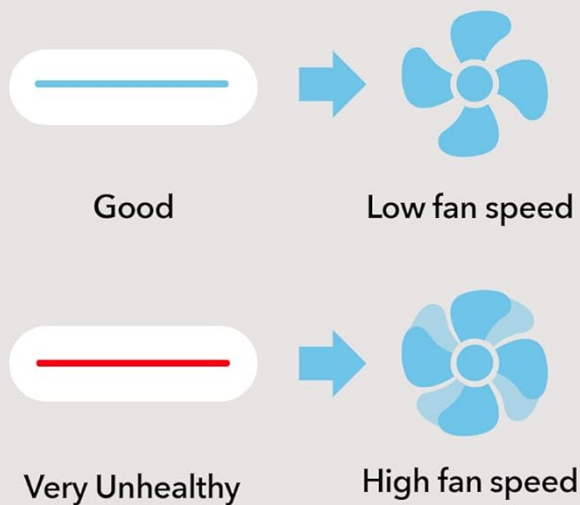

4.4 Sleep Mode

- Sleep Mode operates the unit at a low, quiet fan speed and dims the display lights for undisturbed rest.
- Press the **Sleep Mode button** to activate or deactivate.

4.5 Timer Function

- Set the unit to operate for a specific duration (e.g., 1 hour, 4 hours, 8 hours) before automatically turning off.
- Press the **Timer button** to select the desired operating time.

4.6 Wireless Charging

- The top surface of the air purifier features a Qi-compatible wireless charging pad.
- Place your compatible smartphone or device on the charging pad to initiate charging.

5. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the lifespan of your air purifier.

5.1 Pre-Filter Cleaning

- The pre-filter is washable and should be cleaned regularly (e.g., every 2-4 weeks, depending on usage and air quality).
- Turn off and unplug the unit before cleaning.
- Remove the front cover and then the pre-filter.
- Wash the pre-filter under running water to remove dust and debris. For stubborn dirt, use a soft brush.
- Allow the pre-filter to air dry completely before reinstalling.

5.2 Deodorization Filter and True HEPA Filter Replacement

- The deodorization filter and True HEPA filter are not washable and must be replaced periodically.

- The Filter Life Indicator on the control panel will illuminate when it's time to replace these filters (typically every 12 months, but this can vary based on usage).
- Turn off and unplug the unit.
- Remove the front cover, then the pre-filter, deodorization filter, and True HEPA filter.
- Dispose of the old deodorization and True HEPA filters.
- Install new filters in the correct order (True HEPA first, then deodorization filter).
- Close the front cover.
- After replacing, reset the filter life indicator by pressing and holding the **Filter Reset button** (refer to the control panel diagram for exact location).

Filter Replacement Indicator

Light indicate when filters need changing, so there's no need to keep track yourself.

5.3 Exterior Cleaning

- Wipe the exterior of the unit with a soft, dry cloth.
- Do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents, or harsh chemicals.

6. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your COWAY Airmega Icon, please refer to the following common solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not turn on	Power cord not securely plugged in; No power to outlet.	Check power cord connection. Verify power outlet is functional.
Weak airflow or no air purification	Filters are dirty or clogged; Protective plastic not removed from new filters.	Clean the pre-filter. Replace the deodorization and True HEPA filters. Ensure all plastic packaging is removed from filters.
Unusual noise	Foreign object inside unit; Filters not installed correctly.	Turn off and unplug the unit. Check for any obstructions. Reinstall filters correctly.
Air quality indicator always shows "Good" despite poor air	Air quality sensor is dirty.	Refer to the full user manual for instructions on cleaning the air quality sensor.



