# 1.2 Battery Installation

To install batteries, slide open the battery compartment cover on the back of the remote control. Insert two AAA batteries, ensuring correct polarity (+ and -) as indicated inside the compartment. Close the cover securely.


# 1.3 Initial Setup (No Programming Required)

CH +/-	Changes channels up or down.
Mute	Mutes or restores sound.
Playback Controls	Controls media playback (Play, Pause, Stop, Rewind, Fast Forward).
Sleep	Adjusts the sleep timer setting.

The remote includes dedicated shortcut buttons for quick access to popular streaming services:

- Netflix
- Prime Video
- YouTube
- Google Play

Note: This remote control does not support voice control functions.

#### 4. MAINTENANCE

To ensure the longevity and optimal performance of your remote control, follow these maintenance guidelines:

- Cleaning: Wipe the remote with a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the remote's response becomes sluggish or stops working. Always replace both batteries at the same time with new ones of the same type (AAA).
- **Storage:** Store the remote in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.
- Avoid Drops: Protect the remote from drops and impacts, which can damage internal components.

# 5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your OMAIC Universal Remote Control, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

#### · Remote not responding:

- Ensure batteries are correctly installed with proper polarity.
- Replace old batteries with new AAA batteries.
- $\circ~$  Check for any obstructions between the remote and the TV's IR receiver.

#### • Short operating range:

- Ensure batteries are fresh.
- Verify there are no strong light sources (like direct sunlight) interfering with the IR signal.

#### · Specific buttons not working:

- Clean the remote's surface and buttons to remove any dirt or debris that might be causing sticking.
- Confirm your TV model is listed as compatible. While universal, some advanced functions on specific TV models might not be fully supported.
