1. INTRODUCTION

This manual contains important information regarding the operation, maintenance, and safety of your 2023 Hyundai Santa Fe. Please read it thoroughly to ensure proper use and to maximize your vehicle's lifespan and performance. Keep this manual in your vehicle for future reference.

Safety Information: Always pay attention to warning labels and safety instructions throughout this manual and on your vehicle. Failure to do so could result in serious injury or damage.

2. INITIAL SETUP AND ADJUSTMENTS

2.1 Key Fob Operation

Your vehicle comes with a smart key fob. To **lock** the doors, press the lock button once. To **unlock**, press the unlock button once. Pressing the unlock button twice within three seconds will unlock all doors. The panic alarm can be activated by pressing and holding the panic button for a few seconds.

2.2 Seat Adjustments

Adjust your seat for optimal driving position and comfort. Most models feature power-adjustable seats. Use the controls located on the side of the seat to move the seat forward/backward, adjust the seatback angle, and modify lumbar support. Ensure the seat is securely locked in place before driving.

2.3 Mirror Adjustments

Adjust the side mirrors using the control switch on the driver's door panel. Select the left or right mirror, then use the directional pad to position the mirror. The rearview mirror can be manually adjusted or may feature an auto-dimming function.

3. OPERATING YOUR VEHICLE

3.1 Starting and Stopping the Engine

To **start** the engine, ensure the shift lever is in P (Park) or N (Neutral), then press the brake pedal and push the ENGINE START/STOP button. To **stop** the engine, shift to P (Park) and press the ENGINE START/STOP button.

3.2 Driving Modes

Your Santa Fe may offer various driving modes (e.g., Comfort, Sport, Eco, Smart) to optimize performance and fuel efficiency. Select your desired mode using the DRIVE MODE button on the center console. Each mode adjusts engine response, transmission shift points, and steering feel.

3.3 Infotainment System Basics

The infotainment system provides navigation, audio, and connectivity features. Familiarize yourself with the touchscreen interface and steering wheel controls. Connect your smartphone via Bluetooth or USB for Apple CarPlay™ or Android Auto™ functionality.

3.4 Climate Control

Use the climate control panel to adjust temperature, fan speed, and air distribution. The system may feature automatic climate control, allowing you to set a desired temperature and the system will maintain it.

4. MAINTENANCE AND CARE

4.1 Regular Service Intervals

Adhere to the recommended service schedule outlined in your separate Service Information Booklet. Regular maintenance is crucial for your vehicle's longevity and warranty validity. This typically includes oil changes, tire rotations, and inspections of various components.

4.2 Fluid Checks

Periodically check engine oil, coolant, brake fluid, and windshield washer fluid levels. Refer to the engine compartment labels for proper fluid types and fill levels. Always perform checks on a level surface with the engine off and cool, except for transmission fluid if applicable.

4.3 Tire Care

Maintain correct tire pressure as specified on the driver's side door jamb label. Regularly inspect tires for wear and damage. Rotate tires according to the recommended schedule to ensure even wear and extend tire life.

4.4 Battery Maintenance

Keep battery terminals clean and free of corrosion. If your vehicle is stored for an extended period, consider using a battery tender to maintain charge. Consult a qualified technician for battery replacement.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

5.1 Warning Lights

If a warning light illuminates on your dashboard, consult this manual for its meaning and recommended action. Some lights indicate minor issues, while others require immediate attention from a service center.

5.2 Engine Not Starting

If the engine does not start, check the following:

- Ensure the shift lever is in P (Park) or N (Neutral).
- Check if the battery is discharged (dim lights, no cranking sound).
- Verify the key fob is inside the vehicle and has a charged battery.
- Ensure there is sufficient fuel in the tank.

If the issue persists, contact Hyundai Roadside Assistance or a certified service technician.

5.3 Flat Tire

In case of a flat tire, safely pull over to a level area away from traffic. Refer to the spare tire and tool kit instructions for changing the tire. If your vehicle is equipped with a Tire Mobility Kit, follow its specific instructions for temporary repair.
