## INTRODUCTION

## SETUP AND INITIAL FIT

2. **Initial Try-On:** Wear the shoes with the type of socks you typically use for basketball. Stand up and walk around to assess the fit. Your toes should have a small amount of space at the front, and your heel should feel secure without excessive slipping.
3. **Break-In Period:** While designed for immediate comfort, a short break-in period may be beneficial. Wear the shoes for shorter durations during light activities before engaging in intense play.

## OPERATING AND INTENDED USE

## MAINTENANCE AND CARE

---

Proper care extends the life and maintains the appearance of your Jordan Zion 1 TB DC4208 401 shoes.

- **Cleaning the Upper (Mesh):**

- Gently brush off loose dirt with a soft-bristled brush.
- Mix a small amount of mild soap (e.g., dish soap) with warm water.
- Dampen a clean cloth or sponge with the soapy water and gently wipe the mesh upper. Avoid saturating the material.
- Wipe off soap residue with a clean, damp cloth.
- Allow to air dry at room temperature, away from direct sunlight or heat sources. Do not machine wash or tumble dry.

- **Cleaning the Sole (Rubber):**

- Use a brush (a toothbrush can work well for crevices) and soapy water to scrub dirt and debris from the rubber sole.
- Rinse with clean water, being careful not to soak the upper.
- Wipe dry with a cloth or allow to air dry.

- **Odor Control:**

- Remove insoles periodically to air them out.
- Use shoe deodorizers or sprinkle baking soda inside the shoes when not in use.

- **Storage:** Store shoes in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures. Avoid storing them in plastic bags, which can trap moisture.

## TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

---

Here are solutions to some common concerns you might encounter:

- **Shoes feel too tight or loose:**

- *Solution:* Re-adjust lacing. For tightness, try loosening the laces over the forefoot. For looseness, ensure laces are snug throughout. Consider trying a different sock thickness. If the issue persists, verify your size against the size chart.

- **Squeaking noise from the sole:**

- *Solution:* This can sometimes occur with new rubber soles on certain court surfaces. Ensure the soles are clean and dry. If the squeak comes from the insole, try removing it, sprinkling a small amount of baby powder or cornstarch inside the shoe, and then reinserting the insole.

- **Foot discomfort or rubbing:**

- *Solution:* Ensure socks are appropriate for athletic activity and fit well. Check for any creases in socks or insoles. Allow for a break-in period. If discomfort persists, consult a footwear specialist.
