

INTRODUCTION

VEHICLE SETUP AND INITIAL CHECKS

Before operating your GMC Terrain or Terrain Denali, it is important to perform initial setup procedures and checks to ensure safe and optimal performance.

- **Familiarization with Controls:** Locate and understand the function of all primary controls, including steering wheel buttons, dashboard instruments, and infotainment system interfaces.
- **Seat and Mirror Adjustment:** Adjust the driver's seat, steering wheel, and all mirrors (rearview and side mirrors) for optimal visibility and comfort before driving.
- **Tire Pressure:** Verify that all tires are inflated to the recommended pressure levels as indicated on the tire placard located on the driver's side door jamb.
- **Fluid Levels:** Check essential fluid levels such as engine oil, coolant, brake fluid, and windshield washer fluid. Refer to the Maintenance section for detailed instructions.
- **Lighting System:** Ensure all exterior and interior lights are functioning correctly, including headlights,

taillights, turn signals, and brake lights.

OPERATING YOUR VEHICLE

This section covers the fundamental aspects of operating your 2022 GMC Terrain or Terrain Denali, from starting the engine to utilizing advanced features.

Starting and Driving

- 1. Engine Start/Stop:** Insert the key or press the engine start/stop button while pressing the brake pedal to start the engine.
- 2. Transmission Operation:** Understand the gear selector positions (P, R, N, D, L) and their functions.
- 3. Driving Modes:** If equipped, learn about available driving modes (e.g., Tour, Sport, Off-Road) and their impact on vehicle performance.

Infotainment System

Your vehicle is equipped with a sophisticated infotainment system. Refer to the dedicated infotainment manual or the relevant section in this manual for detailed instructions on:

- Radio and media playback
- Navigation system usage
- Smartphone integration (Apple CarPlay, Android Auto)
- Bluetooth pairing and hands-free calling

Safety and Driver Assistance Features

Your GMC Terrain includes various safety and driver assistance technologies. Familiarize yourself with features such as:

- Forward Collision Alert
- Lane Keep Assist with Lane Departure Warning
- Rear Vision Camera and Parking Assist
- Adaptive Cruise Control (if equipped)

MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance is crucial for the longevity, safety, and performance of your 2022 GMC Terrain / Terrain Denali. Adhere to the recommended service schedule.

Scheduled Maintenance

Refer to the maintenance schedule provided in this manual for recommended service intervals based on mileage or time, whichever comes first. This typically includes:

- Oil and filter changes
- Tire rotation and inspection
- Brake system inspection

- Fluid level checks and top-offs
- Air filter replacement

Owner Checks

Between scheduled services, perform the following routine checks:

- **Tire Pressure:** Check monthly and before long trips.
- **Engine Oil:** Check regularly and add if necessary.
- **Windshield Washer Fluid:** Keep reservoir filled.
- **Wiper Blades:** Inspect for wear and replace as needed.
- **Exterior Lights:** Verify all lights are operational.

TROUBLESHOOTING COMMON ISSUES

This section provides guidance on identifying and resolving common operational issues you might encounter with your vehicle.

Warning Lights

If a warning light illuminates on your instrument cluster, consult the "Warning Lights and Indicators" section of this manual immediately to understand its meaning and recommended action. Some common warning lights include:

- Check Engine Light
- Low Tire Pressure Warning
- Oil Pressure Warning
- Brake System Warning

Engine Not Starting

If the engine does not start, consider the following:

- **Battery:** Check for a discharged or faulty battery.
- **Fuel Level:** Ensure there is sufficient fuel in the tank.
- **Ignition System:** Verify the key fob is present and recognized.

If you are unable to resolve an issue, contact a certified GMC service center for assistance.
