#### **INTRODUCTION**

Thank you for choosing the Cecotec Portable Induction Hob Full Magma Slim. This appliance is designed to provide efficient and convenient cooking with its advanced induction technology. Featuring 2000W of power across 8 adjustable levels, a high-resistance glass surface, and an intuitive touch display with a built-in timer, this induction hob offers precise control and easy cleaning. Please read this manual thoroughly before use to ensure safe and optimal operation of your new appliance.

#### SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

To prevent injury or damage to the appliance, always observe the following safety precautions:

- Ensure the appliance is placed on a stable, flat, and heat-resistant surface.
- Do not immerse the appliance, cord, or plug in water or any other liquid.
- Use only induction-compatible cookware. Non-magnetic pots and pans will not heat.
- Keep children and pets away from the appliance during operation, as the surface can become hot.
- Do not touch the hot surface immediately after cooking. Allow it to cool down completely.
- Unplug the appliance from the power outlet when not in use and before cleaning.
- Do not operate the appliance if the power cord or plug is damaged, or if the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any way.
- Avoid placing metallic objects such as knives, forks, spoons, or lids on the induction hob, as they can become hot.
- Ensure adequate ventilation around the appliance during use.

#### **S**ETUP

Follow these steps to set up your induction hob:

- 1. Unpack the induction hob and remove all packaging materials.
- 2. Place the hob on a dry, stable, and heat-resistant surface, ensuring there is sufficient space around it for ventilation. Do not place it near heat sources or on metallic surfaces.
- 3. Ensure the power cord is not pinched or tangled.
- 4. Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

#### **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### **Basic Operation**

Place an induction-compatible pot or pan centrally on the cooking zone. Ensure the cookware base covers the induction ring for optimal heating.

Press the power button (**①**) to turn on the appliance. The display will illuminate. Select your desired cooking function or adjust the power level using the touch controls.

#### **Power Levels and Timer**

The hob offers 8 power levels to suit various cooking needs, from gentle simmering to rapid boiling. Use the▲ (increase) and ▼ (decrease) buttons to adjust the power. The digital display will show the current power setting.

To set a cooking time, press the timer button () and use the  $\blacktriangle$  and  $\blacktriangledown$  buttons to set the desired duration. The hob will automatically turn off once the timer expires.

#### MAINTENANCE AND CLEANING

Regular cleaning will help maintain the performance and appearance of your induction hob.

- Always unplug the appliance and allow it to cool completely before cleaning.
- Wipe the glass surface with a soft, damp cloth and a mild detergent. Avoid abrasive cleaners or scouring pads that could scratch the surface.

- For stubborn stains, use a ceramic hob cleaner.
- Clean the ventilation openings regularly to prevent dust buildup, which can affect performance.
- Do not use steam cleaners or high-pressure cleaning devices.

### TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter any issues with your induction hob, refer to the table below for common problems and their solutions.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Hob does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outage; main switch off.	Check power connection; check circuit breaker; ensure power button is pressed.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Cookware not heating.	Cookware not induction-compatible; pan too small or not centered.	Use magnetic cookware; ensure pan is centered and covers the cooking zone.
Display shows an error code.	Overheating; internal malfunction.	Turn off and unplug the hob, let it cool; if error persists, contact support.
Unusual noise during operation.	Normal fan noise; cookware material.	Some noise is normal; certain cookware types may produce slight humming.


