# Homdox HD40 Electric Pressure Washer User Manual

Model: HD40

## 1. IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Read all instructions carefully before operating the Homdox HD40 Electric Pressure Washer. Failure to follow these instructions may result in serious injury or property damage. Keep this manual for future reference.

- Always wear appropriate personal protective equipment, including safety glasses, gloves, and hearing protection.
- Ensure the pressure washer is connected to a grounded outlet. Do not use extension cords unless they are rated for outdoor use and the amperage required by the unit.
- Never point the spray gun at people, pets, or electrical devices. The high-pressure spray can cause severe injury.
- Do not operate the pressure washer in the rain or near standing water.
- Before performing any maintenance or cleaning, always disconnect the power supply and water supply.
- Keep children and bystanders away from the operating area.
- Do not use flammable liquids or toxic chemicals with this pressure washer.

## 2. PACKAGE CONTENTS

Verify that all components are present before assembly. If any parts are missing or damaged, contact customer support.

## 3. ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Follow these steps to assemble your Homdox HD40 Electric Pressure Washer.

1. **Attach the Wheels:** Securely attach the wheels to the base of the pressure washer unit.
2. **Install the Handle:** Slide the retractable handle into its designated slots until it locks into place.
3. **Connect the High-Pressure Hose:** Connect one end of the high-pressure hose to the high-pressure outlet on the front of the unit. Ensure it is tightened securely.
4. **Assemble the Spray Gun and Lance:** Attach the spray lance to the spray gun. Then, connect the other end of the high-pressure hose to the spray gun.
5. **Attach the Detergent Tank:** Mount the detergent tank onto its hook on the side of the unit.
6. **Connect Water Inlet:** Attach the garden hose adapter to the water inlet connection on the unit.

## 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

### 4.1 Pre-Operation Checklist

- Ensure all connections are tight and secure.
- Connect your garden hose to the water inlet. Ensure the water supply is turned on fully.
- Select the appropriate quick-connect nozzle for your task (refer to Section 4.3).
- If using detergent, fill the detergent tank with a pressure washer-safe cleaning solution.
- Plug the power cord into a grounded electrical outlet.

### 4.2 Starting and Using the Pressure Washer

1. **Purge Air:** Before turning on the power, squeeze the trigger on the spray gun to allow water to flow through the

system and purge any air. Continue until a steady stream of water emerges.

2. **Turn On:** Flip the power switch to the 'ON' position. The motor will start.
3. **Begin Cleaning:** Squeeze the trigger on the spray gun to start the high-pressure spray. Release the trigger to stop the spray.
4. **Detergent Application:** To apply detergent, use the black SOAP nozzle. The pressure washer will automatically draw detergent from the tank when this nozzle is attached and the trigger is squeezed.

### 4.3 Shutting Down the Pressure Washer

1. **Turn Off Power:** Flip the power switch to the 'OFF' position.
2. **Disconnect Power:** Unplug the power cord from the electrical outlet.
3. **Turn Off Water:** Turn off the water supply at the faucet.
4. **Release Pressure:** Squeeze the trigger on the spray gun to release any remaining pressure in the system.
5. **Disconnect Hoses:** Disconnect the garden hose and the high-pressure hose.

## 5. NOZZLE SELECTION GUIDE

The Homdox HD40 includes five quick-connect nozzles, each designed for specific cleaning tasks. Always test the spray pattern on an inconspicuous area before applying to the main surface.

- **Red Nozzle (0°):** Produces a concentrated, pinpoint stream. Use for extremely tough stains on durable surfaces like concrete. Exercise extreme caution as this nozzle can damage surfaces.
- **Yellow Nozzle (15°):** Provides a powerful, narrow spray. Ideal for intense cleaning of stubborn dirt on hard surfaces.
- **Green Nozzle (25°):** Offers a versatile, medium-angle spray. Suitable for general cleaning of most surfaces, including decks, patios, and vehicles.
- **White Nozzle (40°):** Delivers a wide, gentle spray. Best for delicate surfaces, rinsing, and light cleaning.
- **Black Nozzle (SOAP):** Designed for applying detergent. Provides a low-pressure, wide spray to maximize foam coverage.

## 6. MAINTENANCE

Regular maintenance ensures optimal performance and extends the life of your pressure washer.

### 6.1 Cleaning

- **Nozzle Cleaning:** If a nozzle becomes clogged, use the included nozzle cleaning pin to clear any debris.
- **Water Inlet Filter:** Periodically check and clean the water inlet filter to prevent debris from entering the pump.
- **Exterior Cleaning:** Wipe down the exterior of the unit with a damp cloth. Do not use harsh chemicals.

### 6.2 Storage

- **Drain Water:** Before storing, ensure all water is drained from the pump, hoses, and spray gun to prevent freezing.

- **Store in a Dry Place:** Store the pressure washer in a dry, frost-free environment.
- **Organize Accessories:** Use the integrated storage features for nozzles, spray gun, and hose reel to keep all components organized.

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Unit does not start	No power supply; GFCI tripped; Power switch off	Check power connection; Reset GFCI; Turn power switch ON
Low pressure	Insufficient water supply; Clogged nozzle; Air in pump; Leaks	Ensure full water flow; Clean nozzle; Purge air from system; Check connections for leaks
Motor runs but no water spray	No water supply; Air in pump; Clogged inlet filter	Turn on water supply; Purge air; Clean inlet filter
Detergent not dispensing	SOAP nozzle not attached; Detergent tank empty; Clogged detergent line	Attach black SOAP nozzle; Refill tank; Clear detergent line




