#### 1. Introduction

Thank you for choosing the KONIX Folding Piano Keyboard. This portable 88-key electronic piano is designed for musicians of all levels, offering a full-size semi-weighted keyboard with innovative light-up keys to assist in learning. Its foldable design ensures maximum portability, allowing you to enjoy music anywhere.

Key features include:

- Portable Folding Design: Folds 180 degrees for compact storage and easy transport.
- Full-Size Semi-Weighted Keys: Provides a realistic piano feel with adjustable touch response.
- Light-Up Keys: Guides users during learning and practice sessions.
- Versatile Connectivity: Bluetooth for app integration and MIDI/USB for computer connection.
- Extensive Sound Library: 128 tones, 128 rhythm patterns, and 20 built-in demo songs.
- **Multiple Functions:** Includes dual keyboard, split, teach mode, dual voice, record, playback, polyphonic metronome, and transpose.
- Long Battery Life: Built-in rechargeable lithium battery for 6-8 hours of play time.

# 3. SETUP GUIDE

# 3.1 Unfolding the Keyboard

The KONIX Folding Piano Keyboard is designed for easy setup. To unfold:

- 1. Place the folded keyboard on a flat, stable surface.
- 2. Gently pull the two halves apart until they fully extend and lock into place. Ensure the locking mechanism engages securely.

# 3.2 Powering On

The keyboard can be powered via the included power adapter or its built-in rechargeable battery.

- **Using Power Adapter:** Connect the USB charging cable to the keyboard's USB port and the power adapter, then plug into a wall outlet.
- **Using Battery:** Ensure the built-in lithium battery is charged. The keyboard can play for 6-8 hours on a full charge.

# 3.3 Connecting Accessories

- Sustain Pedal: Plug the sustain pedal into the 'SUS' port on the keyboard.
- **Headphones/Speakers:** Connect 3.5mm headphones or external speakers to the headphone jack for private practice or amplified sound.
- **Music Stand:** Attach the included music stand to the designated slots on the keyboard for holding sheet music or a tablet.

# 4. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

#### 4.1 Basic Operation

- Power On/Off: Press and hold the power button to turn the keyboard on or off.
- Volume Control: Use the rotary knob to adjust the master volume.
- **Tone Selection:** Rotate the knob to browse through 128 different tones displayed on the LCD screen. Press the 'Tone' button to confirm.
- **Rhythm Selection:** Rotate the knob to select from 128 rhythm patterns. Press the 'Rhythm' button to confirm.
- Demo Songs: Rotate the knob to choose from 20 built-in demo songs. Press the 'Demo' button to play.




Figure 4.1: Close-up view of the full-size semi-weighted keys, illustrating the 1:1 ratio to traditional piano keys and the concept of adjustable touch response for dynamic playing.

#### 4.2 Learning Features

- **Light-Up Keys:** The light-up keys illuminate to guide you on which notes to play, making learning easier, especially with demo songs or connected apps.
- Teach Mode: Activate teach mode to follow along with built-in lessons or app-based tutorials.
- Keyboard Stickers: Apply the included keyboard stickers to help identify notes for beginners.

#### 4.3 Advanced Functions

- Bluetooth Connectivity: Enable Bluetooth on the keyboard and your smart device (phone, tablet, computer). Pair with piano learning apps like Garage Band, Perfect Piano, or Pop Piano for interactive lessons and games.
- **MIDI/USB Interface:** Connect the keyboard to a computer via USB to use it as a MIDI controller. This allows you to edit music, compose, and use various music production software (e.g., Cakewalk, Sonar, Cubase, Nuendo, VST/VSTi).
- **Record & Playback:** Use the record function to capture your performances and the playback function to listen to them.
- **Dual Keyboard/Split:** Divide the keyboard into two sections, allowing two players or different instrument sounds in each section.
- **Dual Voice:** Layer two different instrument sounds to be played simultaneously with each key press.
- Polyphonic Metronome: Use the built-in metronome to practice with precise timing.
- **Transpose:** Adjust the pitch of the entire keyboard up or down to play in different keys without changing your finger positions.




Figure 4.3: An overview of the various function options available on the keyboard, designed to assist users in their musical journey.

# 5. MAINTENANCE

# 5.1 Cleaning

To maintain the appearance and functionality of your keyboard:

• Wipe the surface with a soft, dry cloth.

- For stubborn dirt, slightly dampen the cloth with water and a mild soap solution, then wipe dry immediately.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners, solvents, or chemical sprays, as these can damage the finish.

# 5.2 Storage

When not in use, store the keyboard in its included piano bag to protect it from dust and scratches. Store in a cool, dry place away from direct sunlight and extreme temperatures.

# **5.3 Battery Care**

To prolong the life of the built-in lithium battery:

- Charge the battery fully before first use.
- Avoid completely draining the battery frequently.
- If storing for an extended period, charge the battery to about 50% every few months.

# 6. TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
No sound from keyboard.	Volume is too low; headphones are plugged in; power issue.	Increase volume. Unplug headphones if not needed. Ensure keyboard is powered on and charged.
Keys are not lighting up.	Light-up feature is off; low battery.	Check keyboard settings to ensure light-up feature is enabled. Charge the battery.
Bluetooth connection fails.	Keyboard not in pairing mode; device Bluetooth off; interference.	Ensure keyboard Bluetooth is active. Restart both keyboard and device. Move closer to the device.
Sustain pedal not working.	Pedal not fully inserted; faulty pedal.	Ensure the sustain pedal is firmly plugged into the 'SUS' port. Test with another compatible pedal if available.




Figure 7.1: Detailed product information including weight, number of keys, and folded/unfolded dimensions.
