Dreo Oscillating Fan DR-HAF001 User Manual

Model: DR-HAF001

The Dreco DR-HAF001 fan is designed for efficient air circulation with user-friendly controls.

Components:

- Fan Unit (Main body, grille, blades)
- Remote Control (Requires 1 Lithium Metal battery, included)
- Power Cord (Standard North American 3-prong electrical plug)

4. SETUP

Setting up your Dreco DR-HAF001 fan is straightforward:

1. Unpack the fan and all accessories from the packaging.

2. Place the fan on a stable, flat surface.
3. Ensure the power cord is free from obstructions and not pinched.
4. Plug the power cord into a standard 120V AC electrical outlet.

5. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

Your Dreo DR-HAF001 fan can be operated using the touch controls on the unit or the included remote control.

5.1 Control Panel and Remote Functions

The control panel features touch-sensitive buttons for power, speed, oscillation, and timer. The remote control duplicates these functions for convenience.

5.2 Power On/Off

- Press the **Power button** (🔌) on the fan or remote to turn the unit on or off.

5.3 Adjusting Fan Speed

The fan has 4 speed settings.

- Press the **Speed button** (🌀) repeatedly to cycle through speeds 1 to 4.

5.4 Oscillation and Tilt

The fan offers both automatic oscillation and manual tilt adjustment for optimal air distribution.

More rotation angles. More airflow control.

- Press the **Oscillation button** () to start or stop the 90° horizontal oscillation.
- Manually adjust the fan head up or down to set the desired vertical tilt angle, up to 120°.

5.5 Timer Function

Set the fan to automatically turn off after a specified period.

- Press the **Timer button** (🕒) repeatedly to set the timer from 1 to 8 hours. The display will show the selected duration.

6. MAINTENANCE

Regular cleaning ensures optimal performance and longevity of your fan.

6.1 Cleaning the Fan

Effortless cleaning

- Always unplug the fan before cleaning.
- The front grille and blades can be easily removed for cleaning. Unscrew the grill screw to detach the front grille.
- Wipe the exterior surfaces of the fan with a soft, damp cloth.
- For the grille and blades, wash them with mild soap and water. Ensure they are completely dry before reassembling.

- Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents, as these may damage the fan's surface.

7. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your fan, refer to the following common problems and solutions:

Problem	Possible Cause	Solution
Fan does not turn on.	Not plugged in; power outlet malfunction; damaged cord/plug.	Ensure the fan is securely plugged into a working outlet. Check the power cord for damage.
Weak airflow.	Fan speed too low; dirty blades/grille.	Increase the fan speed. Clean the fan blades and grille as per maintenance instructions.
Fan is noisy.	Obstruction in blades; fan not on a stable surface.	Check for any obstructions around the blades. Ensure the fan is on a flat, stable surface.
Remote control not working.	Battery depleted; remote out of range; obstruction between remote and fan.	Replace the remote control battery. Ensure the remote is pointed at the fan and within range. Remove any obstructions.
