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1. INTRODUCTION

The Lorex Fusion 4K 12-Channel Digital Video Recorder (DVR) is designed to provide comprehensive surveillance for your property. This system supports up to 8 wired and 4 Wi-Fi cameras, offering flexible monitoring solutions. With 4K resolution recording capabilities and a 2TB local storage drive, it ensures detailed video capture without recurring monthly fees. 2. SETUP

2.1 Unpacking and Initial Inspection

Carefully unpack all components and verify that all items listed in the product packaging are present and undamaged. If any items are missing or damaged, contact Lorex support immediately.

2.2 Connecting the DVR

Follow these steps to connect your DVR:

- 1. Connect Cameras:** Connect your wired security cameras to the BNC video input ports on the back of the DVR. For Wi-Fi cameras, refer to the Lorex Home app for pairing instructions.
- 2. Connect Monitor:** Connect a monitor to the DVR using an HDMI or VGA cable.
- 3. Connect Mouse:** Plug the included USB mouse into a USB port on the DVR.
- 4. Connect to Network:** Connect an Ethernet cable from the DVR's LAN port to your router for network access and remote viewing.
- 5. Power On:** Connect the power adapter to the DVR and then to a power outlet. The DVR will power on automatically.




Figure 2.2: Rear panel connections of the Lorex Fusion DVR. Ensure all cables are securely connected to their respective ports.

2.3 Initial Configuration

Upon first power-up, the DVR will guide you through an initial setup wizard on the connected monitor. This includes setting the language, time zone, creating a password, and configuring network settings. Follow the on-screen prompts to complete the setup.

3. OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 Live View and Playback

Once configured, you can view live camera feeds on your connected monitor. Use the USB mouse to navigate the on-screen interface. To access recorded footage, select the 'Playback' option from the main menu. The timeline allows you to select specific dates and times for review.

3.2 Smart Motion Detection

The DVR features intelligent motion detection, capable of distinguishing between people and vehicles. This reduces false alarms and ensures you receive relevant notifications.




Figure 3.4: Consistent monitoring experience whether accessing locally or remotely through the app.




Figure 3.5: Utilize Smart Search to efficiently locate specific events in recorded video.

4. MAINTENANCE

4.1 Hard Drive Management

The DVR includes a 2TB hard drive for local storage, eliminating the need for monthly fees. The system is configured to overwrite the oldest footage once the hard drive is full, ensuring continuous recording. You can adjust recording settings and manage storage space through the DVR's menu or the Lorex Home app.




Figure 4.1: Enjoy ample local storage without monthly fees.

4.2 Software Updates

Periodically check for firmware updates for your DVR to ensure optimal performance and access to the latest features. Updates can typically be performed through the DVR's system settings menu or via the Lorex Home app. Ensure a stable internet connection during the update process.

4.3 Cleaning

To clean the DVR unit, use a soft, dry cloth. Avoid using liquid cleaners or abrasive materials, as these can damage the device.

5. TROUBLESHOOTING

If you encounter issues with your Lorex Fusion DVR, refer to the following common troubleshooting steps:

- **No Video Output:**

- Check all video cable connections (BNC, HDMI, VGA) to ensure they are secure.

- Verify the monitor is powered on and set to the correct input source.

- **Wi-Fi Camera Connection Issues:**

- Ensure Wi-Fi cameras are within range of your Wi-Fi network and the DVR.
- Re-pair Wi-Fi cameras through the Lorex Home app if connection is lost.
- Check for any obstructions or interference affecting the Wi-Fi signal.
