INTRODUCTION

Thank you for choosing the Viper ProScore Electronic Scoreboard. This device is designed to enhance your dart game experience by providing automatic scoring for up to 8 players across 40 different games and 655 game options. This manual will guide you through the installation, operation, and maintenance of your new scoreboard.

PRODUCT FEATURES

- Compatible with steel-tip dartboards, bringing electronic dart game features to traditional play.
- Large, backlit LCD screen for clear visibility from the throw line.
- Supports up to 8 players with 40 distinct games and 655 game variations, including customizable handicaps.
- Features an automatic shut-off and sleep mode to conserve battery power.
- Soft-touch keypad for intuitive and easy operation.
- Compact dimensions: 12.7 cm (L) x 3.8 cm (W) x 26 cm (H).
- Battery operated: Requires 3 AA batteries (not included).

- Mounting hardware (screws and wall anchors or wood screws)

SETUP INSTRUCTIONS

1. Battery Installation

1. Locate the battery compartment on the back of the scoreboard.

2. Open the battery compartment cover.
3. Insert 3 AA batteries (not included), ensuring correct polarity (+/-).
4. Close the battery compartment cover securely.

2. Mounting the Scoreboard

The Viper ProScore Electronic Scoreboard can be mounted on a wall next to your dartboard for optimal viewing.

1. Choose a suitable location on the wall, typically to the side of your dartboard, at a comfortable viewing height.
2. Use the provided mounting hardware (screws and anchors or wood screws) to securely attach the scoreboard to the wall. Ensure the scoreboard is level.

OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Power On/Off

- To turn on the scoreboard, press the **On/Off** button.
- To turn off the scoreboard, press and hold the **On/Off** button until the display turns off.
- The scoreboard features an automatic shut-off and sleep mode to conserve battery life when not in use.

2. Game Selection

1. After powering on, use the **Up** and **Down** buttons to scroll through the list of 40 available games displayed on the screen.

2. Once your desired game is highlighted, press the **Enter** button to select it.

3. Player Setup

- The scoreboard supports up to 8 players. Follow the on-screen prompts to select the number of players for your game.
- Some games allow for custom handicaps. Refer to the specific game rules for details.

4. Scoring

After each player's turn, manually enter the score using the numeric keypad (buttons 1-20, 25, 50). Special buttons are available for common dart scores:

- **X2**: Multiplies the last entered score by 2 (Double).
- **X3**: Multiplies the last entered score by 3 (Triple).
- **25**: For scoring a single bullseye.
- **50**: For scoring a double bullseye.
- **Miss**: To register a missed throw.
- **Next Player**: Advances to the next player's turn after scores are entered.

5. Correcting Scores

- If an incorrect score is entered, press the **Correct** button to adjust the last entry.

6. Volume Control

- Use the **Volume** button to adjust the sound level of the scoreboard's voice announcements and effects.

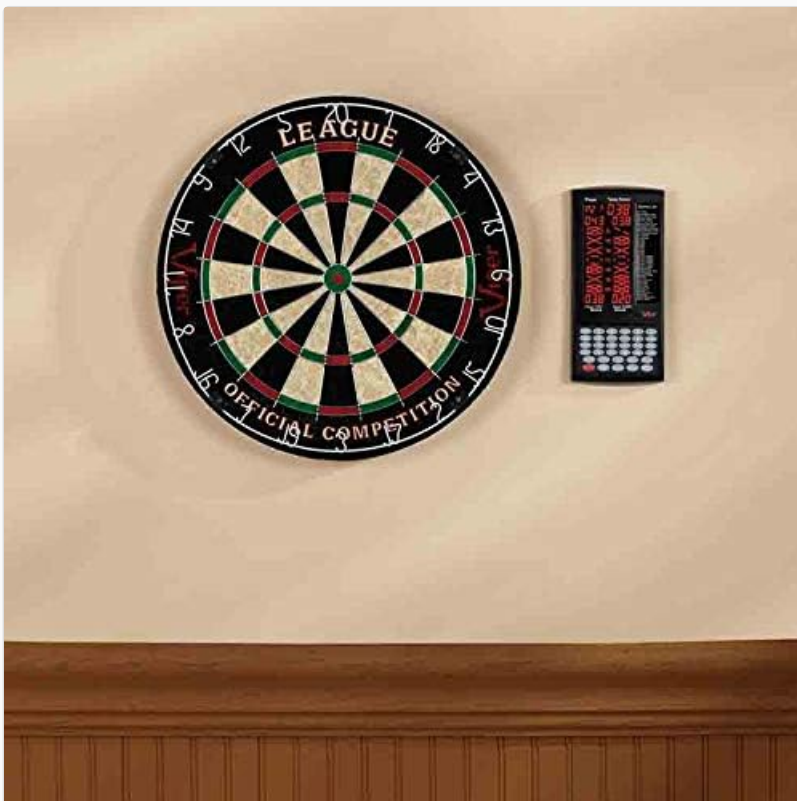

- **Cleaning:** Wipe the scoreboard surface with a soft, dry cloth. Do not use abrasive cleaners or solvents.
- **Battery Replacement:** Replace batteries when the display dims or the scoreboard functions erratically. Always replace all batteries at the same time with new ones of the same type.
- **Storage:** If storing for an extended period, remove the batteries to prevent leakage.

TROUBLESHOOTING

- **Scoreboard does not turn on:**
 - Check if batteries are inserted correctly with proper polarity.
 - Replace old batteries with new ones.
- **Display is dim or flickering:**
 - Batteries may be low. Replace them.
- **Incorrect scores are registered:**
 - Ensure you are pressing the correct numeric buttons for the score.
 - Use the **Correct** button to rectify recent entries.
- **Buttons are unresponsive:**
 - Try turning the scoreboard off and on again.
 - Ensure the buttons are clean and free from debris.






